### FLYING BAT MUSIC BOX

#### Gauge/Tension

Tension is not critical for this project, but different measurements may result in different yarn amounts needed

#### Measurements

17 x 13cm (excluding hanging cord)

#### Abbreviations (UK terms)

[ ] number of stitches on a given row/round

**beg** begin(s)

**ch(s)** chain(s)

**cont** continue

**dc2tog** double crochet 2 together to decrease by 1 st: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up lp) twice, yoh, pull through both lps

**dc** double crochet

**lp(s)** loop(s)

**mr** magic ring

**prev** previous

**rem** remaining

**rep** repeat

**RS** right side(s)

**sk** skip(ped)

**ss** slip stitch(es)

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**tog** together

#### Special Abbreviation

Body, Ears and Bell Cover are worked using amigurumi method: work sts continuously in a spiral without closing each round with ss. Mark





first st of each round with st marker, moving it up as you go. Face and Wings are worked in rows: turn after each row. Body is worked using Yarn A, with occasional 3tr-cl sts using Yarn B; unused yarn is worked over (using tapestry crochet method) until required again.

To change colour, work final st in prev colour to last 2 lps on hook, yoh with new colour and draw through prev colour to finish.

## Instructions

### FACE

Using Yarn C, ch18.

**Row 1 (RS)** 1dc in second ch from hook (sk ch does not count as st), 2dc in next st, 13dc, 2dc in next st, 1dc, turn. [19 sts]

**Row 2 (WS)** Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), 1dc, 2dc in next st, 15dc, 2dc in next st, 1dc, turn. [21 sts]

**Row 3** Ch1, 1dc, 2dc in next st, 17dc, 2dc in next st, 1dc. [23 sts]

**Rows 4-7** Ch1, 23dc.

**Row 8** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 17dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [21 sts]

*Note: shaping of first brow beg here, not all sts in row are worked.*

**Row 9** Ch1, 8dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [10 sts]

**Row 10** Ch1, 7dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [9 sts]

**Row 11** Ch1, 6dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [8 sts]

**Row 12** Ch1, 5dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [7 sts]

**Row 13** Ch1, 4dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [6 sts]

**Row 14** Ch1, 3dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [5 sts]

**Row 15** Ch1, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc. [3 sts]

Fasten off and weave in ends.

*Note: shaping of second brow beg here.*

Join Yarn C with ss in same st as last dc of Row 9.

**Row 9** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 8dc, turn. [10 sts]

**Row 10** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 7dc. [9 sts]

**Row 11** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 6dc. [8 sts]

**Row 12** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 5dc. [7 sts]

**Row 13** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 4dc. [6 sts]

**Row 14** Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 3dc. [5 sts]

**Row 15** Ch1, (dc2tog) twice, 1dc. [3 sts]

**Next round** Ch1, dc evenly around circumference of piece just made, ss to first dc to join.

Fasten off, leaving 40cm tail for assembly.

### BODY

#### Leg (make 2)

Using Yarn A, make mr.

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, 6dc into ring. [6 sts]

**Round 2 (RS)** 2dc in each st around. [12 sts]

**Rounds 3-4** 12dc.

**Round 5** (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18 sts]

**Round 6** 18dc.

**Round 7** (1dc, 2dc in next st, 1dc) 6 times. [24 sts]

**Round 8** 24dc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Rep Rounds 1-8 for second Leg, do not fasten off.

*Note: following rounds join Legs tog.*

**Round 9** 11dc, 3dc in next st, working over first Leg: 23dc, 3dc in next st, working over rem sts of second Leg: 12dc. [52 sts]

Using photo as a guide, cont to work Rounds 10-17 in Yarn A, and use Yarn B to **replace** random sts in these rounds with one 3tr-cl. Alternate Yarns A and B using tapestry crochet method.

**Round 10** (6dc, 2dc in next st, 6dc) 4 times. [56 sts]

**Round 11** 56dc.

**Round 12** (7dc, 2dc in next st) 7 times. [63 sts]

**Round 13** 63dc.

**Round 14** (4dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc) 7 times.  
[70 sts]

**Rounds 15-17** 70dc.

Cont to replace random sts with one 3tr-cl in Rounds 18-36 but **do not** work random sts in the first 35 sts of each round, as Face will be attached over these 35 sts.

