Gauge/Tension

Not critical for this project.

Measurements

Fruit Ø 8cm Hanger 45cm long (adjustable)

Abbreviations

[] number of sts on a given row/round
blo back loop only: insert hook under back loop only
cc colour change: change to new colour on last yoh of last dc
ch(s) chain(s) or chain st(s)
cont continue(d)
dc double crochet
dc2tog double crochet 2 together to decrease by 1 st: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) twice, yoh, draw through all loops
htr half treble crochet
st(s) stitch(es)
yoh yarn over hook

(.....) once/twice/3 times Work the instructions between brackets the total number of times stated.

Pattern Notes

This pattern is worked using the amigurumi method. Work sts continuously in a spiral without closing each round with ss. Mark first st of each round with stitch marker, moving it up as you go. Ch1 at start of any round does not count as st. Use pliers to pull needle through silicone beads.

Instructions

LEMON

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With Yarn B, make magic ring. Round 1 (RS) Ch1, 6dc into ring. [6 dc] **Round 2** 2dc in each st around, cc to Yarn A. [12 dc] Fasten off Yarn B, cont in Yarn A. Round 3 (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18 dc] Round 4 (1dc, 2dc in next st, 1dc) 6 times. [24 dc] Round 5 (3dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [30 dc] **Round 6** (2dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc) 6 times. [36 dc] Round 7 (5dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, [42 dc] Round 8 (3dc, 2dc in next st, 3dc) 6 times, cc to Yarn B. [48 dc] Fasten off Yarn A, cont in Yarn B. Round 9 (7dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [54 dc] Round 10 (4dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc) 6 times, cc to Yarn A. [60 dc] Fasten off Yarn B. cont in Yarn A. Round 11 (9dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, [66 dc] Round 12 (9dc blo, dc2tog blo) 6 times. [60 dc] Rounds 13-15 1dc in each st around. [60 dc] Round 16 (4dc, dc2tog, 4dc) 6 times. [54 dc] **Round 17** 1dc in each st around. [54 dc] **Round 18** (7dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [48 dc] **Round 19** 1dc in each st around. [48 dc] Round 20 (3dc, dc2tog, 3dc) 6 times. [42 dc] **Round 21** 1dc in each st around. [42 dc] Round 22 (5dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [36 dc] **Round 23** 1dc in each st around. [36 dc] Start stuffing Lemon as you go. Round 24 (2dc, dc2tog, 2dc) 6 times. [30 dc] Round 25 1dc in each st around. [30 dc] Round 26 (3dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [24 dc]

Round 27 (1dc, dc2tog, 1dc) 6 times, cc to Yarn C. [18 dc] Fasten off Yarn A, cont in Yarn C. Round 28 (1dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [12 dc] Fasten off, weave yarn tail through sts of last round, pull tight and weave in end. With 2 strands of Yarn B, sew 7 long, straight sts between Rounds 2 and 8 to create segments using image as guide.

APPLE

With Yarn B, make magic ring. Work Rounds 1-10 of Lemon. <u>Note: Do not cc at</u> <u>Rounds 3 and 9</u>. **Round 11** 9dc, 2dc in next st 2 rounds lower,

(9dc, 2dc in next st) twice, 9dc, 2dc in next st 2 rounds lower, (9dc, 2dc in next st) twice. [66 dc] **Round 12** (9dc blo, dc2tog blo) 6 times. [54 dc blo, 6 dc2tog blo]

Work Rounds 13-28 of Lemon. <u>Note: Do not cc at</u> <u>Rounds 27-28.</u>

Fasten off, weave yarn tail through sts of last round, pull tight and weave in end.

With Yarn E, embroider 6 seeds between Rounds 3 and 4 using image as guide.

Stem

With Yarn E, make magic ring. **Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, 6dc into ring. [6 dc] **Rounds 2-7** 1dc in each st around. Fasten off leaving long tail. Sew stem on top of Apple in middle.

