







Tidelines Hats

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MATERIALS

Scheepjes Cotton Create DK (50% Recycled Cotton, 50% Premium Cotton; 50g/100m)

Yarn A 656 Spin x 2 balls

Yarn B 713 Explore (green) or 671 Fasten off (rust) x 1 ball

3.75mm crochet hook (or size needed to achieve gauge)

1 x stitch marker

GAUGE/TENSION

10 rounds of Crown measure 10cm/4in over dc using a 3.75mm hook

MEASUREMENTS

Child size given (to fit approx. age 5-9), with Adult size in brackets:
Crown 13 (14.5)cm / 5 (5¾)in
Circumference at top of contrast band 53 (60)cm / 21 (23½)in
Crown to bottom of Brim length 12 (14: 15*)cm / 4¾ (5½: 6*)in
(*Adult Hat size with option for longer Brim)

ABBREVIATIONS (UK TERMS)

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

false st false stitch: st lying over sk st created by nj

nj needle join(ed): cut yarn with 15cm tail; lift lp with hook until tail emerges then thread tail onto needle, sk next st and insert needle from front to back through both lps of foll st, insert needle down through st where tail emerged and under back bump through to reverse, pulling gently to create false st identical in size standing dc standing double crochet: make sI knot on hook, insert hook in st from front to back whilst holding sI knot in place with index finger, yoh, pull Ip through to front and up to working height, flip yarn tail out of way, yoh, draw through both lps on hook

PATTERN NOTES

Crown and Sides are worked in a spiral without closing each round with ss. Pm in first st of every round ('marked st'), moving it up as you go. Brim is worked in rounds. For neatest finish and to minimise jog, note instructions on joining new yarn, or use your own preferred method. Incs on Sides and Brim are staggered for a smoother curve.

INSTRUCTIONS CHILD HAT CROWN

Using Yarn A, make magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) (2dc, 2htr, 8tr) into ring, pull tail to partially close opening. [2 dc, 2 htr, 8 tr]

Round 2 2dc in each st around, pull tail firmly to close opening. [24 dc]

Round 3 and every alt round to Round 13 1dc in each st around.

Round 4 (2dc in next st, 1dc) 12 times. [36 dc] **Round 6** (2dc in next st, 2dc) 12 times. [48 dc]

Round 8 (2dc in next st, 3dc) 12 times. [60 dc] **Round 10** (2dc in next st, 4dc) 12 times. [72 dc]

Round 12 (2dc in next st, 5dc) 12 times. [84 dc]

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Round 13 1dc in each st to last st, nj to marked st creating false st over last dc, fasten off. [84 dc]

ADULT HAT CROWN

Rounds 1-12 Rep Rounds 1-12 of Child Hat Crown. [84 dc]

Round 13 1dc in each st around.

Round 14 (2dc in next st, 6dc) 12 times. [96 dc] Round 15 1dc in each st to last st, nj to marked st creating false st over last dc, fasten off. [96 dc]

CHILD HAT SIDES

Round 1 Rejoin Yarn A with standing dc in blo of marked st, 1dc blo in each st around. [84 dc blo]

Note: cont working in a spiral through both lps of st.

Round 2 1dc in standing dc, 3dc, (2dc in next st, 27dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 23dc. [87 dc]

Round 3 and every alt round to Round 13 1dc in each st around.

Round 4 (2dc in next st, 28dc) 3 times. [90 dc] **Round 6** 19dc, (2dc in next st, 29dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 10dc. [93 dc]

Round 8 9dc, (2dc in next st, 30dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 21dc. [96 dc]

Round 10 26dc, (2dc in next st, 31dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 5dc. [99 dc]

Round 12 18dc, (2dc in next st, 32dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 14dc. [102 dc]

Round 13 1dc in each st to last st, nj to marked st creating false st over last st, fasten off. [102 dc]

Round 14 Join Yarn B with standing dc in marked st, 101dc. [102 dc]

Round 15 Ss to standing dc (counts as st), 101dc. [1 ss, 101 dc]

Round 16 1dc in ss, 1dc, (2dc in next st, 33dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 31dc. [105 dc]

Rounds 17-18 1dc in each st around.

