Scheepjes Catona + Chroma minis colour

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10 x 25g/62.5m) Christmas Treat x 1 colour pack

(98% Mercerised Cotton x 2 % Metallic Polyester; 50g/155m) 172-S Light Silver - Silver x 1 ball 115-S Hot Red - Silver x 1 ball 515-S Emerald-Silver x 1 ball 525-S Fir-Silver x 1 ball 383-G Ginger Gold - Gold x 1 ball 105-S Bridal White - Silver x 1 ball

Scheepjes River Washed

(78% Cotton x 22% Acrylic; 50g/130m) 960 Murray x 1 ball or piece of leftover yarn

3mm and 3.50mm knitting needles 2.50mm and 4mm crochet hooks 2 x stitch holders 10 x ø 10mm buttons 2 x ø 5mm safety eyes 1 button for front of Dress 1 small button for Headband 25cm long piece of ribbon or cord Pompom maker

GAUGE

Tension is not critical for these projects.

PATTERN NOTES

All garments are knitted or crocheted back and forth in rows. For knitting, cast on sts using the long tail cast-on method.



DRESS MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 25g/62.5m)

Yarn A 390 Poppy Rose x 1 ball

Yarn C 105 Bridal White x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn B 172-S Light Silver-Silver x 1 ball 3mm and 3.50mm knitting needles

4 x ø 10mm buttons

1 button or bead to decorate front of Dress 2 x stitch holders

PATTERN NOTES

Dress is knitted back and forth in rows from neck down.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A and 3mm needles, cast on 25 sts.

Row 1 (WS) Knit. [25 sts]

Change to Yarn C.

Row 2 (RS) (buttonhole row) K1, k2tog, yo, k to end. [25 sts]

Row 3 K3, p19, k3. [25 sts]

Row 4 K5, (M1, k1, M1, k3, M1, k1, M1, k5)

twice. [33 sts]

Row 5 K3, p27, k3. [33 sts]

Row 6 K6, M1, k1, M1, k5, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1, k1, M1, k5, M1, k1, M1, k6. [41 sts]

Row 7 K3, p35, k3.

Row 8 K7, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1, k7, M1, k7, M1, k7. [49 sts]

Row 9 K3, p43, k3.

Row 10 K8, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k11, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k8. [57 sts] Change to Yarn B.

Row 11 K3, p51, k3.

In next row, join Yarn A and alternately work 1 st in Yarn B and 1 st in Yarn A. Work M1, k1 and M1 all in Yarn B.

Row 12 K4 (all in Yarn B), work alternately beginning with Yarn A: k5, M1, k1, M1, k11, M1, k13, M1, k1, M1, k11, M1, k1, M1, k1, M1, k5, k4 (all in Yarn B). [65 sts]



Cast off Yarn A and continue with Yarn B. **Row 13** K3, p59, k3.

Change to Yarn C.

Row 14 (buttonhole row) K1, k2tog, yo, k7, M1, k1, M1, k13, M1, k1, M1, k15, M1, k1, M1, k14, M1, k13, M1, k1, M1, k10. [73 sts]

Row 15 K3, p67, k3.

Row 16 K11, M1, k1, M1, k15, M1, k1, M1, k17, M1, k1, M1, k15, M1, k1, M1, k11. [81 sts]

Row 17 K3, p75, k3.

Row 18 K12, M1, k1, M1, k17, M1, k1, M1, k19, M1, k1, M1, k17, M1, k1, M1, k12. [89 sts]

Row 19 K3, p83, k3.

Row 20 K13, M1, k1, M1, k19, M1, k1, M1, k21, M1, k1, M1, k19, M1, k1, M1, k13. [97 sts] **Row 21** K3, p91, k3.

Separate Front/Back Panels and work Sleeves

Row 22 (RS) K14 (Back Panel sts), knit 23 sts and place on holder (first Sleeve), k23 (Front Panel sts), knit 23 sts and place on holder (second Sleeve), k14 (Back Panel sts).

Remainder of Dress

Continue with sts on needle. [51 sts]

Row 23 (WS) K3, p45, k3.

Row 24 (RS) K4, (k1, M1) to last 5 sts, k5. [93 sts]

Change to Yarn B and 3.5mm needles.

Row 25 K5, (k1, p5) 3x, M1, (k1, p5) 8x, M1, (p5, k1) 3x, k4. [95 sts]

Row 26 (buttonhole row) K1, k2tog, yo, k2, (p1, k5) to end.

Row 27 K3, p2, (k1, p5) to end.

Row 28 K3, p1, (k1, p1) to final 3 sts, k3.

Row 29 Rep Row 27.