Leaf

With Yarn E, ch6, starting in second ch from hook: 1dc, 3htr, 3dc in last ch, cont along the opposite side of ch, 3htr, 1dc, close with ss in first dc of round, ch2 and fasten off leaving long tail. Sew Leaf to bottom of Stem. [5 dc, 6 htr]

WATERMELON

With Yarn D, make a magic ring. Work Rounds 1-8 of Lemon. Note: Do not cc at Round 3. Fasten off Yarn D. cont in Yarn B. Round 9 (7dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, [54 dc] Round 10 (4dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc) 6 times, cc to Yarn C. [60 dc] Fasten off Yarn B, cont with Yarn C and join Yarn E when indicated. Work Rounds 11-12 of Lemon. Rounds 13-15 (8dc. cc Yarn E 2dc) 6 times. [60 dc] Round 16 (Cc Yarn C 4dc, dc2tog, 2dc, cc Yarn E 2dc) 6 times. [54 dc] Round 17 (Cc Yarn C 7dc, cc Yarn E 2dc) 6 times. [54 dc] Round 18 (Cc Yarn C 7dc, cc Yarn E dc2tog) 6 times. [48 dc] Round 19 (Cc Yarn C 7dc, cc Yarn E 1dc) 6 times. [48 dc] Round 20 (Cc Yarn C 3dc, dc2tog, 2dc, cc Yarn E 1dc) 6 times. [42 dc] Round 21 (Cc Yarn C 6dc, cc Yarn E 1dc) 6 times. [42 dc] Fasten off Yarn E. cont in Yarn C.

Work Rounds 22-28 of Lemon. <u>Note: Do not</u> cc at Rounds 27-28.

Fasten off, weave yarn tail through sts of last round, pull tight and weave in end.

With 2 strands of Yarn E, embroider seeds using image as guide.

CROCHETED BEADS

With Yarn D, make magic ring. **Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, 6dc into ring. [6 dc] Leave ring open to allow elastic through. **Round 2** 2dc in each st around. [12 dc] **Round 3** (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18 dc] **Rounds 4-9** 1dc in each st around. **Round 10** (4dc, dc2tog) 3 times. [15 dc] Insert wooden bead. **Round 11** (3dc, dc2tog) 3 times. [12 dc]

Fasten off, weave yarn tail through sts of last round, pull tight and weave in end.

TO FINISH

Using image as guide and needle, thread fruit and beads onto elastic. Thread first elastic end through first hole of cord stopper followed by second to create loop. Pull loop through opening of pacifier clip.

Carefully singe ends of elastic to prevent fraying. Repeat on other side of elastic.



WANNA WAFFLE BLANKET BY ALL CAMPBELL



Gauge/Tension

21 sts x 12 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over tr using a 3mm hook after blocking.

Measurements 112 x 150cm.

Abbreviations

[] number of sts on a given row beg beginning ch(s) chain(s) or chain st(s) ch-sp(s) chain space(s) dc double crochet FPtr Front post treble crochet: yoh, insert hook from front to back to front to go around post of st indicated, work a tr **Ip** loop PM place stitch marker rep(s) repeat(s) RS right side ss slip stitch(es) ss surface crochet with hook on RS of work, and yarn on WS of work, insert hook from front to back at start of ss surface crochet line, yoh, pull through lp of yarn from back to make lp on hook, *insert hook into next st on line, yoh, pull up lp from back and draw through lp on hook; rep from * to end, fasten off, weave in ends st(s) stitch(es) tr treble crochet

WS wrong side

yoh yarn over hook

*.....; rep from * once more/twice more/3 more times/to end Work the instructions after * and then repeat that section as specified.

(.....) once/twice/3 times Work the instructions between brackets the total number of times stated.

Pattern Notes

Work blanket in rows creating blocks of waffle stitches. PM into every ninth FPtr worked on Row 4, move stitch markers up as you work a new row. Border is worked in both rounds and rows. Always keep RS facing when working the Border. Coloured lines are surface crocheted onto blanket, use image as guide.

BLANKET

With Yarn A, ch257 loosely.

Row 1 (WS) 1tr in fourth ch from hook and each ch to end, turn. [255 tr] Row 2 (RS) Ch2 (count as tr throughout), 1tr in each st to end, turn.

Row 3 Rep Row 2.

