

### Round 38

With **RS facing**, join your yarn by making a standing **BPtr** around the marked beg ch-3 from the previous round. You may now remove the SM. **BPtr** around each of the next **37 sts**. The last BPtr should fall in a marked st from the previous round. Remove the SM and use it to mark the last BPtr you just made.

(BPtr around each of the next 72 sts. The last BPtr should fall in a marked st from the previous round. Remove the SM and use it to mark the last BPtr you just made) 7 times. BPtr around the last 34 sts. Join to the first BPtr with a sl st.

Stitch Count: 576 BPtr






### Round 39

Ch 1, dc in the same st as the sl st join. Dc in the next 12 sts. Htr in the next 12 sts, tr in the next 12 sts. [Tr, ch 2, tr] in the next st, which should be the marked BPtr. Remove the SM.

(Tr in the next 12 sts, htr in the next 12 sts, dc in the next 23 sts. Htr in the next 12 sts, tr in the next 12 sts, [tr, ch 2, tr] in the next st, which should be the marked BPtr. Remove the SM) 7 times.

Tr in the next 12 sts, htr in the next 12 sts, dc in the last 10 sts. Join to the first dc with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

Stitch Count per Side: 23 dc, 24 htr, and 26 tr, not including ch-2 corner sps.





### Round 40

Join your yarn by making a standing dtr in any ch-2 sp around. [2 dtr, ch 2, 3 dtr] in the same ch-2 sp. This is your corner made.

\*Skip the next 2 sts, the first of which will be hidden. Tr in the next 7 sts. Ch 1, skip the next st, tr in the next 2 sts, htr in the next 3 sts. Ch 1, skip the next st, htr in the next 5 sts. (Ch 1, skip the next st, dc in the next 5 sts) 5 times. Ch 1, skip the next st, htr in the next 5 sts. Ch 1, skip the next st, htr in the next 3 sts, tr in the next 2 sts. Ch 1, skip the next st, tr in the next 7 sts. Skip the next 2 sts. [3 dtr, ch 2, 3 dtr] in the next ch-2 sp.\*

Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the first dtr with a sl st.

Fasten off and work away your ends if you are going to change colours for the next round, otherwise sI st in the next 2 sts and into to the next ch-2 corner sp.

**Stitch Count per Side: 25** dc, **16** htr, **18** tr, **6** dtr, and **10** ch-1 sps, not including ch-2 corner sps.

#### Round 41

Please Note: All the htr sts after a ch-1 sp will be tricky to get into. Don't accidentally skip


#### them!

- If you are using the same colour: Ch 3.
- **If you are using a new colour:** Join your yarn by making a standing tr in any ch-2 sp around.

[5 tr, ch 3, sl st in the third ch from the hook to form a picot, 6 tr] in the same ch-2 sp. This is your first corner made. It will be a tight fit getting all 12 tr into the corner sp. Squish them up good!

\*Skip the next 3 dtr, the first of which will be hidden. Tr in the next 7 sts, tr in the next ch-1 sp, tr in the next 4 sts. Htr in the next st, htr in the next ch-1 sp, htr in the next st. Dc in the next 4 sts. (Dc in the next ch-1 sp, dc in the next 5 sts) 5 times. Dc in the next ch-1 sp, dc in the next 4 sts. Htr in the next st, htr in the next ch-1 sp, htr in the next st. Tr in the next 4 sts, tr in the next ch-1 sp, tr in the next 7 sts. Skip the next 3 dtr. [6 tr, ch 3, sl st in the third ch from the hook to form a picot, 6 tr] in the next ch-2 sp.\* Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the first tr (or the top of the beg ch-3) with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

Stitch Count per Side: 39 dc, 6 htr, and 36 tr, not including corner Picots



### Round 42

When you make the corners in this round, they will seem too tight for the round. Do not worry about it.


Join your yarn by making a standing dc in any ch-3 picot around. Mark this first dc with a SM and don't remove the SM until you have worked into it in Round 45.

