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### MATERIALS

#### Scheepjes Stone Washed Minerals

(78% Cotton, 22% Acrylic; 50g/130m)

**Yarn A** 903 Sapphire Serenade x 3 (4: 4: 4: 5) balls

**Yarn B** 907 Amethyst Mist x 3 (3: 3: 4: 4) balls

**Yarn C** 905 Limestone Lush x 3 (3: 3: 4: 4) balls

**Yarn D** 908 Rhodonithe Radiance x 3 (3: 3: 4: 4) balls

#### Scheepjes Stone Washed

(78% Cotton, 22% Acrylic; 50g/130m)

**Yarn E** 813 Amazonite x 1 (1: 1: 2: 2) ball(s)

5mm crochet hook

Stitch markers

### GAUGE/TENSION

17 sts and 10 rows to measure 10 x 10cm over patt using a 5mm hook

### PATTERN NOTES

Back and Front are worked in rows. Sleeves are worked in the round.

Front, Back and Sleeves have a row that is worked on top and bottom, to level edge of patt.

Ss ribbing using the JAYG (join-as-you-go) method is attached after pieces have been worked. Rib is worked at a right angle to the piece and is attached to hem edge by ss.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Back

Using 5mm hook and Yarn A, ch81 (92: 98: 107: 115).

**Foundation row (RS)** 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each ch to end, turn. [80 (91: 97: 106: 114) dc]

**Row 1 (WS)** Ch3 (does not count as st throughout), 1tr in next 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, \*2tr in each of next 3 sts, sk 1 st, (1tr in next st, sk 1 st) 5 times, 2tr in each of next 3 sts; rep from \* 3 (4: 4: 5: 5) more times, 1tr in next 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, turn. [80 (91: 97: 106: 114) tr]

**Row 2** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, turn.

Rows 1-2 set patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 12cm.

Change to Yarn B.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 24cm.

Change to Yarn C.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 36cm.

Change to Yarn D.\*\*

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 48 (49: 50: 51: 52)cm and finish after a Row 2. Next row levels edge.

**Next row (WS)** Ch1, 1dc in next 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, \*(3dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr, 3tr, 2htr, 3dc); rep from \* to last 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, 1dc in each st to end. [12 (6: 12: 4: 12) dc and 4 (5: 5: 6: 6) patt reps of (3dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr, 3tr, 2htr, 3dc)]  
Fasten off.

Next row levels hem edge.

With WS facing, join Yarn A to other side of

starting chain at hem edge.

**Next row** Ch1, 1tr in next 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, \*(3tr, 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr); rep from \* to last 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, 1tr in each st to end. [12 (6: 12: 2: 12) tr and 4 (5: 5: 6: 6) patt reps of (3tr, 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr)]

Fasten off.

Pm either side of 30 (31, 31, 32, 34) sts at centre for Neck.

### Ribbing (see Pattern Notes)

With RS facing, join Yarn E to first st of hem edge.

Ch10.

**Row 1** Ch1, ss blo in each st to end, ss in next 2 sts of hem edge, turn. [10 ss along rib]

**Row 2** Ch1, sk 2 ss of hem edge, ss blo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Rows 1-2 across hem edge.

Fasten off.

### Front

Work as for Back until \*\*.

Cont in patt until you have worked 8 rows less than Back, finishing after a Row 2.

### Shape Neck

**Next row (WS)** Ch1, 1dc in next 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, \*(3dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr, 3tr, 2htr, 3dc); rep from \* to last 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, 1dc in each st to end. [12 (6: 12: 4: 12) dc and 4 (5: 5: 6: 6) patt reps of (3dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr, 3tr, 2htr, 3dc)]

**Row 1 (RS)** Ch3, 25 (30: 33: 35: 40)tr, turn and work on these sts only for left side. [25 (30: 33: 35: 40) tr]

**Row 2** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, turn. [25 (30: 33: 37: 40) dc]

Rep last 2 rows twice more, then rep Row 1 again.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, sk 30 (31: 31: 32: 34) sts and join yarn to next st.

**Row 1 (RS)** Ch3, 1tr in each st to end, turn. [25 (30: 33: 37: 40) tr]

**Row 2** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, turn. [25 (30: 33: 37: 40) dc]

Rep last 2 rows twice more, then rep Row 1 again.

Fasten off.

Next row levels hem edge.

With WS facing join Yarn A to other side of starting chain at hem edge.

**Next row** Ch1, 1tr in next 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, \*(3tr, 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr); rep from \* to last 6 (3: 6: 2: 6) sts, 1tr in each st to end. [12 (6: 12: 4: 12) tr and 4 (5: 5: 6: 6) patt reps of (3tr, 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr)]

Fasten off.

### Ribbing (see Pattern Notes)

With RS facing, join Yarn E to first st of hem edge.

Ch10.

**Row 1** Ch1, ss blo in each st to end, ss across 2 sts of hem edge, turn. [10 ss for rib]

**Row 2** Ch1, sk 2 ss of hem edge, ss blo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Rows 1-2 across hem edge.

Fasten off.



### Sleeve (make 2)

*Note: Sleeve is worked in the round and turned.*  
Using 5mm hook and Yarn A, ch68 (72: 74: 78: 82).

