## Gauge/Tension

## Pattern Notes

Tooth Fairy pattern uses amigurumi method throughout (work in a spiral without closing each round with ss), unless otherwise indicated. For row-based sections, turn after each row.
To change colour, work final st in previous colour to last 2 loops on hook, yarn over hook with new colour and draw through previous colour to finish.

Using Yarn A, make magic ring.
Round 1 (RS) 6dc into ring. [6 dc]

Set aside, then make a second piece by rep Rounds 1-10, do not fasten off after Round 10. Foll round joins both pieces together.
Round 11 In second piece already on hook, work 1dc in each st around, pick up first piece, work 1dc in each st of Round 10. [48 dc]
Round 12 (and all foll even rounds) 1dc in each st around.
Round 13 (Dc2tog, 14dc) 3 times. [45 dc]

Rounds 36-40 1dc in each st around.
Fasten off, make second Leg, do not fasten off and continue continue to join legs as folls:
Press Legs together, 1dc in next 6 sts working through sts of last rounds of both first and second Leg at the same time to join. Continue to Body.

Rounds 3-22 1dc in each st around.
Change to Yarn B.
Rounds 23-32 1dc in each st around.
Fasten off, leaving 20 cm tail for assembly.

## SHOE (MAKE 2)

Using Yarn C, make magic ring.
Rounds 1-3 (RS) Rep Rounds 1-3 of Wing. [18 dc]
Round 4 (2dc in next st, 5dc) 3 times. [21 dc]
Rounds 5-10 1dc in each st around, turn.
Row 11 (WS) Ch1 (does not count as st
throughout), 17dc, turn. [17 dc]

Row 12 (RS) Ch1, 17dc, turn.
Continue to work Shoe Lace as folls:
Row 13 (WS) Ch20, 17dc across Row 12, ch20.
Fasten off, weave in ends.

## HAIR (MAKE APPROX. 25)

Using Yarn D, make magic ring.
Rounds 1-4 (RS) Rep Rounds 1-3 of Wing. [18 dc] Fasten off, leaving 20 cm tail for assembly.

## EAR (MAKE 2)

Using Yarn B, make magic ring.
Rounds 1-2 (RS) Rep Rounds 1-2 of Wing. [12 dc] Fasten off, leaving 20 cm tail for assembly.

## COLLAR

Using Yarn A, ch41.
Row 1 (WS) 1dc in second chain from hook and each chain to end, turn. [40 dc]
Row 2 (RS) 16dc, skip next st, 5tr in next st, skip next st, 2ss, skip next st, 5tr in next st, skip next st, $16 d \mathrm{~d}$. Fasten off, weave in ends. [32 dc, $10 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ss}$ ]

## ASSEMBLY

Use photo as a guide. Using straight sts, embroider nose in Yarn B, eyebrows in Yarn A and cheeks in Yarn C onto face. Stitch Hair pieces to Head, Arms to top of Dress, then Wings to back of Dress. Place Shoes on Legs and tie bow to secure. Place Collar around neck and tie to secure.

## TO FINISH

Weave in any remaining ends.


## TOOTH FAIRY DOOR HANGER By Liz Barraclough

## Measurements

$11 \times 27 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Pattern and Schematic Notes

Hanger is made from two layers of felt (forming Front and Back) and features a tooth-shaped Pocket with embroidery and an iron-on patch. Pocket is joined to Front using blanket stitch, Front and Back are then stitched together with Cardboard Insert sandwiched between. Refer to photo for placement of elements.
Refer to Simy's Studio blog for embroidery stitch instructions: bit.ly/simys-embroidery-tutorial. Schematic 1 below shows dimensions for Front, Back and Cardboard Insert. Schematic 2 (top right of page) shows the tooth-shaped Pocket at 100\%.

## Instructions

PREPARE FABRIC AND INSERT
Step 1 Fuse interlining to pieces of felt (follow manufacturer's instructions), then using Schematics 1-2, trace and cut out a Front and Back piece, one Cardboard Insert and one Pocket.
Step 2 Using black yarn, embroider eyes and mouth onto Pocket piece using stem or split stitches. Gently colour in cheeks using pink pencil.
Step 3 Position Pocket on Hanger, blanket stitch in place using white yarn, beginning at top left corner and ending at top right corner, leaving top edge open.

## ASSEMBLY

Step 4 Fuse iron-on fairy patch to Front side of Hanger (follow manufacturer's instructions), then using gold yarn, work straight stitches to create the fairy dust and star details between the fairy's wand to the top right edge of Pocket.
Step 5 Apply thin layer of glue to one side of Cardboard Insert. Stick glued side of insert to Back piece of Hanger, then glue other side of insert and stick to Front piece of Hanger, ensuring insert is positioned centrally and edges align all around. Step 6 Using gold or pink yarn, blanket stitch around hole and outer edges to secure layers.