\*Ch 4, skip the next 6 tr of Round 41, **FPdtr3tog** over the next 3 dtr from Round 40. **Ch 2**, skip the next 3 tr of Round 41, htr in the next 8 sts. The last htr should fall in the second to last tr of the previous round. Dc in the next 49 sts, htr in the next 8 sts. **Ch 2**, skip the next st. **FPDtr3tog** over the next 3 dtr from Round 40. Ch 4, dc in the next Picot.\*

Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last dc on the last repeat. Join to the first dc with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

**Stitch Count per Side: 49** dc, **16** htr, **2** FPdtr3tog, **2** ch-2 sps, and **2** ch-4 sps, not including corner dc.

Don't worry about the ch-4 sps in the corner for now. We will deal with them in Round 44.





## Round 43

### Note 1

When working into the corners, work **behind** the ch-4 sps from Round 42. You may find it easiest to fold them forward out of the way.



### Note 2

When working into the skipped sts from Round 39, work in front of Rounds 40 – 42.



Join your yarn by making a standing **BPdc** around the first tr in any 12-tr corner group from Round 41. **BPdc** around the next 11 tr. This is your corner made.

\*Ch 6, skip the next ch-2 sp of Round 42 and the next 4 htr. Dc in the next st, which should be the st of Round 42 made into the st of Round 41 made into the ch-1 sp of Round 40. Ch 3, dc in the same st. Make a **ttr** in the next skipped st of Round 39. Skip the next st of Round 42, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st.

Ch 3, skip the next 3 sts. [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st (see weird landmark above, here and throughout). **Dtr** in the next skipped st from Round 39. Skip the next st of Round 42, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st.

(Ch 3, skip the next 3 sts, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st. **Tr** in the next skipped st from Round 39. Skip the next st of Round 42, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st) **6** times.


Ch 3, skip the next 3 sts, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st. **Dtr** in the next skipped st from Round 39. Skip the next st of Round 42, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st.

Ch 3, skip the next 3 sts, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st. **Ttr** in the next skipped st from Round 39. Skip the next st of Round 42, [dc, ch 3, dc] in the next st.

Ch 6, skip the next 4 htr and the next ch-2 sp. **BPdc** around each of the 12 tr in the corner group.\*

Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the first BPdc with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

**Stitch Count per Side: 20** 'Leaves'(each containing 2 dc and 1 ch-3), 10 'Stems' (**6** tr, **2** dtr, **2** ttr), **9** ch-3 sps between Leaf/Stem combinations, and **2** ch-6 sps – not including 12 corner BPdc.



### Round 44

IMPORTANT: In this round, you will work in front of the ch-4 sps from Round 42 when making the corners. Fold these ch-4 sps to the back and out of the way.


Before you start, take a look at your work. On each side, you will have 10 'Stems' created by working into Round 39, each with a leaf in front of it and behind it. You will only be working into these Stems when making the sides.

Join your yarn by making a standing dc in the first tr of the 12-tr group from Round 41. You will have to dig a fair bit to find that first tr, here and throughout. Ch 1, [tr, ch 1, tr] in the next tr. Ch 1, dc in the next tr. This is the first Petal of a Corner Flower made. (Dc in the next tr, ch 1, [tr, ch 1, tr] in the next tr. Ch 1, dc in the next tr) 3 times. This is your first Corner Flower made.

\*Ch 3, dc in the next ch-6 sp from Round 43, ch 5. (Make a Popcorn in the next Stem, ch 6) **9** times. Make a Popcorn in the last Stem. Ch 5, dc in the next ch-6 sp, ch 3. (Dc in the next tr, ch 1, [tr, ch 1, tr] in the next tr. Ch 1, dc in the next tr) **4** times.\*

Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last Corner Flower on the last repeat. Join to the first dc with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

**Stitch Count per Side:** 2 dc, 10 Popcorns, 2 ch-3 sps, 2 ch-5 sps, and 9 ch-6 sps, not including the Corner Flowers, which consist of 4 Petals, each containing 2 dc, 2 tr, and 3 ch-1 sps.





### Round 45

When I refer to the ch-3 sps from Round 43, I mean the ones between Leaves, not the ones

#### that form the Leaves.


Join your yarn by making a standing htr in the marked corner dc from Round 42, which you will find behind the Corner Flower from Round 44. Remove the SM. Ch 2, htr in the same dc. This is your corner made.