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), 1dc in each ch around, ss in first dc to close, turn. [68 (72: 74: 78: 82) dc]

**Round 2** Ch3 (does not count as st throughout), 0 (2: 3: 5: 7)tr, \*2tr in each of next 3 sts, sk 1 st, (1tr in next st, sk 1 st) 5 times, 2tr in each of next 3 sts; rep from \* 3 more times, 0 (2: 3: 5: 7)tr, ss to top of beg 3-ch, turn. [68 (72: 74: 78: 82) tr]

**Round 3** Ch1, 1dc in each st around, ss in first dc, turn. [68 (72: 74: 78: 82) dc]  
These last 2 rounds set patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 11cm.

Change to Yarn B.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 22cm.

Change to Yarn C.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 33cm.

Change to Yarn D.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 44cm.

Next round levels the edge.

**Next round (WS)** Ch1, 1dc in next 0 (2: 3: 5: 7) sts, \*(3dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr, 3tr, 2htr, 3dc); rep from \* to last 0 (2: 3: 5: 7) sts, 0 (2: 3: 5: 7)dc, ss in first st. [0 (4: 6: 10: 14) dc and 4 patt reps of (3dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr, 3tr, 2htr, 3dc)]  
Fasten off.

Next round levels hem edge.

With WS facing, join Yarn A to other side of starting chain at hem edge at beg of round.

**Next round** Ch3 (does not count as st), 1tr in next 0 (2: 3: 5: 7) sts, \*(3tr, 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr); rep from \* to last 0 (2, 3, 5, 7) sts, 1tr in each st to end, ss in top of beg 3-ch to join. [0 (4: 6: 10: 14) tr and 4 patt reps of (3tr, 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 3tr, 1dtr)]

**Next round** Ch1 (does not count as st), dc2tog all around. [34 (36: 37: 39: 41) dc2tog]  
Fasten off Yarn A, join Yarn E and ss in each st to complete round, do not fasten off. [34 (36: 37: 39: 41) ss]

### Ribbing (see Pattern Notes)

Using Yarn E, ch10.

**Row 1** Ch1, ss blo in second ch from hook and in each ch to end, ss across 2 sts of body, turn. [10 ss for rib]

**Row 2** Ch1, sk 2 ss, ss blo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Rows 1-2 across cuff edge.

### Neckband

*Note: St counts are not given as row tension may not be matched exactly, so you may have more (or fewer) row ends.*  
Join shoulder seams.

**Round 1** Using 5mm hook and Yarn D, join yarn to back neck at left shoulder seam, ch1 (does not count as st), 1dc in same st, 2dc around each tr row end and 1dc around each dc row end down left front, 1dc in each st across front, 2dc around each tr row end and 1dc around

each dc row end up right front, 1dc in marked st, 1dc in each st across back, ss in first dc to join.

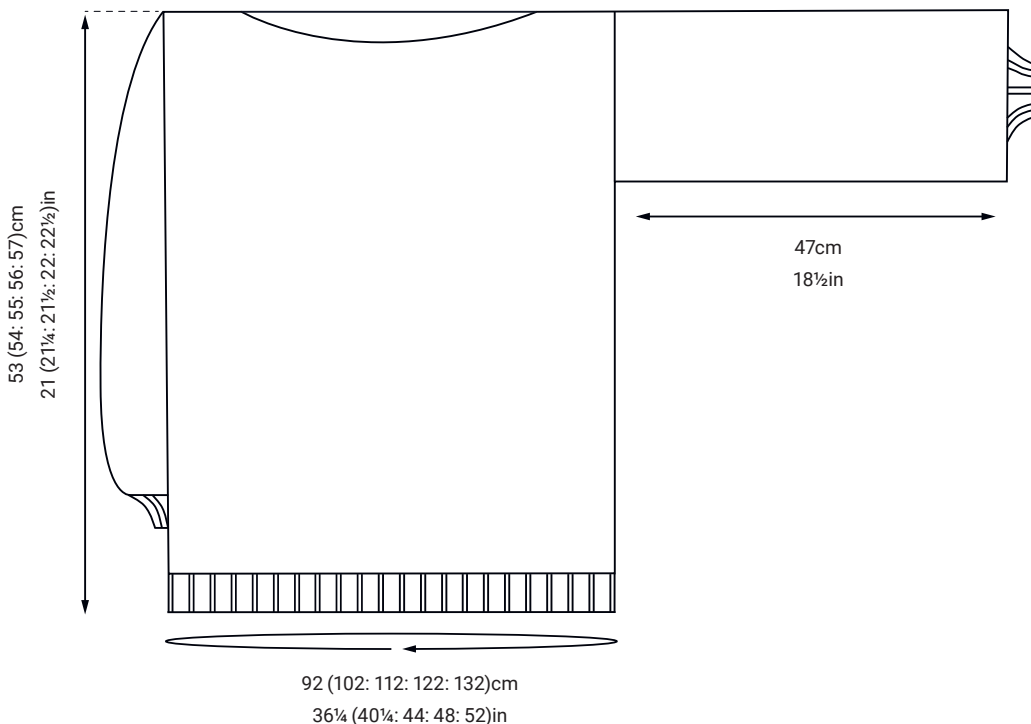
**Round 2** Ss in each st around to prevent neckline from sagging, ss in first ss.

### TO FINISH

Block pieces. Mark a point 20 (21: 22: 23: 24) cm down from shoulder seam on Back and Front. Sew side seams to this point. Sew in Sleeves.