Round 19 1dc in each st to last st, nj to marked st, fasten off. [105 dc]

ADULT HAT SIDES

Round 1 Rejoin Yarn A with standing dc in blo of false st created by nj, 1dc in blo of marked and each st to standing dc. [96 dc blo]

Round 2 Cont in a spiral, ss to standing dc (counts as st), 5dc, (2dc in next st, 7dc) 11 times, 2dc in next st, 1dc in last st.

[1 ss. 107 dc]

Rounds 3-6 1dc in each st around.

Round 7 (2dc in next st, 35dc) 3 times. [111 dc]

Rounds 8-10 1dc in each st around.

Round 11 14dc, (2dc in next st, 36dc) twice, 2dc in next st, 22dc. [114 dc]

Rounds 12-14 1dc in each st around. **Round 15** (2dc in next st, 37dc) twice, 2dc in

next st, 36dc to last st, nj to marked st, fasten off. [117 dc]

Note: work measures 6.5cm from Crown to this point.

Round 16 Join Yarn B with standing dc in

marked st, 1dc in next and each st around. [117 dc]

Rounds 17-21 1dc in each st around. Note: work measures 9cm from Crown to this point.

Round 22 1dc in each st to last st, nj in marked st, fasten off. [117 dc]

BRIM

Work in nj rounds (see Special Abbreviations). Fasten off at end of each round. To best disguise join at end of round, do not weave in ends straightaway. This enables you to check standing dc looks identical once foll round is completed, and to tighten sl knot if necessary. Tapestry needle can also be used to manipulate st.

If a single colour Brim is preferred, simply cont working in a spiral. Replace standing dc with dc from Round 2 up to final round. Replace nj with dc in final st up to penultimate round.

CHILD HAT BRIM

Round 1 Join Yarn A with standing dc in marked st, 104dc, nj to second st of round, creating false st over standing dc. [105 dc] Round 2 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, (2dc in next st, 20dc) 4 times, 2dc in next st, 19dc, nj to second st of round. [110 dc]

Round 3 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 109dc, nj to second st of round. [110 dc]

Round 4 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 5dc, (2dc in next st, 10dc) 9 times, 2dc in next st, 4dc, nj to second st of round. [120 dc]

Round 5 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 119dc, nj to second st of round. [120 dc]

Round 6 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 1dc, (2dc in next st, 11dc) 9 times, 2dc in next st, 9dc, nj to second st of round. [130 dc]

Round 7 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 129dc, nj to second st of round. [130 dc]

Round 8 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, (2dc in next st, 12dc) 9 times, 2dc in next st, 11dc, nj to second st of round. [140 dc]

Round 9 Count 4 sts back form false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 139dc, nj to second st of round [140 dc]

Round 10 Join Yarn B by pulling lp through any st at back of Hat from back to front, ss in each st to where first lp emerged, nj to first ss. [140 ss]

ADULT HAT BRIM

Round 1 Join Yarn A with standing dc in marked st, 1dc in each st, nj to second st of round, creating false st over standing dc. [117 dc]

Round 2 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 5dc, (2dc in next st, 12dc) 8 times, 2dc in next st, 6dc, nj to second st of round. [126 dc]

Round 3 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 125dc, nj to second st of round. [126 dc]

Round 4 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 12dc, (2dc in next st, 13dc) 8 times, 2dc in last st, nj to second st of round. [135 dc]

Round 5 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 134dc, nj to second st of round. [135 dc]

Round 6 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 3dc, (2dc in next st, 14dc) 8 times, 2dc in next st, 10dc, nj to second st of round. [144 dc]

Round 7 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 143dc, nj to second st of round. [144 dc]

Round 8 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 13dc, (2dc in next st, 15dc) 8 times, 2dc in next st, 1dc, nj to second st of round. [153 dc]

Round 9 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 152dc, nj to second st of round. [153 dc]

Note: check Brim size at this point. If happy with length, proceed to Round 12. For longer Brim, proceed to Round 10.

Round 10 Count 3 sts forward from false st and join Yarn B with standing dc, 4dc, (2dc in next st, 16dc) 8 times, 2dc in next st, 11dc, nj to second st of round. [162 dc]

Round 11 Count 4 sts back from false st and join Yarn A with standing dc, 161dc, nj to second st of round. [162 dc]

Round 12 Join Yarn A by pulling lp through any st at back of Hat from back to front, ss in every st to where first lp emerged, nj to first ss. [162 ss]

TO FINISH

Weave in all ends and block to measurements.

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
