SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

ccA changing colour from Yarn B to Yarn A after last ss of round: place Yarn B in front of work, insert hook under working Yarn B and in ch-2 sp, yoh with Yarn A, pull loop through ch-2 sp and Yarn B loop to complete ss, ch1, turn, 1dc in ch-2 sp

ccB changing colour from Yarn A to Yarn B after last ss of round: turn work, place Yarn A at front of work and Yarn B at back of work, insert hook under working Yarn A and in ch-2 sp, yoh with Yarn B, pull loop through ch-2 sp and Yarn A loop to complete ss, ch1, insert hook in ch-2 sp and under working yarn, (1dc, ch2, place Yarn A at back of work, 1dc) in ch-2 sp to complete cnr

moss st 1dc in ch-1 sp, ch1, sk 1 dc (or row end)

mtr mosaic treble crochet: work treble st in sk st two rows below in same colour, working in front of ch-2 sps

PATTERN NOTES

Crochet version of Goldcrest Scarf consists of one Central Square with an Arrow Section, Stripe Section, Triangle Section, Mosaic Section and Continuation of Stripe Section on either side. After Central Square, each subsequent section is first worked on either side before working next section. Carefully refer to schematic throughout for the colour order of each half. Stripes are added using a join-as-you-go method.

Central Square is worked in the round, turning at the end of each round during colour change; all other sections are worked in turned rows.

Aside from Mosaic Section, all parts are worked in moss st.

In Mosaic Section, cc in last st in row.

Beg ch1 does not count as st throughout, unless otherwise stated.

INSTRUCTIONS

CENTRAL SQUARE

Note: in this section, do not carry unused yarn colour after changing colour but leave hanging until required for next colour change.

Using 4mm hook and Yarn A, make magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) (1dc, ch1, 1dc, ch2 (forms cnr)) 4 times into ring, ss to first dc, ccB. [8 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, 4 cnr ch-2 sps]

Round 2 (WS) *Ch1, sk 1 dc, moss st to cnr, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in cnr; rep from * twice, ch1, sk 1 dc, moss st to cnr, ss to first dc, ccA. [12 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, 4 cnr ch-2 sps]

Round 3 *Ch1, sk 1 dc, moss st to cnr, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in cnr; rep from * twice, ch1, sk 1 dc, moss st to cnr, place Yarn B at front of work, (1dc, ch2) in first cnr, ss to first dc, ccB.

[16 dc, 12 ch-1 sps, 4 cnr ch-2 sps]

Round 4 *Ch1, sk 1 dc, moss st to cnr, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in cnr; rep from * around, omitting last cnr, ss to first dc, ccA.

[20 dc, 16 ch-1 sps, 4 cnr ch-2 sps]

Rounds 5-26 Rep Rounds 3-4 a further 11 times, omitting ccA on last round. [108 dc, 104 ch-1 sps, 4 cnr ch-2 sps]

Fasten off Yarn A only, continue with Yarn B for Arrow Section. Central Square is now complete.

ARROW SECTION

Note: Arrow Section is worked in two parts to set straight border edges of Scarf; 2 sides of Central Square will be worked in Yarn B and then 2 sides in Yarn A to form two arrows. St counts stay the same for each row.

With RS facing and using Yarn B, work back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (RS) Beg in next ch-1 sp, moss st to cnr, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in cnr, ch1, sk 1 dc, moss st to next cnr, turn.

[54 dc, 52 ch-1 sps, 1 cnr ch-2 sp]

Row 2 (WS) Sk first dc, moss st to cnr, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in cnr, ch1, sk next dc, moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn.

Rows 3-9 Rep Row 2 a further 7 times.

Fasten off Yarn B.

For second Arrow, turn work so unworked edges of Central Square are facing up.

With RS facing, join Yarn A with ss to cnr ch-2 sp on right-hand side of Central Square.

Rep Rows 1-9 to create second Arrow.

Fasten off.

STRIPE SECTION

Stripes are decreased at straight edges of Scarf, and have a straight edge at the other end. When joining Stripes with join-as-you-go method later on, you will work into row-ends along this straight edge.

