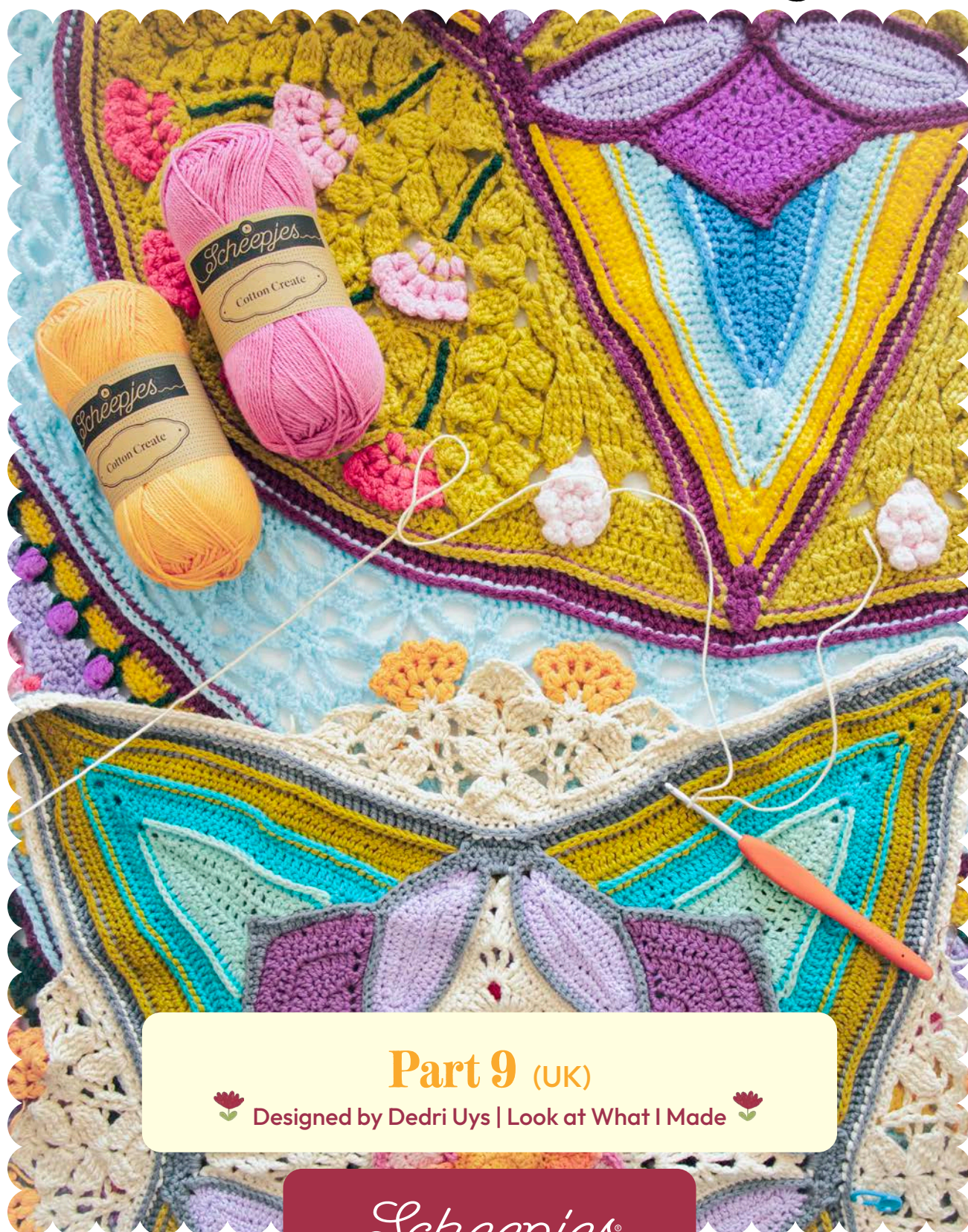

Round 68

Join your yarn by making a standing tr in the marked ch-3 sp from the previous round. **Re-move the SM.** [Tr, ch 1, 2 tr] in the same ch-3 sp. **This is your first corner made.**