**Round 18** (6dc, dc2tog, 6dc) 5 times. [65 sts]

**Rounds 19-21** 65dc.

**Round 22** (11dc, dc2tog) 5 times. [60 sts]

**Rounds 23-25** 60dc.

Beg stuffing piece.

**Round 26** (5dc, dc2tog, 5dc) 5 times. [55 sts]

**Rounds 27-29** 55dc.

**Round 30** (9dc, dc2tog) 5 times. [50 sts]

**Rounds 31-33** 50dc.

**Round 34** (4dc, dc2tog, 4dc) 5 times. [45 sts]

**Rounds 35-36** 45dc.

With lower edge of Face aligned between Rounds 18 and 19 of Body, stitch Face to Body. Insert safety eyes between Rows 10 and 11 of Face with 9 sts in between.

Using black yarn, embroider nose and mouth on Face.

Insert music box into Body, removing pendant from pull cord, thread pull cord through sts between Legs and tie bell securely to pull cord.

Using Yarn B, work 20cm length of chs for hanging loop. Fasten off and thread tail through opening at top of music box, tie with knot to secure and weave in ends.

Cont to work Body, stuffing work and working

3tr-cl sts at random intervals.

**Round 37** (3dc, dc2tog) 9 times. [36 sts]

**Round 38** (1dc, dc2tog, 1dc) 9 times. [27 sts]

**Round 39** (1dc, dc2tog) 9 times. [18 sts]

**Round 40** (1dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [12 sts]

**Round 41** (Dc2tog) 6 times. [6 sts]

Fasten off, leaving 20cm tail. Thread tail through last 6 sts, pulling hanging loop through before pulling opening tight.

Weave in ends.

## BELL COVER

Using Yarn B, make mr.

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, 6dc into ring. [6 sts]

**Round 2 (RS)** 2dc in each st around. [12 sts]

**Round 3** (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18 sts]

**Rounds 4-8** 18dc.

**Round 9** (1dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [12 sts]

Insert bell.

**Round 10** (Dc2tog) 6 times. [6 sts]

**Rounds 11-12** 6dc.

Fasten off, leaving 20cm tail. Thread tail through last 6 sts, pull tight and weave in ends.

## EAR (MAKE 2)

Using Yarn A, make mr.

**Rounds 1-2** Rep Rounds 1-2 of Bell Cover.

**Rounds 3-4** 12dc.

**Round 5** (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18 sts]

**Round 6** 18dc.

**Round 7** 3dc (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times, 3dc. [24 sts]

**Round 8** 24dc.

Fasten off, leaving 20cm tail for assembly.

## WING PIECE (MAKE 4: 2 PER WING)

Using Yarn B, ch7.

**Row 1 (RS)** 1dc in second ch from hook (skip ch does not count as st), 5dc, turn. [6 sts]

**Rows 2 (WS)-4** Ch1, 6dc, turn. [6 sts]

**Row 5** Ch1, sk first st, 5dc. [5 sts]

**Row 6** Ch1, sk first st, 4dc. [4 sts]

**Row 7** Ch1, 4dc.

**Row 8** Ch1, sk first dc, 3dc. [3 sts]

**Row 9** Ch1, sk first dc, 2dc. [2 sts]

**Row 10** Ch1, 2dc.

**Row 11** Ch1, sk first st, 1dc. [1 st]

**Next round** Ch1, dc evenly around edge of Wing, working 3dc in corner sts.

Fasten off.

## Wing Assembly

### Left Wing

Use Schematic: Wing Assembly as reference. With RS facing of both pieces, join Yarn B with ss at point A, ss along right-hand side up to Point B, then along left-hand side of second piece down to Point A, place both pieces WS tog and working through adjacent sts, dc up to point B, joining both pieces tog. Fasten off, weave in ends. Rep for Right Wing.

## ASSEMBLY

Stuff Ears and stitch to Body piece: place top edge of each Ear 15mm from centre top of head and attach. Using Yarn B, stitch Wings to sides of Body.