Stripe 1

With WS facing, join Yarn C with ss to last dc of Arrow Section.

Row 1 (WS) Moss st to cnr, 1dc in cnr, ch1, turn.

[27 dc, 26 ch-1 sps]





Row 2 (RS) Sk first dc, moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn. [26 dc, 25 ch-1 sps]
Row 3 Sk first dc, moss st to end, 1dc in last ch of 2 rows below, ch1.
Rows 4-9 Rep Rows 2-3 a further 3 times. [23 dc, 22 ch-1 sps]
 Fasten off.

Stripe 2

With RS facing, join Yarn D with ss to first dc of last row of Arrow Section.

Row 1 (RS) Moss st to cnr of Arrow Section, ch1, 1dc in first row end of Stripe 1, *ch1, sk next row end of Stripe 1, 1dc in next row end; rep from * to end, ch1, turn. [31 dc, 30 ch-1 sps]

Row 2 (WS) Moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn. [30 dc, 29 ch-1 sps]

Row 3 Moss st to end, 1dc in last ch of 2 rows below, ch1.

Rows 4-9 Rep Rows 2-3 a further 3 times. [27 dc, 26 ch-1 sps]
 Fasten off.

Stripe 3

With WS facing, join Yarn E with ss to last dc made in Yarn D of Stripe 2.

Row 1 (WS) Ch1, moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn. [26 dc, 25 ch-1 sps]

Row 2 (RS) Sk first dc, moss st to end, 1dc in first ch of 2 rows below, ch1, turn.

Row 3 Sk first dc, moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp. [25 dc, 24 ch-1 sps]

Rows 4-9 Rep Rows 2-3 a further 3 times. [22 dc, 21 ch-1 sps]
 Fasten off.

Stripe 4

With WS facing, join Yarn F with ss to first dc of last row of Stripe 1.

Row 1 (WS) Moss st to end of Stripe 1, ending with 1dc in final ch-1 sp of Stripe 1, work 4 moss sts in total in row ends of Stripe 2, then work 5 moss sts in total in row ends of Stripe 3 ending with 1dc in final row end of Stripe 3, ch1, turn. [31 dc, 30 ch-1 sps]

Row 2 (RS) Sk first dc, moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn. [30 dc, 29 ch-1 sps]

Row 3 Sk first dc, moss st to end, 1dc in last ch of 2 rows below, ch1.

Rows 4-9 Rep Rows 2-3 a further 3 times. [27 dc, 26 ch-1 sps]
 Fasten off.

Stripe 5

With RS facing, join Yarn C with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 4.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 3.

Stripe 6

With RS facing, join Yarn D with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 3.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 4, working across row ends of Stripes 4 and 5.

Stripe 7

With WS facing, join Yarn F with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 6.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 3.

Stripe 8

With WS facing, join Yarn E with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 5.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 4, working across row ends of Stripes 6 and 7.

Stripe 9

With RS facing, join Yarn D with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 8.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 3.

Stripe 10

With RS facing, join Yarn C with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 7.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 4, working across row ends of Stripes 8 and 9.

Stripe 11

With WS facing, join Yarn F with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 10.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 3.

Stripe 12

With WS facing, join Yarn E with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 9.

Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 4, working across row ends of Stripes 10 and 11.

Rotate Scarf to work along opposite side of Arrow Section.

With WS facing, join Yarn C to last dc of last row of Arrow in Yarn B.

Rep Stripes 1-12.

TRIANGLE SECTION

Refer to schematic for colour sequence.

With RS facing, join Yarn A with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 11.

Row 1 (RS) Moss st to end; working 4 moss sts in total in row ends of Stripe 12, ending with 1dc in final row end of Stripe 12, ch1, turn. [26 dc, 25 ch-1 sps]

Row 2 (WS) Sk first dc, moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn. [25 dc, 24 ch-1 sps]

Row 3 Sk first dc, moss st to end, 1dc in last ch of 2 rows below, ch1.

Rows 4-49 Rep Rows 2-3 a further 23 times. [2 dc, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 50 1dc in last ch-1 sp. [1 dc]

Row 51 1dc in last ch of Row 49. [1 dc]

Fasten off.