## TVFINISH

Place Hanger over bedroom doorknob, put a tooth in the Pocket and wait for the tooth fairy to arrive!

Next row (RS) (K1, kfb) to end. [60 sts] Beg with a p row, work 21 rows in st st. Next row (RS) (K1, k2tog) to end. [40 sts] Beg with a p row, work 9 rows in st st.
Next row (RS) K1, (k2tog, k1) to end. [27 sts] Beg with a p row, work 5 rows in st st.
Next row (RS) (K1, k2tog) to end. [18 sts]
Beg with a p row, work 3 rows in st st. Rep last 4 rows twice more. [8 sts]
Next row (RS) (K2tog) to end. [4 sts]
Next row Purl.
Next row (K2tog) to end. [2 sts]
Break yarn and pull thread through rem sts, tighten and fasten off.

## TOOTH

## Main Piece

Using Yarn A, cast on 10 sts.
Row 1 (RS) (Kfb) to end. [20 sts]
Beg with a p row, work 3 rows in st st.
Next row (RS) (Kfb) to end. [40 sts]
Beg with a p row, work 5 rows in st st.
Next row (RS) K4, kfb, (k9, kfb) 3 times, k5.
[44 sts]
Beg with a p row, work 21 rows in st st.
Shape Roots
*Next row (RS) K11, turn.
Cont to work on these 11 sts only, placing rem sts on holder. Beg with a p row, work 3 rows in st st.
Next row K2tog, k7, k2tog. [9 sts]
Beg with a p row, work in stst for 3 rows.
Next row K2tog, k5, k2tog. [7 sts]
Next row Purl.

## Next row K2tog, k3, k2tog. [5 sts]

Next row Purl.
Break yarn and pull thread through rem sts, tighten and fasten off.
Rejoin yarn to sts on holder.
Rep from * to end of section 3 more times.

## Base

Using Yarn A, cast on 5 sts.
Row 1 (RS) (Kfb) to end. [10 sts]
Row 2 (WS) Purl.
Row 3 (Kfb) to end. [20 sts]
Beg with a p row, work 3 rows in st st.
Next row (RS) (Kfb) to end. [40 sts]
Next row Purl.
Shape Roots
*Next row (RS) K10, turn.
Cont to work in these 10 sts only, placing rem sts
on st holder. Beg with ap row, work 3 rows in st st.
Next row (RS) K2tog, k6, k2tog. [8 sts]
Beg with a p row, work 3 rows in st st.
Next row K2tog, k4, k2tog. [6 sts]
Next row Purl.
Next row K2tog, k2, k2tog. [4 sts]
Next row Purl.
Break yarn and pull thread through rem sts, tighten and fasten off.
Rejoin yarn to sts on holder.
Rep from * to end of section 3 more times.

## ASSEMBLY

Use photo as a guide.

## Toothbrush

Join row ends down centre back of Toothbrush

Main Piece using mattress st. Cut two rectangular pieces of stiff cardboard, measuring $45 \times 9 \mathrm{~cm}$. Lay knitted piece over cardboard, then cut seven 1 cm notches that correspond with shaped neck of Toothbrush. Slide cardboard pieces into Toothbrush and ease toy stuffing in between, being careful not to overstuff. Sew Toothbrush Base in place using mattress stitch. Fold Bristle piece along knitted fold lines, join cast-off edge of Bristle Sides to row ends of main Bristle piece, then join row ends of Sides to row ends of main Bristle piece, leaving an opening for stuffing. Before stuffing, oversew complete Bristle section in place on top of Toothbrush, then insert stuffing, being careful to maintain rectangular shape. Close seam. Join row ends of Toothpaste, leaving an opening for stuffing. Lightly stuff then close opening. Oversew Toothpaste onto Bristles. Tooth
Join row ends of Main Piece to beg of Root shaping using mattress stitch. Run a gathering thread through the cast-on sts and pull tightly to close. Join row ends of Tooth Base to the beg of Root shaping. Gather cast-on sts to close. Oversew Base to Main Piece aligning points of Roots and leaving an opening for stuffing. Stuff Tooth. Using a 30cm length of Yarn A, stitch through centre base of Tooth to centre top and back down again, pull thread to bring top of Tooth down slightly, then knot to secure. Using Yarn D, embroider features using straight sts and French knots, or create your own expressions! Weave in any rem ends.
