PATTERN NOTES

Read through Tips & Tricks document before beginning. Visit martinupnorth.com for video tutorials and additional photos. Patt is written assuming dpns are used for working in the round to make the Central Square, and circular needles are used for working straight in rows.

Centre Square, Arrow Sections, Stripe Sections and Triangle are worked in moss st.

Construction

Note: all outside edges start with slipped stitches.

Middle Section: Centre Square is worked first, then each Arrow Section added to opposite sides of Centre Square.

First Half: Stripe Section One is added to Arrow Section worked in **Yarn A**. Next, Triangle Section, Mosaic Section, and Stripe Section Two are worked in order.

Second Half: Arrow Section Two is then worked in **Yarn B** to the opposite side of the Central Square. Next, Stripe Section One, Triangle Section, Mosaic Section, and Stripe Section Two are worked in order.

Part of Stripe Section Two may be repeated as indicated to add length if desired; however, more repeats will require more yarn.

Centre Square

Note: all rounds of Central Square are worked at RS of work, do not turn.

When changing colour in Centre Square, either carry yarn on WS or break yarn at each colour change. Colour changes are made by slipping new colour through first st purlwise.

Stripe Sections

Different stripe patts are repeated to form Stripe Sections. Stripe Section One has 12 stripes in total. Stripe Section Two has 10 stripes in total. Follow the Schematic: Scarf Layout. When working Stripe 2, Row 1 is worked with decrease as given to avoid gap.

Mosaic Section

Change colour every two rows; do **not** break yarn, carry it up the side. Colour changes are made on WS by purling last st in new colour.

INSTRUCTIONS MIDDLE SECTION

Centre Square

There will be a video for the pinhole cast-on.

Using 3mm crochet hook and Yarn A, cast on 12 sts using pinhole cast-on as foll: make magic ring, (insert hook into ring, yoh, pull up loop, yoh, pull through one loop on hook) 12 times. Using 3mm dpns, carefully remove hook and place 3 sts on each needle, ensuring that last st made is last st on last needle.

Round 1 (RS) Join to work in the round, knit to end.

Round 2 (RS) (Kfb, k1, kfb) 4 times. [20 sts]

Round 3 and all odd rounds Work moss st to end.

Round 4 and all even rounds (Kfb, work moss st to last st on needle, kfb) 4 times.

Rep Rounds 3 and 4 until 40 rounds have been worked, changing colour between Yarns A and B every 6 rounds, ending with 4 rounds in Yarn A. [172 sts in total; 43 sts on each needle]

Pattern is now worked in rows; sts are divided in half as foll: transfer first 86 sts onto one set of circular needles, and second 86 sts onto second cable or scrap yarn to cont after working First Half Section.

FIRST HALF

Arrow Section One

Work on first 86 sts and cont in Yarn A and on RS. Sm in centre marking corner will become point of arrow.

Row 1 (RS) Sl1p, moss st to sm, slm, moss st to last st, k1, **turn**. *Note: end with a p before sm and beg with a p after sm*. [86 sts] **Row 2 (WS)** Sl1p, k2tog, moss st to 1 st before sm, kfb, slm, kfb, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog, **turn**.

Cont to turn after each row.

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to sm, slm, moss st to last st, k1.









Row 4 Sl1p, k2tog, moss st to 1 st before sm, kfb, slm, kfb, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Rows 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe Section One

See Patt Notes, and use Schematic: Scarf Layout as a guide.

Stripe 1 (Short)

Using Yarn C and with WS facing, work on first 43 sts only.

Row 1 (WS) Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2. [43 sts]

Row 2 (RS) P2, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [42 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 4 P2, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [41 sts]

Rows 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. [37 sts]

Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 2 (Long)

Using Yarn D and with RS facing, cont from rem Arrow sts: **Row 1 (RS)** Sl1p, moss st to last st. Using a dpn, pick up Yarn A bump at top of Arrow to create a new st, then slip dpn through 6 bumps along short edge of Stripe 1, including bump of first st on left needle (*you have 7 sts on dpns now*). Slide sts along dpn to right and working on these sts, p2tog (*note: this decrease avoids a gap*), moss st to end. [49 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [48 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to end. [48 sts]

Row 4 Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [47 sts]

Row 5 Sl1p, moss st to end. [47 sts]

Row 6 Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [46 sts]

Row 7 Sl1p, moss st to end. [46 sts]

Row 8 Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [45 sts]

Rows 9-12 Rep Rows 5-8. [43 sts]

Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 3 (Short)

Using Yarn E and with RS facing, cont from Stripe 2:

Row 1 (RS) Sl1p, moss st to end. [43 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [42 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to end.

Row 4 Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [41 sts]

Rows 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. [37 sts]

Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 4 (Long)

Using Yarn F and with WS facing, cont from Stripe 1:

Row 1 (WS) Sl1p, moss st next 36 sts, slip dpn through 12 bumps along short edges of Stripe 2 and Stripe 3, moss st next 10 sts, p2. [49 sts]

Row 2 (RS) P2, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [48 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2. [48 sts]

Row 4 P2, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [47 sts]

Row 5 Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2. [47 sts]

Row 6 P2, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [46 sts]

Row 7 Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 8 P2, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [45 sts]

Rows 9-12 Rep Rows 5-8. [43 sts]

Break yarn, leaving sts on needle.