Rotate Scarf to rep Triangle Section on opposite side of Scarf using Yarn B.

MOSAIC SECTION

Refer to schematic for colour sequence.

Both written instructions and chart are given.

Note: when changing yarn colours, old yarn is carried up side of work, and after changing colours, old colour is then dropped rather than carried until needed for next colour change.

With WS facing, join Yarn G with ss to first dc of last row of Stripe 12.

Row 1 (WS) Moss st to end of Stripe 12, continue working moss sts to end of Triangle Section; working 1dc in every odd-numbered row end and ending with 1dc in final row end, turn.

[52 dc, 51 ch-1 sps]

Change to 3.5mm hook.

Row 2 (RS) Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), 1dc in first dc, 1dc in each ch-1 sp, 1dc in every dc to second to last dc, ch1, sk second to last dc, 1dc in last ch-1 sp, turn. [101 dc, 1 ch-1 sp]





Row 3 Moss st once, 1dc in each dc to end, cc to Yarn E.

[100 dc, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 4 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, ch2, sk 1 dc, 6dc, (ch3, sk 2 dc, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 dc, 10dc) 5 times, ch3, sk 2 dc, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 dc, 4dc, ch1, sk 1 dc, 1dc in ch-1 sp. [74 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 5 Moss st once, (1dc in each dc, ch3 over every ch-3 sp, ch2 over every ch-2 sp) to end, cc to Yarn G.

[73 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 6 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, 1mtr, 4dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 8dc) to last 13 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp (leave last dc unworked).

[48 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp, 25 mtr]

Row 7 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 12 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 6dc, cc to Yarn E.

[72 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 8 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, ch2, sk 1 st, 2dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 8dc) to last 13 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp.

[46 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp, 24 mtr]

Row 9 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 10 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch2, sk 1 st, 1dc, cc to Yarn G. [69 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 10 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, 1mtr, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 8dc) to last 13 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp.

[44 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp, 25 mtr]

Row 11 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 8 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, cc to Yarn E.

[68 dc, 12 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 12 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, ch2, sk 1 st, (2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 8dc, ch3, sk 2 sts) to last 11 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp.

[44 dc, 11 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp, 24 mtr]

Row 13 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 6 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch2, sk 1 st, 1dc, cc to Yarn G.

[67 dc, 11 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 14 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, 1mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, (8dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr) to last 5 sts, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp. [44 dc, 11 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp, 23 mtr]

Row 15 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 4 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, cc to Yarn E.

[66 dc, 11 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 16 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, ch2, sk 1 st, 2mtr, (8dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr) to last 5 sts, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp. [44 dc, 10 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp, 22 mtr]

Row 17 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 2 sts, ch2, sk 1 st, 1dc, cc to Yarn G.

[65 dc, 10 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 18 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, 1mtr, (8dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr) to last 5 sts, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp.

[44 dc, 10 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp, 21 mtr]

Row 19 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to end, cc to Yarn E. [64 dc, 10 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-1 sp]

Row 20 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, ch2, sk 1 st, 6dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 8dc) to last 13 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2mtr, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, dc in ch-1 sp.

[42 dc, 10 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp, 20 mtr]

Row 21 Moss st, 3dc, (ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 10dc) to last 14 sts, ch3, sk 2 sts, 2dc, ch3, sk 2 sts, 6dc, ch2, sk 1 st, 1dc, cc to Yarn G. [61 dc, 10 ch-3 sps, 1 ch-2 sp, 1 ch-1 sp]

**

Rows 22-37 Rep from ** to ** once more.

Rows 38-49 Rep from ** to end of Row 17.

Fasten off Yarn E, cont with Yarn G only.

Row 50 Ch1, 1dc in first dc, 1mtr, (10dc, 2mtr, 2dc, 2mtr) 3 times, 2dc, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-1 sp. [40 dc, 1 ch-1 sp, 13 mtr]

Row 51 Moss st, 1dc in every st to end. [52 dc, 1 ch-1 sp]

Change to 4mm hook.