\*Make 5 htr in the next ch-4 sp. **Ch 1**, make 3 tr in the next ch-2 sp of Round 42, working in front of Rounds 43 and 44. Still working in front of Rounds 43 and 44, skip the next htr of Round 42, which will be tricky to get into anyway. Tr in the next 2 htr, skip the last htr. Make 2 htr in the ch-6 sp of Round 43, working in front of the ch-5 sp of Round 44.

For the next bit, it will be easier if you fold Round 44 down behind your work so that it is out of the way.

Working in front of Round 44: (ch 4, make 3 htr in the next ch-3 sp of Round 43) **9** times. Ch 4, make 2 htr in the ch-6 sp of Round 43, working in front of the ch-5 sp of Round 44. Skip the next 2 htr of Round 42, tr in the next 2 htr. Make 3 tr in the next ch-2 sp of Round 42, working in front of Rounds 43 and 44. **Ch 1**, make 5 htr in the next ch-4 sp of Round 42. [Htr, ch 2, htr] in the next dc.\* Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the first htr with a sl st.

**Stitch Count per Side: 43** htr, **10** tr, **2** ch-1 sps, and **10** ch-4 sps, not including ch-2 corner sps.



### Round 46

SI st in the next ch-2 sp. Ch 4 (counts as htr and ch-2), htr in the same ch-2 sp. This counts as your corner.

\*Skip the next st, which will be tricky to get into anyway. Htr in the next 5 sts, htr in the next ch-1 sp, htr in the next 7 sts.

Make 2 dc in the next ch-4 sp of Round 45, working **OVER** the ch-5 sp of Round 44.


(Make a **FPdc** around the Popcorn from Round 44, make 2 dc in the same ch-4 sp of Round 45, working **OVER** the next ch-6 sp of Round 44, skip the next htr, dc in the next 2 htr, working in front of Round 44. Make 2 dc in the next ch-4 sp of Round 45, working OVER the ch-6 sp from Round 44) **9** times.

Make a **FPdc** around the last Popcorn from Round 44, make 2 dc in the same ch-4 sp of Round 45, working OVER the ch-5 sp of Round 44. Skip the next st, htr in the next 6 sts. Htr in the next ch-1 sp, skip the next htr (which will be tricky to get into anyway), htr in the last 5 sts. [Htr, ch 2, htr] in the next ch-2 corner sp.\*

Rep from  $^*$  to  $^*$  7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the second ch of the beg ch-4 with a sl st.



Stitch Count per Side: 58 dc, 10 FPdc, and 27 htr, not including ch-2 corner sps.




### Round 47

SI st in the next ch-2 sp. Ch 4 (counts as htr and ch-2), htr in the same ch-2 sp. This counts as your corner.

\*Skip the next st, which will be tricky to get into anyway. Htr in the next 15 sts. (Htr2tog over the FPdc and the next dc, Htr in the next 5 sts) 9 times. Htr2tog over the last FPdc and the next dc, htr in the last 14 sts. [Htr, ch 2, htr] in the next ch-2 corner sp.\*

Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the second ch of the beg ch-4 with a sl st.

Stitch Count per Side: 76 htr and 10 htr2tog, not including ch-2 corner sps.



### Round 48


When making the Scallops <u>that fall over the Popcorns</u> in this round, the last dc of each repeat should fall in the htr2tog from the previous round. This round will ruffle a bit, don't worry about it.

SI st in the next ch-2 sp. Ch 3, [Tr, ch 2, 2 tr] in the same ch-2 sp. This counts as your corner.

\*Ch 1, skip the next st, which will be tricky to get into anyway. Make 3 tr in the next st, skip the next 2 sts, dc in the next st. (Dc in the next st, skip the next st, make 3 tr in the next st. Ch 2, make 3 tr in the next st, skip the next st, dc in the next st) 13 times. There should now be 3 sts left before the ch-2 corner sp. Dc in the next st, skip the next st, make 3 tr in the next st. Ch 1, [2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr] in the next ch-2 corner sp.\*

Rep from \* to \* 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the top of the beg ch-3 with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

**Stitch Count per Side: 28** dc, **88** tr, **2** ch-1 sps, and **13** ch-2 sps, not including ch-2 corner sps.
