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MATERIALS

Colourway shown above

Simy's Studio Yarn Truth DK Weight (100% Superwash Merino Wool; 100g/300m)

63 You are what you eat x 1 skein

Simy's Studio Yarn Hope DK Weight (100% Superwash Merino Wool; 100g/300m)

02 For everything there is a season x 1 skein 4mm and 4.5 mm crochet hooks

GAUGE/TENSION

28 sts and 28 rows to measure $10 \times 10 \text{cm}$ over Ribbing Swatch using a 4mm hook (see below)

Ribbing Swatch

Using 4.5mm hook, ch28.

Change to 4mm hook.

Row 1 (**RS**) Ss in back bump of second fch from hook, 27ss in back bumps of fchs, turn. [28 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1 tightly (does not count as st throughout), 28yohss blo, turn.

Row 3 Ch1 tightly, 28ss blo.

Row 4 Ch1 tightly, 28yohss blo.

Rep Rows 3-4 a further 12 times.

Fasten off and block to measurements.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dbl-ehtr double back loop extended htr: yoh, insert hook first in next st blo, then in following st blo, pull up loop, yoh, draw through 1 loop, yoh, draw through all 3 loops

dbl-htr double back loop htr: yoh, insert hook first in next st blo,

then in following st blo, pull up loop, yoh, draw through all 3 loops **dec-ss** slip stitch decrease: insert hook first in next st blo and then in following st blo, yoh, pull up loop and draw through loop on hook **ehtr** extended htr: yoh, insert hook in next st blo, pull up loop, yoh, draw through 1 loop, yoh, draw through 3 loops

e-yohss edge yohss: work yohss but insert hook from back to front to twist it, tighten it by pulling the yarn. This will help to create a neat and reliable ribbing edge

inc-ss slip stitch increase: insert hook first in blo of st just worked and then into next st blo, pull up loop and draw through 1 loop p2l-yohss 2 loops yarn over hook slip stitch: insert hook under 2 top loops of turning ch, yoh and place between working loop and turning ch loops, secure in place with finger (4 loops on hook), insert hook into next st blo, yoh, pull up loop and draw through all 4 loops on hook

set set of 9 stitches: yohss, ch1, dbl-htr, ch1, dbl-ehtr, ch1, dbl-htr, ch1, skip next st, yohss. Ch is counted as 1 st throughout ss-w insert hook in blo of st just worked, work ss yohss yarn over hook slip stitch: yoh, insert hook in next st blo, pull up loop, draw through 2 loops.

PATTERN NOTES

Hat is made flat, in panels working up from ribbing to crown and back down to ribbing to produce strips. Repeating panels are connected as you go. After finishing panels, side seam is sewn. The stitch pattern is created using short rows and slip stitch variations, smoothly integrated into the ribbing. Always work into back bumps when working into foundation chains. Ch1 at bottom edge of ribbing should be pulled tight and does not count as st throughout. Work into blo of each st unless instructed otherwise. When applicable rem st count of row below is given in st count in *italics*.

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INSTRUCTIONS

Set-up Panel

Using 4.5mm hook, ch51 (57: 63).

Change to 4mm hook.

Row 1 (**RS**) Ch1 tightly (does not count as st throughout), 1ss in back bump of second fch from hook, 12ss in back bumps of fchs, leave rem chs unworked, turn. [12 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 11yohss, 1e-yohss, turn. [12 sts]

Row 3 Ch1, 9ss. [9 sts, 3 sts]

Row 4 Ch1, 8yohss, 1e-yohss. [9 sts]

Row 5 Ch1, 8ss, inc-ss, ss-w, p2l-yohss, 2yohss, p2l-yohss, 5yohss, leave rem chs unworked. [19 sts]

Row 6 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 10 sts]

Row 7 Ch1, set, p2l-yohss, 5yohss, leave rem chs unworked. [15 sts]

Row 8 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 6 sts]

Rep Rows 7-8 once (twice: 3 times) more.