Row 52 Ch2 (counts as turning ch and ch-1), 1dc in second st, (ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in next st) 25 times (last dc is placed in ch-1 sp of Row 51). [26 dc, 26 ch-1 sp]

Fasten off.

Turn Scarf to rep Mosaic Section on opposite side of Scarf, starting with Yarn G and using **Yarn C** instead of Yarn E.

Mosaic Section is now complete.

Continuation of Stripe Section

Refer to schematic for colour sequence.

With RS facing, join Yarn D with ss to last st of Triangle Section.

Work along straight side of Mosaic Section. When working Row 1, work dc sts in even-numbered row ends, placing last dc in first ch of Row 52.

Stripe 13

Row 1 (RS) Ch1, moss st to final row end working first dc in same sp, 1dc in final row end, ch1, turn. [27 dc, 26 ch-1 sps]

Row 2 (WS)-9 Rep Rows 2-9 of Stripe 1.

Stripe 14

With WS facing, join Yarn F with ss to last dc of last row of Mosaic Section.

Rows 1-9 As Rows 1-9 in Stripe 2.

Stripe 15

With RS facing, join Yarn E with ss to last dc made in Yarn F of Stripe 14.

Rows 1-9 As Rows 1-9 in Stripe 3.

Stripe 16

With RS facing, join Yarn C with ss to first dc of last row of Stripe 13.

Rows 1-9 as Rows 1-9 in Stripe 4.

Stripe 17

With WS facing, join Yarn D with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 16.

Rows 1-9 as Rows 1-9 in Stripe 3.

Stripe 18

With WS facing, join Yarn F with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 15.

Rows 1-9 As Rows 1-9 in Stripe 4.

Stripe 19

With RS facing, join Yarn A with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 17.

Row 1 (RS) Work moss st to last ch-1 sp of Stripe 17, 1dc in ch-1 sp, ch1, work moss st 4 times in total till last dc of Row 9 of Stripe 18, 1dc in this last dc, turn. [27 dc, 26 ch-1 sps]

Row 2 (WS) Moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn. [26 dc, 25 ch-1 sps]

Rows 3-9 Rep Row 2. [19 dc, 18 ch-1 sps]

Stripe 20

With WS facing, join Yarn A with ss to first dc of last row of Stripe 18.

Row 1 (WS) Work moss st 26 times, 1dc in last dc of Row 1 of Stripe 19, turn. [27 dc, 26 ch-1 sps]





Row 2 (RS) Moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp, turn.

[26 dc, 25 ch-1 sps]

Rows 3-9 Rep Row 2. [19 dc, 18 ch-1 sps]

Stripe 21

With WS facing, join Yarn B with ss to last st of last row of Stripe 19.

Row 1 (WS) Moss st to final ch-1 sp, 1dc in ch-1 sp.

[18 dc, 17 ch-1 sps]

Rows 2-9 Rep Row 1, decreasing with 1 dc and 1 ch-sp every row. [10 dc and 9 ch-1 sps]

Stripe 22

With RS facing, join Yarn B with ss to last dc of last row of Stripe 20.

Rows 1 (RS)-9 Rep Rows 1-9 of Stripe 21.

Row 10 (WS) 1dc in first ch-1 sp, (ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in next ch-1 sp)

8 times, ch2, 1dc in side of first dc of Row 9, (ch1, sk one row end, 1dc in next row end) 17 times, ch2, 1dc in first ch-1 sp of Row 9, (ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in next ch-1 sp of Row 9) 8 times, turn.

[36 dc, 33 ch-1 sps, 2 ch-2 sps]

Row 11 1dc in first ch-1 sp, (ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in next ch-1 sp) 7 times, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-2 sp, (ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in next ch-1 sp)

17 times, ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in ch-2 sp, (ch1, sk 1 st, 1dc in next ch-1 sp) 8 times, ch1, fasten off. [35 dc, 34 ch-1 sps]


Turn Scarf to rep Continuation of Stripe Section on opposite side of Scarf. Work Stripes 19 and 20 in Yarn B, and Stripes 21 and 22 in Yarn A.

TO FINISH

Weave in ends.