Stripe 5 (Short)

Using Yarn C, with WS facing and cont from Stripe 4, rep Stripe 1.

Stripe 6 (Long)

Using Yarn D and with RS facing, cont from Stripe 3:

Row 1 (RS) Sl1p, moss st next 36 sts, slip dpn through 12 bumps along short edges of Stripes 4 and 5. Slide sts along dpn to right and moss st for 10 sts, p2. [49 sts]

Rows 2 (WS)-12 Work as for Stripe 2. [43 sts]

Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 7 (Short)

Using Yarn F, with RS facing and cont from Stripe 6, rep Stripe 3.

Stripe 8 (Long)

Using Yarn E, with WS facing and cont from Stripe 5, rep Stripe 4.

Stripe 9 (Short)

Using Yarn D, with WS facing and cont from Stripe 8, rep Stripe 1.

Stripe 10 (Long)

Using Yarn C, with RS facing and cont from Stripe 7, rep Stripe 6.

Stripe 11 (Short)

Using Yarn F, with RS facing and cont from Stripe 10, rep Stripe 3.

Stripe 12 (Long)

Using Yarn E, with WS facing and cont from Stripe 9, rep Stripe 4.

Triangle Section

With RS facing and using Yarn B and cont from Stripe 11:

Row 1 (RS) Sl1p, moss st next 36 sts, slip dpn through 6 bumps along short edge of Stripe 12, moss st to end. [43 sts]

Row 2 Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [42 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to end.

Row 4 Moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [41 sts]

Row 5 Sl1p, moss st to end.

Rows 6-8 Rep Rows 2-4. [39 sts]

Rep Rows 5-8 a further 17 times. [5 sts]

Rep Row 5 once more.

Dec row Moss st next 3 sts, k2tog. [4 sts]

Next row Sl1p, p1, k1, p1.

Dec row P1, k1, k2tog. [3 sts]

Next row Sl1p, k1, p1.

Dec row P1, k2tog. [2 sts]

Next row Sl1p, p1.

Dec row P2tog. [1 st]

Break yarn.

Mosaic Section

With WS facing, cont on sts of Stripe 12; there should be 43 sts on the needles.

Make extra st as foll: between Stripe 12 and Triangle Section, you will find a bar at start of Triangle Section. Pick up bar to create extra st, then, using bumps along edge of Triangle Section, slip a further 42 sts onto needles, **do not** turn. [86 sts]

Both written instructions and chart are given.

Row 1 (WS) Using Yarn G, sl1p, moss st to last st, p1. [86 sts]

Row 2 (RS) P1, k83, k2tog. [85 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, p83, change to Yarn E, p1.

Row 4 (RS) Cont in Yarn E, p1, k9, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) 4 times, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k3, k2tog. [84 sts]

Row 5 (WS) Sl1p, p3, (sl2p wyif, p2, sl2p wyif, p10) 4 times, sl2p wyif, p2, sl2p wyif, p9, change to Yarn G, p1. [84 sts]









Row 6 (RS) Cont in Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, k6, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 12 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k4, k2tog. [83 sts]

Row 7 (WS) and all WS rows Sl1p and then p sts in same colour as previous row, and slip sts in different colour pwise wyif, changing colour in last st as on Rows 3 and 5. Change colours between Yarn E and G every 2 rows.

Row 8 Using Yarn E, p1, k5, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 13 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k5, k2tog. [82 sts]

Row 10 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, k2, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 14 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k6, k2tog. [81 sts]

Row 12 Using Yarn E, p1, k1, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 15 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k7, k2tog. [80 sts]

Row 14 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, (k10, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib) to last 10 sts, k8, k2tog. [79 sts]

Row 16 Using Yarn E, p1, k1, sl2p wyib, (k10, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib) to last 11 sts, k9, k2tog. [78 sts]

Row 18 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, (k10, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib) to last 12 sts, k10, k2tog. [77 sts]

Row 20 Using Yarn E, p1, k9, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 3 sts, sl1p wyib, k2tog. [76 sts]

Row 22 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, k6, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 4 sts, sl2p wyib, k2tog. [75 sts]

Row 24 Using Yarn E, p1, k5, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 5 sts, sl2p wyib, k1, k2tog. [74 sts]

Row 26 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, k2, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 6 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, k2tog. [73 sts]

Row 28 Using Yarn E, p1, k1, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 7 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, sl1p wyib, k2tog. [72 sts]

Row 30 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, (k10, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib) to last 2 sts, k2tog. [71 sts]

Row 32 Using Yarn E, p1, k1, sl2p wyib, (k10, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib) to last 3 sts, k1, k2tog. [70 sts]

Row 34 Using Yarn G, p1, sl1p wyib, (k10, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib) to last 4 sts, k2, k2tog. [69 sts]

Row 36 Using Yarn E, p1, k9, (sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k10) to last 11 sts, sl2p wyib, k2, sl2p wyib, k3, k2tog. [68 sts] Rep Rows 6-36 once more.

