DUPLICATE STITCH EMBROIDERY

Working from marked centre outwards, work blue tit pattern following schematic.

Work duplicate stitches as follows:

Thread tapestry needle with a length of Cahlista for area to be stitched no longer than 80cm.

Step 1 Insert needle from back of fabric to the front, emerging at the bottom of the 'v' where stitch is to be placed, leaving 4 cm tail hanging on back.

Step 2 Pass needle beneath stitch above, under both strands of Scrumptious.

Step 3 Pass needle back through the bottom of the stitch where you started in Step 1, creating a duplicate stitch on top, ensuring stitch lays smooth and flat.

Step 4 Continue working in any direction until the colour section is complete or yarn is running out, then cut yarn at back to 6 cm.

To secure ends, use tapestry needle tip to gently separate the Cahlista strands evenly into two. Use the 2.5mm crochet hook to pull one half under a nearby Cahlista stitch at back of work. Tie the two together in a reef (square) knot around stitch and trim ends to 1.5cm.

Repeat Steps 1-4 for all remaining colour sections.










Blue Tit Cushion Knit Version Schematic
