



In this part, we will create a lacy brook all the way around our meadow. I chose this pattern because it reminds me of dappled water. And who doesn't love a bit of dappled water or dappled shade? Or better yet, a combination of the two!



If you know that you make your chains much tighter than your other stitches (I'm looking at you, Yankers!), please be mindful of not making your chain stitches too tight! This part will be wonky, but the next part will start pulling it into shape.

The chart for Rounds 27 – 37 is at the end of Round 37.

## Round 27

Join your yarn by making a standing **BPtr** in any FPtr from Round 26. You will find these FPtr sts at the tip of each Large Petal. **BPtr** in the rem 447 sts\*. Join to the top of the first BPtr with a sl st.

Stitch Count: 448 BPtr

\*Of these 447 sts, 112, 224, and 336 should fall in a FPtr – not including the first standing RPtr

### Round 28

Ch 1, dc in the same st as the sl st join. Dc in the next 2 sts.

(Ch 5, skip the next 3 sts, tr in the next 3 sts. Ch 5, skip the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts) **31** times. Ch 5, skip the next 3 sts, tr in the next 3 sts. Ch 5, skip the next 3 sts, dc in the last 2 sts. Join to the first dc with a sl st. **TURN**.

Stitch Count: 160 dc, 96 tr, and 64 ch-5 sps

**Checkpoint for 5-dc group above a FPtr from Round 26:** The third dc should fall in the BPtr made into the FPtr.

# Round 29

With **WS facing**, ch 1, dc in the same st as the sl st join and the next st.

(Ch 5, skip the next dc, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 1, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 5, skip the next dc, dc in the next 3 dc) 31 times. Ch 5, skip the next dc, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 1, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 5, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Join to the first dc with a sl st. TURN.

**Stitch Count: 96** dc, **192** tr, **32** ch-1 sps, and **64** ch-5 sps

### Round 30

With **RS facing**, ch 7 (counts as tr and ch-4).

(Make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp, ch 3, make a tr in the next ch-1 sp, marking this tr with a **SM** on the first repeat. Ch 3, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 4, skip the next dc, tr in the next dc. Ch 4, skip the next dc) **31** times. Make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp, ch 3, make a tr in the next ch-1 sp. Ch 3, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 4, join to the third ch of the beg ch-7 with a sl st. Fasten off and **TURN**.

Stitch Count: 256 tr, 64 ch-3 sps, and 64 ch-4 sps

### Round 31

When making the dc sts in this round, make sure to place the first and last one of each repeat close to the tr between ch-3 sps. Do the same with the 3-tr groups that bracket a tr.

With **WS facing**, join your yarn by making a standing dc in the marked tr from the previous round. Remove the SM. Dc in the next ch-3 sp.

(Ch 5, make 3 tr in the next ch-4 sp. Ch 1, make 3 tr in the next ch-4 sp. Ch 5, dc in the next ch-3 sp, dc in the next tr, dc in the next ch-3 sp) 31 times. Ch 5, make 3 tr in the next ch-4 sp. Ch 1, make 3 tr in the next ch-4 sp. Ch 5, dc in the next ch-3 sp. Join to the first dc with a sl st. TURN.

**Stitch Count: 96** dc, **192** tr, **32** ch-1 sps, and **64** ch-5 sps.

## Round 32

When making the dc sts in this round, make sure to place the first and last one of each repeat close to the 3 dc sts between ch-5 sps.

With **RS facing**, ch 1, dc in the same st as the sl st join and the next st. Dc in the next ch-5 sp. (Ch 5, make 3 tr in the next ch-1 sp. Ch 5, dc in the next ch-5 sp, dc in the next 3 dc, dc in the next ch-5 sp) **31** times. Ch 5, make 3 tr in the next ch-1 sp. Ch 5, dc in the next ch-5 sp, dc in the last dc. Join to the first dc with a sl st. **TURN**.

**Stitch Count: 160** dc, **96** tr, and **64** ch-5 sps.

### Round 33

With **WS facing**, ch 1, dc in the same st as the sl st join and the next st.

(Ch 5, skip the next dc, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 1, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 5, skip the next dc, dc in the next 3 dc) 31 times. Ch 5, skip the next dc, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 1, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 5, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Join to the first dc with a sl st. TURN.

Stitch Count: 96 dc, 192 tr, 32 ch-1 sps, and 64 ch-5 sps

## Round 34 (As 30 except SM different)

With **RS facing**, ch 7 (counts as tr and ch-4).

(Make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp, ch 3, make a tr in the next ch-1 sp. Ch 3, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 4, skip the next dc, tr in the next dc. Ch 4, skip the next dc) 31 times. Make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp, ch 3, make a tr in the

**last** ch-1 sp. This tr should fall above the point of a Large Flower Petal. Mark this tr with a **SM**. Ch 3, make 3 tr in the next ch-5 sp. Ch 4, join to the third ch of the beg ch-7 with a sl st. Fasten off and **TURN**.

**Stitch Count: 256** tr, **64** ch-3 sps, and **64** ch-4 sps

As Round 31.

### Round 37

This round is a bit tedious so that we can introduce some landmarks (Stitch Markers) to make the next round easier to keep track of.

With **WS facing**, ch 3, tr in the next 2 dc.

(Make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 3 tr, make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 5 dc) twice. Mark the post of the 2<sup>nd</sup> tr of the last 5-tr group with a SM.

\*(Make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 3 tr, make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 5 dc) 4 times. Mark the post of the 2<sup>nd</sup> tr of the last 5-tr group with a SM.\*


Repeat from \* to \* 6 more times.

Make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 3 tr, make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 5 dc.

Make 5 tr in the next ch-5 sp, tr in the next 3 tr, make 5 tr in the last ch-5 sp, tr in the last 2 dc. Join to the top of the beg ch-3 with a sl st. Mark this beg ch-3 with a different coloured SM so that you can identify it from the other marked sts in the next round. Please don't remove this marker until I politely point out that you may do so. Fasten off and work away your ends.

Stitch Count: 576 tr
