Crochet Pattern: Tiny Toadstools



TINY TOADSTOOLS

By Scheepjes Design

Materials

Scheepjes Little Darling (100% Polyester; 50g/90m)

Yarn A 401 Ice Bear x 1 ball

Yarn B 417 Strawberry x 1 ball

Yarn C 404 Teddy Bear x 1 ball

3.5mm crochet hook

Stitch marker

Polyester stuffing

Measurements

Small Mushroom approx. 11cm (4¼in) tall

Large Mushroom approx. 15cm (6in) tall

Gauge/Tension

Gauge/Tension is not critical for this project, although different measurements may result in different yarn amounts needed. Keep the stitches tight to prevent the stuffing from showing through the fabric.

Pattern Notes

Mushrooms are worked bottom up in one piece using amigurumi method. Work sts continuously in a spiral without closing each round with ss. Mark first st of each round with stitch marker, moving it up as you go. Stuff Mushrooms as you go. Sew White Dots to Mushroom cap.

Abbreviations (UK terms)

[] number of sts on a given round

dc double crochet

dc2tog double crochet 2 sts together to decrease by 1 st: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) twice, yoh, draw through all loops

flo front loop(s) only: insert hook under front loop(s) only

inc 2dc in same st

RS right side

ss slip stitch(es)

st(s) stitch(es)

yoh yarn over hook

(.....) **once/twice/3 times** work instructions between brackets the *total* number of times stated

Instructions

SMALL MUSHROOM

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 7dc into ring. [7 dc]

Round 2 (RS) (Inc) 7 times. [14 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, inc) 7 times. [21 dc]

Round 4 (2dc, inc) 7 times. [28 dc]

Round 5 (3dc, inc) 7 times. [35 dc]

Round 6 (4dc, inc) 7 times. [42 dc]

Rounds 7-8 1dc in each st around.

Round 9 (5dc, inc) 7 times. [49 dc]

Round 10-15 1dc in each st around.

Round 16 (5dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [42 dc]

Rounds 17-18 1dc in each st around.

Round 19 (4dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [35 dc]

Rounds 20-21 1dc in each st around.

Change to Yarn B.

Round 15 (4dc flo, inc flo) 7 times. [42 dc]

Round 16 (5dc, inc) 7 times. [49 dc]

Round 17 (6dc, inc) 7 times. [56 dc]

Round 18 (7dc, inc) 7 times. [63 dc]

Rounds 19-20 1dc in each st around.

Round 21 (7dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [56 dc]

Round 22 (6dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [49 dc]

Round 23 (5dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [42 dc]

Round 24 (4dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [35 dc]

Round 25 (3dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [28 dc]

Round 26 (2dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [21 dc]

Round 27 (1dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [14 dc]

Round 28 (Dc2tog) 7 times. [7 dc]

Fasten off, weave tail through flo of sts, pull tight to close gap and weave in end.

LARGE MUSHROOM

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 7dc into ring. [7 dc]

Round 2 (RS) (Inc) 7 times. [14 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, inc) 7 times. [21 dc]

Round 4 (2dc, inc) 7 times. [28 dc]

Round 5 (3dc, inc) 7 times. [35 dc]

Round 6 (4dc, inc) 7 times. [42 dc]

Rounds 7-12 1dc in each st around.

Round 13 (4dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [35 dc]

Rounds 14-17 1dc in each st around.

Round 18 (3dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [28 dc]

Rounds 19-22 1dc in each st around.

Change to Yarn C.

Round 23 (3dc flo, inc flo) 7 times. [35 dc]

Round 24 (4dc, inc) 7 times. [42 dc]

Round 25 (5dc, inc) 7 times. [49 dc]

Round 26 (6dc, inc) 7 times. [56 dc]

Round 28 (7dc, inc) 7 times. [63 dc]

Round 29 1dc in each st around.

Round 30 (7dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [56 dc]

Round 31 1dc in each st around.

Round 32 (6dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [49 dc]

Round 33 1dc in each st around.

Round 34 (5dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [42 dc]

Round 35 1dc in each st around.

Round 36 (4dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [35 dc]

Round 37 1dc in each st around.

Round 38 (3dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [28 dc]

Round 39 1dc in each st around.

Round 40 (2dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [21 dc]

Round 41 1dc in each st around.

Round 42 (1dc, dc2tog) 7 times. [14 dc]

Round 43 1dc in each st around.

Round 44 (Dc2tog) 7 times. [7 dc]

Fasten off, weave tail through flo of sts, pull tight to close gap and weave in end.

WHITE DOT

(Make 11 for Small Mushroom, 15 for Large Mushroom)

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 6dc into ring, ss in first dc. [6 dc]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

TO FINISH

Sew White Dots to Mushroom caps, placing Dots wherever you like. Weave in any remaining ends.