## TO FINISH

Fasten off and weave in ends.

## EMBELLISHED WITCH HAT

### Measurements

31cm (crown height) x ø 48cm,  
fits max. 58cm head circumference

### Abbreviations

ø diameter

st(s) stitch(es)

### Pattern Notes

Witch Hat is made using 3mm-thick felt to give structure. Ease has been added to head circumference so Hat can sit lower down on forehead and to allow for thickness of felt. Seams are joined using whip sts, causing felt edges to butt up against each other and removing need for seam allowance. Metallic thread used for embellishment can be prone to fraying, as each strand is made up of two smaller metallic twisted strands. For easier stitching, use a larger needle, keep lengths short and follow instructions for knotting thread around eye.

### Make it for kids!

*To adapt for a child (head circ. 48cm with ease), make Hat with Crown height 27cm, cut ø 36cm ring for Brim with ø 17cm hole. Cut segment for Crown with 28cm sides and 53cm arc.*



## Instructions

### PREPARE FABRIC

#### Brim

**Step 1** Draw 32cm line down centre of cardboard strip, use pencil to poke small hole at both ends of line. Measure and mark 10cm and 24cm from one hole, and poke a hole at both points.

**Step 2** Lay paper down vertically, draw circle as close to bottom of paper as possible as follows: put pencil through hole at end of cardboard strip and hold steady while using other pencil in 24cm hole to draw ø 48cm circle. Keeping pencil at centre point, use 10cm hole to draw ø 20cm circle. Cut around outer circle, fold in half, and cut out and discard centre circle.

#### Crown

**Step 3** Draw 32cm vertical line 1cm in from top corner. Put pencils through holes at either end of cardboard strip and match up with either end of line. Hold lower pencil steady while drawing arc that's roughly a third of a circle. Use string to carefully measure around curve and mark point at 64cm. Draw 32cm line from this mark to end of vertical line. Cut out shape.

**Step 4** Pin shapes to felt and cut out Brim and Crown. Remove from felt and fold both paper patterns in half three times, creasing along folds each time. Open up again, and place back on matching felt pieces. Snip 8 tiny notches on inner Brim and 7 on curved edge of Crown in line with the creases to help with placement of pieces in Step 8.

### EMBELLISH CROWN

**Step 5** Arrange stars on Crown ensuring tips are positioned at least 2cm from edges. Following packet instructions, apply to felt using iron.

**Step 6** Cut 60cm length of silver thread and separate strands evenly into three lengths of two strands each. Using one length of two strands, fold in half and thread folded end through needle. Feed both ends through folded loop to make knot around eye of needle. Sew two 5mm straight stitches between points of 7 stars as shown.

### CONSTRUCT HAT

**Step 7** Fold Crown in half with right sides together and clip in place. With black thread, whip st along straight edge towards tip and turn through. Finger press seams flat.

**Step 8** Place Crown inside Brim, align notches and clip at these points. With black thread, whip st together along edge.

### POMPOM SPIDER

**Step 9** Wrap sides of ø 45mm pompom maker (or cardboard rings) with River Washed yarn, pass pipe cleaners through middle of ring before tying tightly with black sewing thread double stranded. Trim pompom. Bend pipe cleaners upwards, then downwards, then upwards to form legs. Glue on safety eyes.

### TO FINISH

Glue or stitch Spider to top of Brim, or, using black thread, dangle 5cm from underside of brim, attaching with a small stitch 8cm in from cut edge and quarter of way around from cone seam.