Row 9 Ch1, set, p2l-yohss, 4yohss, leave rem chs unworked. [14 sts]

Row 10 Ch1, 8yohss. [8 sts, 6 sts]

Row 11 Ch1, 1yohss, ch1, dbl-htr, ch1, dbl-ehtr, ch1, dbl-htr, 1yohss, p2l-yohss, 4yohss, leave rem chs unworked. [13 sts]

Row 12 Ch1, 7yohss. [7 sts, 6 sts]

Row 13 Ch1, 1yohss, ch1, (dbl-htr, ch1) twice, skip one blo, 1yohss, p2l-yohss, 7yohss, leave rem chs unworked. [15 sts]

Row 14 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 6 sts]

Row 15 Ch1, set, p2l-yohss, 2yohss. [12 sts]

Row 16 Ch1, 12yohss, p2l-yohss, 2yohss. [15 sts, 3 sts]

Cont with Main Panel, starting with Row 17.

Main Panel

Row 1 (RS) Ch1, 12ss, turn. [12 sts, 3 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 11yohss, 1e-yohss, turn. [12 sts]

Row 3 Ch1, 9ss. [9 sts, 3 sts]

Row 4 Ch1, 8yohss, 1e-yohss. [9 sts]

Row 5 Ch1, 8ss, inc-ss, ss-w, (p2l-yohss, 2yohss) 3 times. [19 sts, *3 sts*]

Row 6 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 10 sts]

Row 7 Ch1, set, (p2l-yohss, 2yohss) twice. [15 sts, 3 sts]

Row 8 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 6 sts]

Rep Rows 7-8 once (twice: 3 times) more.

Row 9 Ch1, set, p2l-yohss, 2yohss, p2l-yohss, 1yohss. [14 sts, 2 sts]

Row 10 Ch1, 8yohss. [8 sts, 6 sts]

Row 11 Ch1, 1yohss, ch1, dbl-htr, ch1, dbl-htr, ch1, dbl-htr,

(1yohss, p2l-yohss) twice, 2yohss. [13 sts, 2 sts]

Row 12 Ch1, 7yohss. [7 sts, 6 sts]

Row 13 Ch1, 1yohss, ch1, (dbl-htr, ch1) twice, skip next st,

(1yohss, p2l-yohss) twice, 5yohss. [15 sts, 3 sts]

Row 14 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 6 sts]

Row 15 Ch1, set, p2l-yohss, 2yohss. [12 sts]

Row 16 Ch1, 12yohss, p2l-yohss, 2yohss. [15 sts, 3 sts]

Row 17 Ch1, 1yohss, ch1, dbl-htr, ch1, skip next st, 2yohss. [6 sts, 9 sts]

Row 18 Ch1, 6yohss, (p2l-yohss, 2yohss) twice. [12 sts, 3 sts]

Row 19 Ch1, 7yohss. [7 sts, 5 sts]

Row 20 Ch1, 1yohss, ch1, skip next st, (dbl-htr, ch1) twice, 1yohss, (p2l-yohss, 2yohss) twice. [13 sts, 3 sts]

Row 21 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 4 sts]

Row 22 Ch1, set, (p2l-yohss, 2yohss) twice. [15 sts, 3 sts]

Row 23 Ch1, 9yohss. [9 sts, 6 sts]

Rep Rows 22-23 once (twice: 3 times) more.

Row 24 Ch1, set, p2l-yohss, 2yohss, p2l-yohss, 8yohss, 1e-yohss. [22 sts]

Row 25 Ch1, 11ss, dec-ss. [12 sts, 9 sts]

Row 26 Ch1, 11 yohss, 1e-yohss. [12 sts]

Row 27 Ch1, 12ss, p2l-yohss, 2yohss. [15 sts, 6 sts]

Row 28 Ch1, 14yohss, 1e-yohss. [15 sts]

Rep complete Main Panel instructions a further 10 (11: 12) times. Fasten off leaving 50cm yarn tail.

ASSEMBLY

Sew side seam from ribbing to crown using mattress stitch. Pull needle through every single loop of turning chains at crown edge and pull tight, rep twice more.

TO FINISH

Weave in ends and block to measurements.

The short-row variations and textures of the hat are highlighted in changing shades, echoing the movement of light across the surface of water