Row 30 K5, (p1, k5) to end.

Row 31 K3, p2, (k1, p5) to end.

Rows 32-39 Rep Rows 30-31 four more times

Row 40 (buttonhole row) Rep Row 26.

Rows 41-45 Rep Rows 35-39.

Row 46 Rep Row 28.

In next row, join Yarn A and alternately work 1 st in Yarn B and 1 st in Yarn A.

Row 47 K3, p1 (grey), p1 (red), k1 (grey), work

alternately following patt: (p5, k1) to final 3 sts, k3 (grey).

Row 48 K3 (grey), k1 (red), [k1 (grey), p1 (grey), k1 (grey, k1 (red), k1 (grey), k1 (red)] rep between brackets to end, ending with k3 in grey.

Rows 49-51 Rep Rows 47-48 once and then Row 47 once more.

Rows 52-55 Using Yarn B, rep Rows 30-31 twice

Change to Yarn A.

Row 56 P5, (k1, p5) to end.

Row 57 Purl.

Change to Yarn B.

Row 58 Knit.

Cast off.

Left Sleeve

Row 1 (WS) Purl. [23 sts]

Row 2 (RS) Purl.

Change to Yarn B and 3.5mm needles.

Row 3 P1, M1, p1, (M1, p3) to end. [31 sts]

Row 4 Knit.

Row 5 K1, (p1, k1) to end.

Row 6 Knit.

Row 7 Purl.

In next row, Join Yarn A and alternately work 1 st in Yarn B and then 1 st in Yarn A.

Row 8 Knit.

Cast off Yarn A, change to Yarn B.

Row 9 Knit.

Row 10 Purl.

Row 11 K1, (p1, k1) to end.

Row 12 Purl.

Cast off Yarn B, change to Yarn A and 3mm needles.

Row 13 (K1, k2tog) to last st, k1. [21 sts] Cast off.

Right Sleeve

Work as for Left Sleeve.

Join Sleeve seams and attach buttons. Attach button/bead to front of Dress and weave in all ends.







SKIRT MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn A 115-S Hot Red-Silver x 1 ball

Yarn B 172-S Light Silver – Silver x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

25cm long piece of ribbon or cord

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, ch34.

Row 1 (RS) 1htr in third ch from hook (skipped ch2 does not count as a st throughout), 31htr. [32 htr]

Row 2 (WS) Ch2, 3htr blo, ch1, skip 1 htr, 28htr blo. [31 htr blo, ch-1 space]

Row 3 Ch2, 32htr blo. [32 htr blo]

Rows 4-5 Rep Row 2-3 once more.

Row 6 Ch2, 7htr blo, ch8, skip 8 htr, 1htr blo in each st to last 4 sts, ch1, skip 1 htr, 3htr blo.

Row 7 Rep Row 3.

Rows 8-39 Rep Row 2-3 a further 16 times.

Row 40 Rep Row 6.

Row 41 Rep Row 3.

Rows 42-45 Rep Row 2-3 twice.

Fasten off.

Using Yarn B, work surface ss sts around armholes and fasten off.

Weave in ends, and thread ribbon/cord through ch-spaces at RS.

HOODIE MATERIALS Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 25g/62.5m)

Yarn A 515 Emerald x 1 ball

Yarn D 517 Root Beer x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic

Polyester: 50g/115m)

Yarn B 515 Emerald-Silver x 1 ball

Scheepjes River Washed

(78% Cotton, 22% Acrylic; 50g/130m)

Yarn C 960 Murray x 1 ball or leftover yarn for reindeer

3mm and 3.5mm knitting needles

3 x ø 10mm buttons

2 x ø 5mm safety eyes

Stitch holders

PATTERN NOTES

Sweater is knitted onto Hood by picking up sts along the edge. Use intarsia method for the head of the reindeer. Antlers and nose are embroidered onto Sweater at the end. You can either embroider a pair of eyes or use safety eyes.

INSTRUCTIONS

Hood

Using Yarn A and 3mm needles, cast on 52 sts.

Rows 1 (RS)-4 Seed st to end.

Change to Yarn B and 3.5mm needles.

Row 5 Knit.

Row 6 Purl.

Row 7 K18, cast off 8 sts, k2, cast off 8 sts, k16.

Row 8 P17, cast on 8 sts, p2, cast on 8 sts,

Rows 9-22 Work in st st.

Cast off.

Sweater

Using Yarn B, 3.5mm needles and RS facing, pick up 11 sts evenly along first short edge of Hood, then **at the same time** pick up 1 st through end of first short edge and start of

second short edge, then pick up 11 sts evenly along second short edge. You now have 23 sts on your needle.