Row 4 Ch2, 2tr, *(1FPtr, 2tr) 8 times, 1FPtr, 3tr; rep from * to end, turn.

Row 5 Ch2, 2tr, *(1tr, 2FPtr) 8 times, 4tr; rep from * to end. turn.

Rows 6-15 Rep Rows 4-5 5 times.

Row 16 Rep Row 4.

Rows 17-19 Ch2. 1tr in each st to end. turn. Rows 20-83 Rep Rows 4-19 4 times. Rows 84-86 Rep Rows 17-19. Rows 87-88 Ch2. 1tr in each st to end.

Do not turn and keep RS facing. Do not fasten off and continue with Border.

BORDER

Round 1 Ch1, 2dc in each row end downwards along left-hand short side of Blanket, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in corner, 1dc in each st of foundation row, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in corner, 2dc in each row end upwards along right-hand short side, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in corner, 1dc in each tr to end, ch1, ss to beg 1-ch. Row 2 Ch2 (counts as tr), 1tr in each dc to end, 1tr in ch-1

sp, fasten off. Rejoin varn to ch-1 sp on opposite short side, ch2, 1tr in each dc to end, 1tr in ch-1 sp.

Round 3 Join Yarn B with ss to any corner, dc in same st,

*1dc in each st to corner, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in corner; rep from

* 2 times, 1dc in each st to corner, (1dc, ch1) in corner, ss to first dc.

Round 4 Join Yarn C with ss to ch-1 sp, dc in same sp, *1dc in each st to corner, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in corner; rep from * 2 times, 1dc in each st to corner, (1dc, ch1) in corner, ss to first dc.

Round 5 With Yarn D, rep Round 4.

Round 6 Join Yarn A with ss to ch-1 sp, ch2 (counts as tr), 1tr in same sp, *1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, ch1, 2tr) in corner; rep from * 2 times, 1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, ch1) in corner, ss to top of beg 2-ch.

Round 7 With Yarn E, rep Round 4.

Round 8 With Yarn F, rep Round 4.

Round 9 Rep Round 6.

Round 10 Ch2, 1tr in same sp, *1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, ch1, 2tr) in corner; rep from * 2 times, 1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, ch1) in corner, ss to top of beg 2-ch. Round 11 With Yarn G, rep Round 4.

Rounds 12-14 Rep Round 6.

Round 15 Join Yarn B with ss to any corner, 1dc same st, *1dc in each st to corner, 2dc in corner; rep from * 2 times, 1dc in each st to corner, 1dc in corner, ss to first dc.

SURFACE CROCHET

With RS facing and any colour yarn from B to G, ss surface crochet lines along and across plain tr rows, work 1 or 2 lines parallel between two waffle blocks creating a check pattern.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to measurements.



MATERIALS **Scheepjes Organicon**

(100% Soft Organic Cotton; 50g/170m) Yarn A: 220 Broken Almond x 17 balls Yarn B: 213 Sapling x 1 ball Yarn C: 217 Fresh Air x 1 ball Yarn D: 214 Glacier x 1 hall Yarn E: 208 Peach Fuzz x 1 ball Yarn F: 211 Gentle Primrose x 1 ball Yarn G: 205 Lavender x 1 ball 3mm crochet hook Stitch markers







Gauge/Tension

22 sts and 30 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over st st using 3mm needles.

Abbreviations

[] number of sts on a given row/round as folls as follows beg beginning cont continue k knit k2tog knit 2 sts together: insert needle kwise into

first 2 sts and knit them together

kwise knitwise

MB make bobble: with Yarn B, knit into front, back, front, back and front again of the next st to increase 4 sts, turn, beg with a p row and work 7 rows in st st on these 5 sts, then using left needle lift the second, third, fourth and fifth sts on right needle over the first st

p purl

patt pattern

rem remaining

rep repeat

RS right side

sl1 slip 1 st

ssk slip 1 st kwise, slip next st kwise, insert left needle into front of 2 slipped sts and knit them together

st(s) stitch(es)

st st stocking stitch: RS knit, WS purl **WS** wrong side

*.....; rep from * once more/twice more/3 more times/to end Work the instructions after * and then repeat that section as specified. (....) **once/twice 3 times** Work the instructions between brackets the total number of times stated.