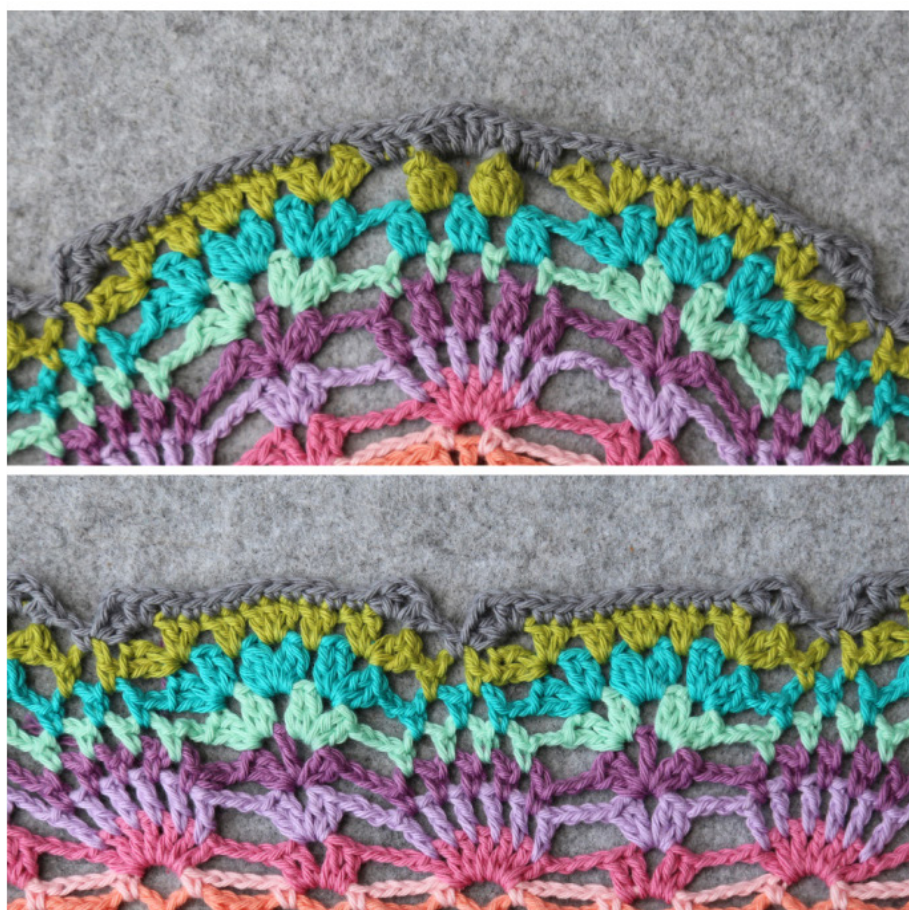
***FPtr** around the next Popcorn, make 2 tr in the next ch-3 sp. Ch 1, make 2 dc in the next ch-2 sp. Skip the next st, dc in the next 10 sts.

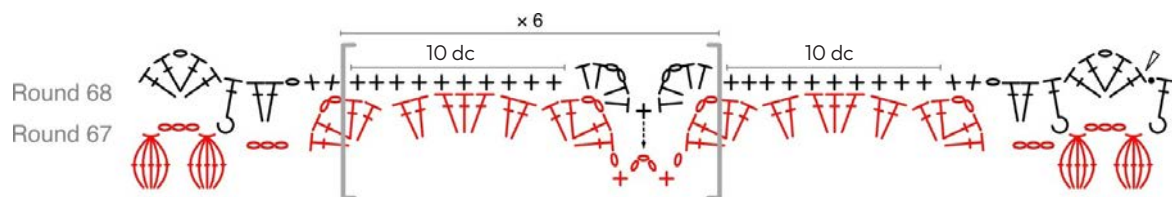
([2 htr, ch 2, 2 htr] in the next ch-2 sp. Skip the next ch-1 sp, dc in the next ch-3 sp. Skip the next ch-1 sp, [2 htr, ch 2, 2 htr] in the next ch-2 sp. Skip the next st, dc in the next 10 sts) **6** times.

Make 2 dc in the next ch-2 sp. Ch 1, make 2 tr in the next ch-3 sp. **FPtr** around the next Popcorn, [2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr] in the next ch-3 sp.*

Rep from * to * 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the first tr with a sl st.