## LITTLE FRANKIE KNITTED TOY

### Gauge/Tension

25 sts and 38 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over st st using 3mm needles

### Measurements

Approx. 33.5 x 30cm

### Abbreviations

[ ] number of sts on a given row

**beg** beginning

**dec** decrease

**g st** garter stitch: knit all rows

**inc** increase

**k** knit

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together to dec by 1 st: insert needle kwise into first 2 sts and knit them together (left leaning dec)

**kfb** knit front and back to inc by 1 st: insert needle kwise into next st: knit as normal but don't slip st from needle, instead bring needle around to back and knit through back loop of same st

**kwise** knitwise

**p** purl

**p2tog** purl 2 sts together to dec by 1 st: insert needle pwise into first 2 sts and purl them together (right leaning dec)

**psso** pass slipped stitch over

**pwise** purlwise

**rep** repeat

**RS** right side

**sl1** slip 1 st kwise

**sm** stitch marker

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**st st** stocking stitch: RS knit, WS purl

**tbl** through back loop

**wyif** with yarn in front: bring working yarn to front of work (as if to purl)

**WS** wrong side(s)

\*.....; **rep from \* x times/to end work**

instructions after \* and then repeat that section as specified

### Pattern Notes

Main Body section is worked bottom up and flat in one piece, and in st st throughout. Work Right Leg separately then put aside, work Left Leg, then continue section joining both Legs together as you go. Arms are picked up and knitted directly onto Main Body section once assembled.

Jacket is worked separate, in st st with g st edging. Break yarn after each colour change.

### Instructions

#### MAIN BODY (MAKE 2)

##### Right Leg

Using Yarn A, cast on 20 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** K tbl to end. [20 sts]

**Row 2 (WS)** Purl.

Change to Yarn B.

Beg with a k row, work 8 rows in st st.

**Row 11** K to last 2 sts, k2tog. [19 sts]

**Row 12** P2tog, p to end. [18 sts]

**Row 13** Knit.

**Row 14** Cast off 8 sts, p to end. [10 sts]

Beg with a k row, work 6 rows in st st.

Change to Yarn C.

With RS facing and beg with a k row, work 28 rows in st st, break yarn. Place sts on st holder.

### Left Leg

Using Yarn A, cast on 20 sts.

**Rows 1-10** Work as for Right Leg.

**Row 11** K2tog, k to end. [19 sts]

**Row 12** P to last 2 sts, p2tog. [18 sts]

**Row 13** Cast off 8 sts, k to end. [10 sts]

Beg with a p row, work 7 rows in st st.

Change to Yarn C.

With RS facing and beg with a k row, work 28 rows in st st.

### Join Legs

**Next row (RS)** K across sts of Left Leg (already on needle), then k across sts of Right Leg. [20 sts]

**Next row (WS)** Purl.

**Next row (RS)** Kfb, k to last st, kfb. [22 sts]

**Next row** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 4 more times. [30 sts]

**Next row (RS)** Knit

**Next row (WS)** Purl.

### Mid-Section

Change to Yarn D.

Beg with a k row, work 12 rows in st st.

**Next row (RS)** K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. [28 sts]

**Next row (WS)** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 6 more times, placing sm in each end of third and twelfth rows for arm placement. [16 sts]

### Neck

Change to Yarn E.

Beg with a k row, work 6 rows in st st.

### Head

**Next row (RS) (inc)** Cast on 4 sts, k across these 4 sts, k to end. [20 sts]

**Next row (WS) (inc)** Cast on 4 sts, p across these 4 sts, p to end. [24 sts]

Beg with a k row, work 26 rows in st st.  
Cast off.

### RIGHT ARM

**Row 1 (RS)** Beg in marked st on Mid-Section, rejoin Yarn D and pick up and k 10 sts along edge to sm on Mid-Section. [10 sts]

\*Beg with a p row, work 15 rows in st st.

Change to Yarn E.

Beg with a k row, work 14 rows in st st.

**Next row (RS)** Kfb, k to last st, kfb. [12 sts]

**Next row (WS)** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [16 sts]

Beg with a k row, work 6 rows in st st.

**Next row (RS)** K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. [14 sts]

**Next row (RS)** P2tog, p to last 2 sts, p2tog. [12 sts]

Rep last 2 rows once more. [8 sts]

Cast off\*\*

### LEFT ARM

**Row 1 (RS)** Beg at marked st on Mid-Section, rejoin Yarn D and pick up and k 10 sts along edge to sm on Mid-Section.

Work as for Right Arm from \* to \*\*.

### MAIN JACKET

## Lower Back

Using Yarn F, cast on 76 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** K tbl to end. [76 sts]

**Rows 2 (WS)-4** Knit.

Buttonholes are created in Rows 5-6.

