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MATERIALS

Blue version

Scheepjes Colour Crafter Parade (100% Premium Acrylic (Anti Pilling); 300m/100g)
Yarn A 404 Green Blend x 2 (2: 2: 2: 2) balls
Yarn B 605 Mountain Lake x 2 (2: 2: 2: 2) balls
Yarn C 405 Blue Blend x 2 (2: 2: 2: 2) balls
Scheepjes Colour Crafter (100% Premium Acrylic (Anti Pilling); 300m/100g)
Yarn D 1820 Goes x 1 (1: 1: 1: 1) ball

Pink version

Scheepjes Terrazzo (70% Recycled Mulesing Free Wool, 30% Recycled Viscose; 175m/50g)
Yarn A 721 Lampone x 2 (2: 3: 3: 3) balls
Yarn B 722 Anguria x 2 (2: 3: 3: 3) balls
Yarn C 723 Rosa x 2 (2: 3: 3: 3) balls
Yarn D 745 Pergamena x 1 (1: 1: 1: 1) ball

Both versions

4mm crochet hook
 Stitch markers

GAUGE/TENSION

15 sts and 9 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over tr using a 4mm hook

PATTERN NOTES

Sweater is worked bottom up in four pieces, back, front, and two sleeves. Sleeves are worked in the round. Unless otherwise instructed turn your work at the end of each row/round. Change colour during the final yoh of the st before the colour change.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back

Using Yarn A, ch79 (85: 94: 100: 109).

Row 1 (RS) 1tr in fourth ch from hook (sk ch-3 count as 1 tr), 1tr in each ch to end, turn. [77 (83: 92: 98: 107) tr]

Row 2 (WS) Ch2(counts as a st here and throughout), (1FPtr, 1BPtr) to end (end: last st: last st: to end), 0 (0: 1: 1: 0) FPtr, turn.

Row 3 Ch2, 0 (0: 1: 1: 0)FPtr, (1BPtr, 1FPtr) to end.

Row 4 Ch2, (1FPtr, 1BPtr) to end (end: last st: last st: end), 0 (0: 1: 1: 0)FPtr.

Rows 5-12 (12: 13: 13: 14) Ch3(counts as 1 tr throughout), 1tr in each st to end.

Row 13 (13: 14: 14: 15) Ch3, 1tr, sk 2 sts, (3tr in next st, sk 2 sts) to last st, 2tr in last st.

Row 14 (14: 15: 15: 16) Change to Yarn D, ch3, 3tr in each sp to end, 1tr in last st.

Row 15 (15: 16: 16: 17) Ch3, 1tr in first sp, 3tr in each sp to last sp, 1tr in last sp.

Row 16 (16: 17: 17: 18) Change to Yarn B, ch3, 3tr in each sp to end, 1tr in last st.

Rows 17-28 (17-28: 18-30: 18-30: 19-32) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end. [77 (83: 92: 98: 107) sts]

Row 29 (29: 31: 31: 33) Ch3, 1tr, sk 2 sts, (3tr in next st, sk 2 sts) to last st, 2tr in last st.

Row 30 (30: 32: 32: 34) Change to Yarn D, ch3, 3tr in each sp to end, 1tr in last st.

Row 31 (31: 33: 33: 35) Ch3, 1tr in first sp, 3tr in next sp to last sp, 2tr in last sp.

Row 32 (32: 34: 34: 36) Change to Yarn C, ch3,

3tr in each sp to end, 1tr in last st.

Rows 33-44 (33-44: 35-47: 35-47: 37-50) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end. [77 (83: 92: 98: 107) sts] Fasten off.

Front

Rep Rows 1-39 (39: 42: 42: 45) of Back then continue with Right shoulder.

Right shoulder

Row 40 (40: 43: 43: 46) Ch3, 25 (28: 32: 35: 39)tr. [26 (29: 33: 36: 40) tr]

Row 41 (41: 44: 44: 47) Ch3, tr2tog, 1tr in each st to end. [25 (28: 32: 35: 39) tr]

Row 42 (42: 45: 45: 48) Ch3, 1 tr in each st to last 2 sts, tr2tog. [24 (27: 31: 34: 38) tr]

Row 43 (43: 46: 46: 49) Ch3, tr2tog, 1tr in each st to end. [23 (26: 30: 33: 37) tr]

Row 44 (44: 47: 47: 50) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end.

With WS of Front and Back panel together, ch1 and close shoulder seam by working 1 ss

through the next 23 (26: 30: 33: 37) sts of both panels.

Fasten off.

Left shoulder

With WS facing, sk 25 (25: 26: 26: 27) sts from **Row 39 (39: 42: 42: 45)** and join yarn with ss in next st.

Row 40 (40: 43: 43: 46) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end. [26 (29: 33: 36: 40) tr]

Row 41 (41: 44: 44: 47) Ch3, 1tr in each st to last 2 sts, tr2tog. [25 (28: 32: 35: 39) tr]

Row 42 (42: 45: 45: 48) Ch3, tr2tog, 1tr in each st to end. [24 (27: 31: 34: 38) tr]

Row 43 (43: 46: 46: 49) Ch3, 1tr in each st to last 2 sts, tr2tog. [23 (26: 30: 33: 37) tr]

Row 44 (44: 47: 47: 50) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end.