Stitch Count Per Side: 80 dc, 48 htr, 8 tr, 2 FPtr, 2 ch-1 sps, and 12 ch-2 sps, not including ch-1 corner sp.





Round 69

Sl st in the next st and the ch-1 corner sp. Ch 4 (counts as tr and ch-1). Tr in the same ch-1 sp. **This is your first corner made.**

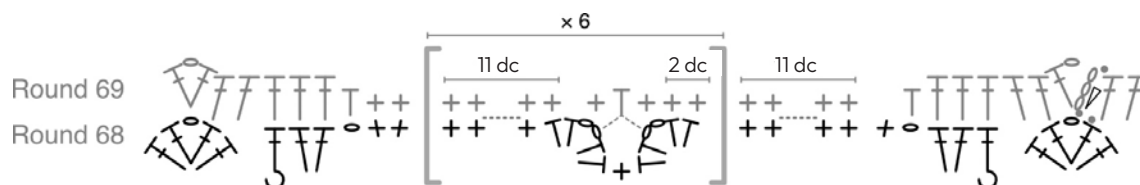
*Tr in the next 5 sts, htr in the next ch-1 sp. Skip the next st, dc in the next 13 sts.

(Dc in the next ch-2 sp. Working into the same ch-2 sp **AND** the next ch-2 sp, make an htr, **inserting your hook from front to back into the first ch-2 sp and from back to front into the next ch-2 sp**. Dc in the second ch-2 sp. Skip the next htr, **which will be tricky to get into anyway**, dc in the next 13 sts) **6** times. Htr in the next ch-1 sp, tr in the next 5 sts. [Tr, ch 1, tr] in the next ch-1 sp.*

Rep from * to * 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the third ch of the beg ch-4 with a sl st.

Stitch Count Per Side: 103 dc, 2 htr, 6 weird joining htr (in ch-2 sps), and 12 tr, not including ch-1 corner sp.





Round 70

This round will bulge slightly between Pineapples. Don't worry about it. Also, I am so sorry! There will be A LOT of counting in this round.

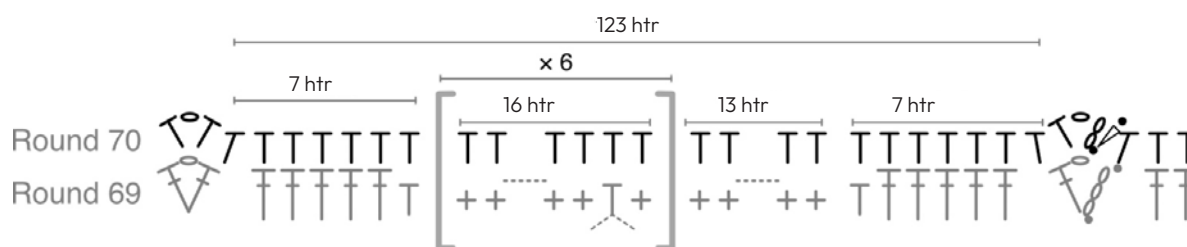
Tester's Tip: "If you want landmarks, here are the stitches that will land in the 'weird joining htrs': 22, 38, 54, 70, 86, 102. So the 22nd htr of the side (**not including the corner htr**), then every 16th htr until there are 21 sts left before the corner sp." – Kay Crone and Susanne van der Wal

Sl st in the next ch-1 sp. Ch 3 (**counts as htr and ch-1**). Htr in the same ch-1 sp. Htr in the next 123 sts.

([Htr, ch 1, htr] in the next ch-1 sp. Htr in the next 123 sts) **7** times. Join to the second ch of the beg ch-3 with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

Stitch Count Per Side: 125 htr, not including ch-1 corner sps.





Round 71

Landmark: The first leg of the tr2tog in bold will fall in the htr made into the weird joining htr from Round 69.

Join your yarn by making a standing tr in any ch-1 corner sp. [Ch 1, tr] in the same ch-1 sp. **This is your first corner made.**

*Skip the first st, **which will be tricky to get into anyway**, tr in the next 6 sts, tr2tog. Htr in the next 4 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, htr in the next 4 sts.