Pattern Notes

This sweater is constructed of four pieces worked flat with one selvedge st at each edge to make seam allowance. Back and Front are worked bottom up and Sleeves are worked top down. Bobbles are worked with Yarn B.

Instructions

BACK

With Yarn A, cast on 50 (54: 56: 60) sts.

Ribbed Hem

Row 1 (RS) Sl1, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 1 (1: 3: 3) sts, k0 (0: 2: 2), p1.

Row 2 (WS) Sl1, p0 (0: 2: 2), *k2, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Last 2 rows set rib.

Cont in rib for 8 more rows.

Bobble Section

Row 11 (RS) SI1, k to last st, p1.

Row 12 (WS) SI1, p to end.

Join Yarn B for first bobble and strand it loosely behind work between bobbles and work rest of row with Yarn A.

Note: Work each MB with Yarn B.

Row 13 Sl1, *k4, MB; rep from * 8 (9: 9: 10) more times, k3 (2: 4: 3), p1.

Fasten off Yarn B and cont with Yarn A only.

Row 14 Sl1, p to end.

Work in st st.



SHOPPING LIST

DAISY DOT SWEATER

Scheepjes Organicon (100% Soft Organic Cotton: 50g/170m)

Yarn A: 211 Gentle Primrose x 2 (2: 2: 2) balls

Yarn B: 220 Broken Almond x 1 (1: 1: 1:) ball

3mm knitting needles

Tip!

Switch Yarn A and B around for a completely different sweater!

NOTES Use this space to write your pattern notes! Row 15 (RS) SI1, k to last st, p1. Row 16 (WS) SI1, p to end. Last 2 rows form patt: st st with selvedge sts at each end. Cont in patt a further 44 (48: 54: 58) rows until a total of 60 (64: 70: 74) rows have been worked for Back, ending after a WS row. Cast off.

FRONT

Work Rows 1-16 of Back. Cont in patt a further 36 (38: 42: 44) rows until a total of 52 (54: 58: 60) rows have been worked for Front.

Shape Left Front Neck Next row (RS) Sl1, k24 (26: 27: 29), turn. Next row (WS) Sl1, p to end. Rep last 2 rows 3 (4: 5: 6) more times. Cast off.



Shape Right Front Neck

With RS facing, rejoin Yarn A to rem 25 (27: 28: 30) sts. **Next row (RS)** SI1, k23 (25: 26: 28), p1. **Next row (WS)** SI1, p to end. Rep last 2 rows 3 (4: 5: 6) more times. Cast off.

SLEEVE (MAKE 2)

With Yarn A, cast on 30 (34: 38: 40) sts for top of Sleeve. **Row 1 (RS)** Sl1, k to last st, p1. **Row 2 (WS)** Sl1, p to end. Last 2 rows form patt: st st with selvedge sts at each end. Rep patt twice more. **Dec row (RS)** Sl1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1. Work 5 rows in patt. Rep last 6 rows 2 (3: 4: 5) times, then rep dec

row once more. [22 (24: 26: 26) sts]

Bobble Section Row 1 (WS) SI1, p to end. Join Yarn B for first bobble and strand it loosely behind work between bobbles and work rest of row with Yarn A. Note: Work each MB with Yarn B. Row 2 (RS) SI1, *k4, MB; rep from * 3 more times, k0 (2: 4: 4), p1. Fasten off Yarn B and cont with Yarn A only. Row 3 Rep Row 1. Row 4 SI1, k to last st, p1. **Ribbed Cuff** Next row (WS) SI1, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 1 (3:1:1) sts, k0 (2:0:0), p1. This row sets rib. Cont in rib. dec 1 st at each end as before on next row and foll sixth row. [18 (20: 22: 22) sts] Work 2 rows in rib. Cast off.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to measurements, then sew all seams from WS as folls: sew shoulder seams from arm edge to neckline, leaving 5cm unsewn for neck opening. Line up middle of top edge of Sleeve to shoulder seam, sew in Sleeves. Join sleeve and side seams.

EXTRAS!
