



Blue Tit Cushion Crochet Version

CROSS STITCH EMBROIDERY

Working from marked center outwards, work blue tit pattern following schematic.

To make an individual cross stitch:

Thread tapestry needle with a length of Cahlista suitable for area to be stitched and no longer than 80cm.

Step 1 Insert needle from back of fabric to front at bottom left corner, leaving 5cm tail.

Step 2 Insert needle from front of fabric to back at top right.

Step 3 Insert needle from back of fabric to front at bottom right.

Step 4 Insert needle from front of fabric to back at top left, ensuring stitch lays smooth and flat.

To work multiple cross stitches as once: beginning at bottom of a vertical section of cross stitches to be worked, repeat Steps 1-2 to create rows of half cross stitches, then repeat Steps 3-4 to complete the stitches along the row.

To secure ends, use the tapestry needle tip to gently separate the Cahlista strands evenly into two. Use 2.5mm crochet hook to pull one half under a nearby Cahlista stitch at back of work. Tie the two together in a reef (square) knot around stitch and trim ends to 1.5cm.