Row 2 and every following even-numbered row Purl. [23 sts]

Row 3 K3, M1, k1, M1, k3, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1, k1, M1, k3, M1, k1, M1, k3. [31 sts]

Row 5 K4, M1, k1, M1, k5, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k5, M1, k1, M1, k4. [39 sts]

Row 7 K5, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1, k1, M1, k11, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1, k1, M1, k5. [47 sts]

Row 9 K6, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k13, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k6. [55 sts]

Row 11 K7, M1, k1, M1, k11, M1, k1, M1, k15, M1, k1, M1, k11, M1, k1, M1, k7. [63 sts] Over next rows, head of reindeer is worked using Yarn C, indicated with C after st. Use Yarn B for all other sts.

Row 13 K8, M1, k1, M1, k13, M1, k1, M1, k2, k3C, k1, k5C, k1, k3C, k2, M1, k1, M1, k13, M1, k1, M1, k8. [71 sts]

Row 14 P30, p11C, p30.

Row 15 K9, M1, k1, M1, k15, M1, k1, M1, k6, k7C, k6, M1, k1, M1, k15, M1, k1, M1, k9. [79 sts]

Row 16 P36, p7C, p36.

Row 17 K10, M1, k1, M1, k17, M1, k1, M1, k7, k7C, k7, M1, k1, M1, k17, M1, k1, M1, k10. [87 sts]

Row 18 P41, p5C, p41.

On next row, Sleeves are worked.

Row 19 K11 (place sts on holder for back panel), k21 (place sts on holder for first Sleeve), k9, k5C, k9 (place sts on holder for front panel), k21 (place sts on holder for second Sleeve), k11 (place sts on holder for next back panel).

Sleeve

Place sts of one Sleeve onto 3.50mm needles.

Work 11 rows in st st.

Change to Yarn A and 3mm needles.

Work 4 rows in seed st.

Cast off.

Rep for second Sleeve.

Join all parts

Join first back panel, front panel and second back panel using 3.50mm needles.

Row 20 Join all panels: p20, p5C, p20. [45 sts]

Row 21 K21, k3C, k21.

Rows 22-26 Work in st st and change to Yarn A at the end

Rows 27-30 Work in seed st. Cast off.

Edging/Buttonhole Band

Using Yarn A, 3mm needles and RS facing, pick up 54 sts along one edge and work 4 rows in seed st. Cast off.

Pick up 54 sts along other edge but skip centre 3 sts at top of back of Hoodie.

Row 1 (WS) Seed st to end.

Row 2 (RS, buttonhole row) 12 sts in seed st, (yo, knit 2 sts together) to end.

Rows 3-4 Seed st to end.

Cast off.

Join both ends of Edging at top of Hoodie. Embroider antlers and nose. Attach buttons on Sweater and weave in all ends.



TROUSERS MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn A 525-S Fir-Silver x 1 ball

Yarn C 390 Poppy Rose x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona Chroma

100% Mercerised Cotton; 25g/62.5m)

Yarn B 009 Holly x 1 ball

3mm and 3.5mm knitting needles

2.5mm crochet hook

 $3 \times 0 10 mm$ buttons

PATTERN NOTES

Work both Legs separately, join at gusset and then work remainder of Trousers.

INSTRUCTIONS

First Leg

Using Yarn B and 3mm needles, cast on 38 sts.

Row 1 (RS)-4 Seed st to end. [38 sts]

Change to Yarn A and 3.5mm needles.

Row 5 (RS) K3, (p1, k4) to end.

Row 6 (WS) (K1, p4) to final 3 sts, p3.

Rows 7-8 Rep Rows 5-6.

Row 9 Knit.

Rows 10-22 Rep Row 5-9 twice, then Rows 5-7 once more.

Row 23 Cast off 5 sts, rep patt to end. [33 sts]

Row 24 Cast off 3 sts, rep patt to end. [30 sts]

Rows 25-26 Rep patt.

Row 27 Knit.

Row 28 (K4, p1) to end.

Place sts on holder.

Second Leg

Work as for First Leg to end of Row 22.

Row 23 Cast off 3 sts, rep patt to end.

Row 24 Cast off 5 sts, rep patt to end.

Rows 25-26 Rep patt.

Row 27 Knit.

Row 28 Rep patt.

On next row, join both Legs.

Row 29 4 seed sts, (p1, k4) to last st, k2tog over last st on needle and first st on holder, rep patt and end with 4 seed sts. [59 sts]

Row 30 4 seed sts, p1, (k4, p1) to last 4 sts, 4 seed sts.

Rows 31-32 Rep patt.