Rep Rows 6-18 once more.

Next row Using Yarn E, p1, k42, k2tog. [44 sts]

Next row Sl1p, p43.

Next row P1, k41, k2tog. [43 sts]

Break Yarns E and G, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe Section Two

Stripe 1 (Short)

Working on RS, slip dpn through bumps of Mosaic Section row ends to pick up 43 sts (shown in red on Chart: Mosaic Section). Sts will be alternately Yarn G and Yarn E, except for last st which is also Yarn E.

Using Yarn D, and with **RS** facing, rep Stripe 3 of Stripe Section One.

Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 2 (Long)

Return to Mosaic Section sts. Using Yarn F, and with WS facing, rep Stripe 4 of Stripe Section One.
Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 3 (Short)

Using Yarn E, with WS facing, rep Stripe 1 of Stripe Section One. Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 4 (Long)

Using Yarn C, with RS facing, rep Stripe 6 of Stripe Section One. Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 5 (Short)

Using Yarn D, with RS facing, rep Stripe 3 of Stripe Section One. Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 6 (Long)

Using Yarn F, with WS facing, rep Stripe 4 of Stripe Section One. Break yarn.

Note: as per Pattern Notes, if desired, Stripe sequence above may be rep to add length but more yarn will be needed. If rep Stripe sequence, last two stripes before Stripe 7 must be Stripes 5 and 6.

Stripe 7

Using Yarn A, with WS facing, cont from Stripe 6.

Row 1 (WS) Sl1p, moss st to end. [43 sts]

Row 2 (RS) P1, p2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [41 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 4 P1, k2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [39 sts]

Row 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. [31 sts]

Break yarn.

Stripe 8

Using Yarn B, with WS facing, cont from Stripe 7.

Row 1 (WS) Sl1p, moss st to end. [31 sts]

Row 2 (RS) P1, p2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [29 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 4 P1, k2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [27 sts]

Row 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. [19 sts]

Break yarn, leaving sts on needles.

Stripe 9

Using Yarn A, with RS facing, cont from Stripe 5.

Row 1 (RS) Sl1p, moss st next 36 sts, slip dpn through 6 bumps along short edge of Stripe 6; knitting from dpn, moss st for 4 sts, p2. [43 sts]

Row 2 (WS) P1, k2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [41 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to end.

Row 4 P1, p2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [39 sts]

Rows 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. [31 sts] Break yarn.

Stripe 10

Using Yarn B, with RS facing, cont from Stripe 9.

Row 1 (RS) Sl1p, moss st to last 2 sts, p2. [31 sts]

Row 2 (WS) P1, k2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [29 sts]

Row 3 Sl1p, moss st to end.

Row 4 P1, p2tog, moss st to last 2 sts, k2tog. [27 sts]

Row 5-12 Rep Rows 1-4 twice more. [19 sts]

Do not break yarn.

Next row (RS) Sl1p, moss st next 18 sts, slip dpn through row end bumps and bump of first st on needle [25 sts on dpn], moss st to end. [63 sts]

Final row (WS) Sl1p, moss st to end.

Cast off, working sts as they present themselves.

SECOND HALF

Work as for First Half, except for foll colour swaps: Work Arrow Section Two by rep Arrow Section One on opposite side of Centre Square in Yarn B.







Work Triangle Section in Yarn A.
Work Mosaic Section using Yarn G and Yarn C (replace Yarn E with Yarn C).
In Stripe Section Two, work Stripes 7 and 9 in Yarn B, and Stripes 8, 10, and final rows in Yarn A.

TO FINISH

Weave in all ends and block to measurements if desired.







Knit Version Pattern: Photos




Stripe Section One Row 2 (Long)



Work Row 1 as below.



Using a dpn, pick up Yarn A bump at the top of the Arrow to create a new st, then pick up the 6 bumps along short edge of Stripe 1 as shown, including the bump of the first st on the left needle.



P2tog the last st of the row and the new st to avoid leaving a gap.

How to begin Mosaic Section



Create an extra st here:



Between the two stripes on RS of Scarf, you will find a bar at start of Triangle Section.



Pick up that bar, this is going to be your new st.



It should look like this.



Slip the bumps of Triangle Section onto the needle.

Mosaic Section Row 3



Work Row 3 until one st remains.



Join new yarn.



Purl last st using new colour.



Turn to RS and work next row.

How to begin Stripe Section Two



We will be working along the row ends as shown at the top of the picture.



Slip the dpn through the 43 bumps shown in red on the chart.



The st colours alternate, except for the two sts at the end, which are the same colour.



Work Stripe 1 as given in patt.








Schematic: Scarf Layout (knit)












Knitting Chart: Mosaic Section Part 1