**Row 5** K2, cast off 2 sts, k to end. [74 sts]

**Row 6** K2, p to last 2 sts, cast on 2 sts, k2. [76 sts]

**Row 7** Knit.

**Row 8** K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 9** Knit.

**Row 10** Rep Row 8.

**Rows 11-12** Rep Rows 5-6.

**Rows 13-15** Rep Rows 7-9.

**Row 16** Rep Row 8.

**Rows 17-18** Rep Rows 5-6.

**Row 19** Knit.

**Row 20** Rep Row 8.

**Row 21** K2, sl1, k1, pss0, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. [74 sts]

**Row 22** K2, wyif sl1, p1, pss0, p to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2. [72 sts]

**Rows 23-28** Rep Rows 21-22 a further 3 times. [60 sts]

**Row 29** K2, sl1, k1, pss0, k10, turn, place unworked sts on st holder. [13 sts]

## Right Front

**Row 30 (WS)** P9, p2tog, k2. [12 sts]

**Row 31 (RS)** K2, sl1, k1, pss0, k8. [11 sts]

**Row 32** P7, p2tog, k2. [10 sts]

**Row 33** K2, sl1, k1, pss0, k6. [9 sts]

**Row 34** P5, p2tog, k2. [8 sts]

**Row 35** K2, sl1, k1 pss0, k4. [7 sts]

**Row 36** P3, p2tog, k2. [6 sts]

**Row 37** K2, sl1, k1, pss0, k2. [5 sts]

**Row 38** P1, p2tog, k2. [4 sts]

**Row 39** Knit.

**Row 40** P2, k2.

Cast off.

## Upper Back

**Row 1 (RS)** Rejoin Yarn F and work sts on st holder: k2tog, k29, k2tog, leave remaining unworked 13 sts on st holder. [31 sts]

**Row 2 (WS)** P2tog, p to last 2 sts, p2tog. [29 sts]

Beg with a p row, work 11 rows in st st.

Cast off.

## Left Front

**Row 1 (RS)** Rejoin Yarn F and work sts on st holder: k9, k2tog, k2. [12 sts]

**Row 2 (WS)** K2, wyif sl1, p1, pss0, p8. [11 sts]

**Row 3** K7, k2tog, k2. [10 sts]

**Row 4** K2, wyif sl1, p1, pss0, p6. [9 sts]

**Row 5** K5, k2tog, k2. [8 sts]

**Row 6** K2, wyif sl1, p1, pss0, p4. [7 sts]

**Row 7** K3, k2tog, k2. [6 sts]

**Row 8** K2, wyif sl1, p1, pss0, p2. [5 sts]

**Row 9** K1, k2tog, k2. [4 sts]

**Row 10** K2, p2.

**Row 11** Knit.

Cast off.

## JACKET SLEEVE (MAKE 2)

Using Yarn F, cast on 22 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** K tbl to end. [22 sts]

**Rows 2 (WS)-5** Knit.

Beg with a p row, work 25 rows in st st.

Cast off.

## PATCH (MAKE 2: 1 IN YARN F, 1 IN YARN C)

Cast on 5 sts, work 7 rows in g st.

Cast off.

## ASSEMBLY

Weave in ends and block pieces if desired.

Use photo as a guide for assembly.

With WS together, join both Main Body pieces, using mattress stitch and matching colours.

Leave approx. 3cm gap to add stuffing, being careful not to overstuff and distort shape.

Using Yarn B, sew Yarn F patch onto Leg.

With WS together, join Jacket Sleeves to Main Jacket using mattress stitch and matching colours.

Sew on buttons, aligning with buttonholes.

Using Yarn B, sew Yarn C patch onto jacket.

## Hair

Cut 40 x 15cm lengths of Yarn B, fold in half and insert through Head using a tapestry needle or crochet hook. Thread ends through loop and pull to secure. Work in sts along top ridge of Head. Trim ends to desired length.

## Face

Using black embroidery thread, embroider face details using back st.

## Bolt

Using Yarn A, work one French knot on each side of Neck.

## TO FINISH

Weave in any remaining ends.