Row 33 4 seed sts, k to last 4 sts, 4 seed sts.

Rows 34-38 Rep patt.

Row 39 Rep Row 33.

Rows 40-43 Rep patt.

Row 44 4 seed sts, p1, k4, p2tog, (k3, p2tog) to last 8 sts, k4, 4 seed sts. [50 sts] Change to Yarn B and 3mm needles.

Rows 45-46 Seed st to end.

Row 47 (buttonhole row) K1, k2tog, yo, seed st to end.

Row 48 Seed st to end.

Cast off, leaving long thread hanging to attach button.

Join Leg and gusset seams. Attach buttons for Suspenders: 2 on the front and 1 on the back.

Suspenders

Using Yarn C, ch36.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook (skipped ch does not count as a st), 34dc, ch7, turn and continue along opposite side: 35dc, ch7, 1ss in first st to join, fasten off. Create another shorter chain: ch26.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook (skipped ch does not count as a st), 24dc, ch7, turn and continue along opposite side: 1dc in each st to last 2 sts, 1ss. Fasten off, leaving long thread hanging to join both parts.

Place short chain next to longer chain. Count approximately 10 sts from bottom of longer chain and attach short end of shorter chain to create Y-shape.

Weave in all ends and attach Suspenders to Trousers.



HAT MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn A 383-G Ginger Gold-Gold x 1 ball 3.5mm knitting needles Pompom maker

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, cast on 48 sts.

Rows 1 (RS)-14 (K3, p3) to end. [48 sts] Row 15 Work 14 sts following patt, cast off 6 sts, work 8 sts following patt, cast off 6 sts, work patt to end. [36 sts]

Row 16 Work 14 sts following patt, cast off 6 sts, work 8 sts following patt, cast off 6 sts, work patt to end. [48 sts]

Rows 17-42 (K3, p3) to end.

Cast off, leaving 30cm long thread hanging to join seam and attach cast-on edge to Hat. Fasten off.

Using Yarn A, make a pompom. Measure 3cm from top of Hat and attach pompom by wrapping the yarn tail tightly around Hat, tie a knot to secure.







MITTENS MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 25g/62.5m)

Yarn A 244 Spruce x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic

Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn B 105-S Bridal White-Silver x 1 ball 3mm knitting needles

4mm crochet hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A and 3mm knitting needles, cast on 24 sts

Row 1 (RS) (K1, p1) to end. [24 sts] Rep Row 1 a further 9 times.

Rows 11-20 Work in st st.

Row 21 (K4, k2tog) to end. [20 sts]

Row 22 Purl.

Row 23 (K3, k2tog) to end. [16 sts]

Row 24 Purl.

Row 25 (K2, k2tog) to end. [12 sts]

Row 26 Purl.

Row 27 (K2tog) to end. [6 sts]

Fasten off and thread yarn tail through final 6 sts, pulling tight to close opening.

Rep for second Mitten.

Using Yarn B, embroider a star in centre of each Mitten. Using blanket sts, sew along cuff to create a decorative edge.

Create a cord as follows: using Yarn B double stranded and 4mm crochet hook, ch50 and

Fold cuff in half and attach cord to centre back of each Mitten.

HEADBAND MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona Shine

98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn A 525-S Fir-Silver x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 25g/62.5m)

Yarn B 105 Bridal White x 1 ball

3mm knitting needles 1 x small button or bead

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, cast on 48 sts.

Row 1 (RS) (K1, p1) to end. [48 sts] Rep Row 1 a further 11 times.

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail hanging to join seam.

Using Yarn B, create a decorative edge along top and bottom of Headband by threading yarn through sts. Attach button of bead. Weave in all ends.

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester; 50g/115m)

Yarn F 525-S Fir- Silver x 1 ball

Yarn D 383-G Ginger Gold-Gold x 1 ball

Yarn B 115-S Hot Red-Silver x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 25g/62.5m)

Yarn A 249 Saffron x 1 ball

Yarn E 515 Emerald x 1 ball

Scheepjes Catona Chroma (100% Mercerised Cotton; 50g/125m)

Yarn C 009 Holly x 1 ball

3mm crochet hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, ch77.

Row 1 Skip 2 chains (does not count as a st), 75htr, change to Yarn B in final st, turn.

Row 2 Ch2, 75htr blo, turn.

Rep Row 2 in following colour sequence: C, D, E, and F, leaving 7cm long yarn tails hanging at either side.

Fringe

Cut 2 strands of 20 cm from each color and fold in half. Attach fringes to both sides of Scarf at the corresponding colors, incorporating the yarn tails. Trim the ends to the desired length.