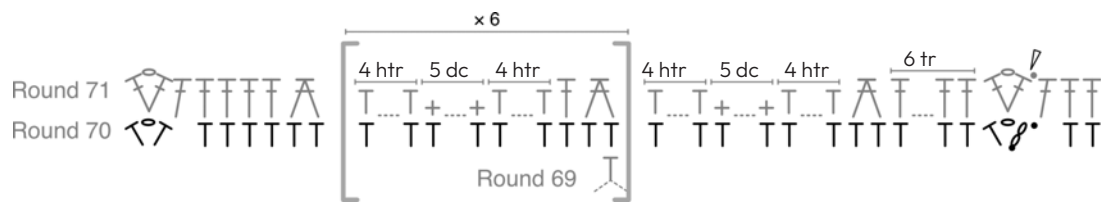
(Tr2tog. Tr in the next st, htr in the next 4 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, htr in the next 4 sts) **6** times. **There should now be 7 sts left.** Tr2tog, tr in the last 5 sts. [Tr, ch 1, tr] in the next ch-1 corner sp.*

Rep from * to * 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the first tr with a sl st.

Stitch Count Per Side: 118 sts (35 dc, 56 htr, 19 tr, and 8 tr2tog), not including ch-1 corner sp.

Fasten off and work away your ends if you are going to change colours for the next round, otherwise sl st into the next ch-1 corner sp.





Round 72

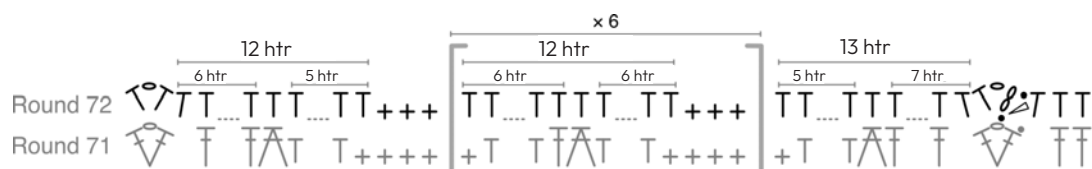
- **If you are using the same colour:** Ch 3 (counts as htr and ch-1). Htr in the same ch-1 sp. **This is your first corner made.**
- **If you are using a new colour:** Join your yarn by making a standing htr in the ch-1 sp of any corner. Ch 1, htr in the same ch-1 corner sp. **This is your first corner made.**

*Htr in the next 13 sts, **the eighth of which will fall in a tr2tog.**

(Dc in the next 3 sts, htr in the next 12 sts, **the sixth of which will fall in a tr2tog**) 7 times.
[Htr, ch 1, htr] in the next ch-1 corner sp.*

Rep from * to * 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the second ch of the beg ch-3 with a sl st.

Stitch Count Per Side: 120 sts (21 dc and 99 htr), not including ch-1corner sp.



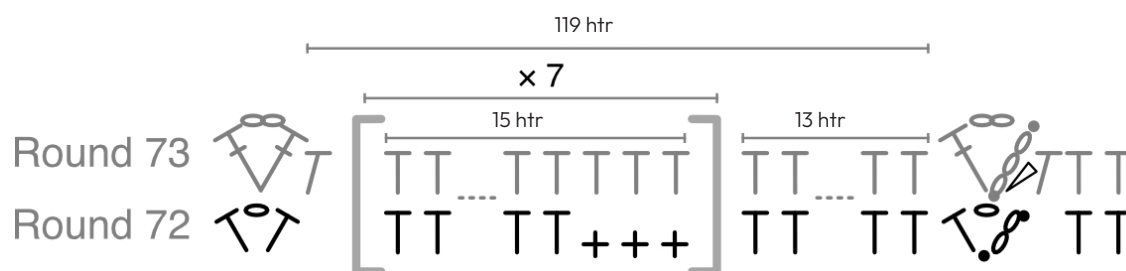
Round 73

Sl st in the next ch-1 sp. Ch 5 (counts as tr and ch-2). Tr in the same ch-1 sp. **This is your first corner made.**

*Skip the first st, **which will be tricky to get into anyway.** Htr in the next 119 sts. [Tr, ch 2, tr] in the next ch-1 corner sp.*

Rep from * to * 7 more times, omitting the last corner on the last repeat. Join to the third ch of the beg ch-5 with a sl st. Fasten off and work away your ends.

Stitch Count Per Side: 121 sts (119 htr and 2 tr), not including ch-2 corner sp.



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