With WS together, ch1 and seam your shoulders by working 1 ss through the next 23 (26: 30: 33: 37) sts on both panels.

Fasten off.

Sleeve (make 2)

Using Yarn A, loosely ch30 (30: 33: 33: 36), ss to first ch to form a ring.

Round 1 (RS) Ch2, 29 (29: 32: 32: 35)tr, ss to top of beg 2-ch to join, do not turn. [30 (30: 33: 33: 36) sts]

Round 2 (RS) Ch2, (1FPtr, 1BPtr) to last st (last st: end: end: last st), 1 (1: 0: 0: 1)FPtr, ss to top of beg 2-ch, do not turn.

Round 3 Rep Round 2.

Round 4 Ch2, (1FPtr, 1BPtr) to last st (last st: end: end: last st), 1 (1: 0: 0: 1)FPtr, ss to top of beg 2-ch, turn.

Round 5 Ch3, 1tr in st at base of ch, 2tr in each st to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch. [60 (60: 66: 66: 72) sts]

Rounds 6-12 (12: 13: 13: 14) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 13 (13: 14: 14: 15) Ch3, 2tr in st at base of ch, sk 2 sts, (3tr in next st, sk 2 sts) to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 14 (14: 15: 15: 16) Change to Yarn D, ch3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in each sp to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 15 (15: 16: 16: 17) Ch3, 2tr in first sp,



3tr in each sp to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 16 (16: 17: 17: 18) Change to Yarn B, ch3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in each sp to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Rounds 17-28 (17-28: 18-30: 18-30: 19-32)
Ch3, 1tr in each st to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.
[60 (60: 66: 66: 72) sts]

Round 29 (29: 31: 31: 33) Ch3, 2tr in st at base of ch, sk 2 sts, (3tr in next st, sk 2 sts) to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 30 (30: 32: 32: 34) Change to Yarn D, ch3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in each sp to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 31 (31: 33: 33: 35) Ch3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in each sp to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Round 32 (32: 34: 34: 36) Change to Yarn C, ch3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in each sp to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.

Rounds 33-44 (33-44: 35-47: 35-47: 37-50)
Ch3, 1tr in each st to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch.
Fasten off.

Neckline edging

Join Yarn C to any st at the back neck.

Round 1 (RS) Ch3, 1tr in each st along back neckline, 10tr evenly along neckline row ends, then 1tr in each st along the front neckline, 10tr evenly along neckline row ends, then 1tr in each st to end, ss to top of beg 3-ch, do not turn.

Round 2 (RS) Ch2, (1FPtr, 1BPtr) to end, ss to top of beg 2-ch, do not turn.

Round 3-4 Rep Round 2.

Round 5 Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, ss to top of beg 1-ch, fasten off.

TO FINISH

With WS facing out, place a marker in the 16th (16th: 17th: 17th: 18th) row down from your shoulder seam. Join yarn with ss to the bottom hem and seam front and back panels up to the marker by working 2dc through each row end on both panels. From your marker continue to seam your Sleeve in same way.

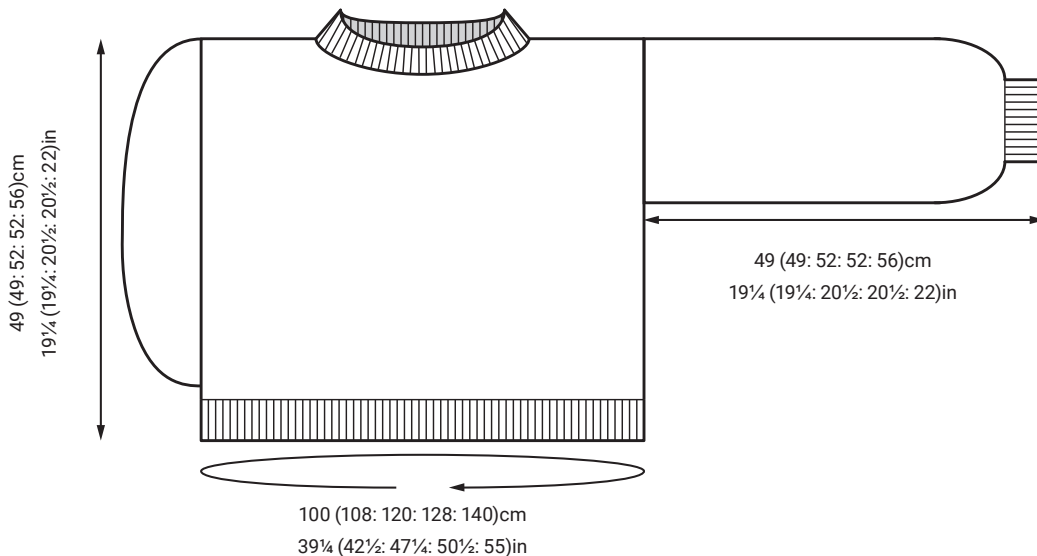
Weave in all ends and block to measurements.

Tip!

Are you using Terrazzo to crochet the sweater? Then it is recommend to hand wash the sweater only, at a maximum temperature of 30°C. To prevent possible further felting, the item should be washed separately, with minimal agitation. Excess water should be gently squeezed out, rather than wrung.
