GAUGE/TENSION

Tension is not critical for these patterns.

ABBREVIATIONS (UK TERMINOLOGY)

Crochet

[] number of sts on a given round/row

ch(s) chain stitch(es)

blo back loop(s) only: work in back loops only

dc double crochet

dc2tog double crochet 2 sts together to decrease by 1 st: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) twice, yoh, draw through all loops

dc3tog double crochet 3 sts together to decrease by 2 sts: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) 3 times, yoh, draw through all loops

dtr double treble crochet

htr half treble crochet

RS right side

ss slip stitch(es)

ss surface crochet with hook on RS of work, and yarn on WS of work, insert hook from front to back at starting point, yoh, pull up loop of yarn from back to make loop on hook, *insert hook from front to back in next st on line, yoh, pull up loop of yarn from back and draw through loop on hook; repeat from * for each st along

st(s) stitch(es)

tr treble crochet

WS wrong side

yoh yarn over hook

Repeat Formats

.....; **repeat from * twice/to end** work instructions after * and repeat as many times as stated

(....) **once/to end** work the instructions between brackets the total number of times stated


PATTERN NOTES

When ornaments are worked back and forth in rows, turn after each row. Turning ch does not count as a st.

When ornaments are worked in a spiral using the amigurumi method, do not close each round with a ss. Mark first st of each round and move it up as you go.

Details are embroidered on at the end.

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CHRISTMAS PRESENT

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Pink present

Yarn A 409 Soft Rose x 1 ball

Yarn B 517 Ruby x 1 ball

Yellow present

Yarn A 249 Saffron x 1 ball

Yarn B 179 Topaz x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

5cm high (6cm incl. Bow) x 5cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Present

Using Yarn A, ch12.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 10dc, turn. [11 sts]

Rows 2 (WS)-10 Ch1, 11dc, turn.


Round 11 Work around Present: Ch1, 10dc, 2dc in final st (forms corner), work 9dc evenly in row-ends, 2dc in first ch of foundation ch, 9dc in foundation ch, 2dc in final ch of foundation ch, work 9dc evenly in row-ends, 2dc in final row-end, 1ss in first st of round, fasten off.

Bow

Using Yarn B, work ss surface crochet across Present: first create a horizontal stripe and then a vertical one across Present, ch15, 1ss next to surface ss and continue with Bow, fasten off. Rejoin yarn with ss in the top next to previous ch15, ch15, 1ss next to surface ss and continue with Bow, fasten off.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



CANDY CANE

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 115 Hot Red x 1 ball

Yarn B 130 Old Lace x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

10cm high x 5.5cm wide

PATTERN NOTES

You can either fasten off the old colour at each colour change or leave the old colour hanging and pick it back up when you need to change again.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, ch4.

Row 1 (RS) Ch1, 1dc in second ch from hook, 2dc, turn. [3 dc]

Row 2 (WS)-3 Using Yarn B, ch1, 3dc, turn.

Rows 4-5 Using Yarn A, ch1, 3dc.

Repeat Rows 2-5 a further 3 times, then repeat Rows 4-5 once more.

Row 20 Using Yarn B, ch1, 3dc.

Row 21 Ch1, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr.

Row 22 Using Yarn A, ch1, 1tr, 1htr, 1dc.

Row 23 Ch1, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr.

Repeat Row 22-23 a further 3 times, changing colour every 2 rows.

Row 30 Using Yarn B, ch1, 3dc.

Row 31 Ch1, 3dc.

Fasten off.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



OAK LEAF

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 512 Lime x 1 ball

Yarn B 525 Fir x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

Stitch marker

MEASUREMENTS

8cm high x 4.5cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, ch12.

Round 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 4dc, 5htr, 5htr in final ch (place stitch marker in third htr), turn and work along other side of foundation chain: 5htr, 5dc, ch1, 1ss in first dc to join, fasten off.

Round 2 (RS) Join Yarn B with dc in same st as joining st of previous round, 1htr, (1tr, ch2, 1ss) in next st, 1dc, 1htr, (2tr, ch3, 1ss) in next st, 1dc, 1htr, (1tr, 1dtr) in next st, (2dtr, ch3, 1ss) in next st, 1dc, 1tr, 6tr in final st (remove stitch marker), 1tr, 1dc, (1ss, ch3, 2dtr) in next st, (1dtr, 1tr) in next st, 1htr, 1dc, (1ss, ch3, 2tr) in next st, 1htr, 1dc, (1ss, ch2, 1tr) in next st, 1htr, 1dc, 1ss, ch5, work back in ch5: ch1 in second ch from hook, 3dc, 1ss in same st as previous ss, work ss surface crochet over middle of foundation chain.

Weave in all ends.

Repeat for second Oak Leaf but swap Yarn A and B.

To Finish

Block Oak Leaf to flatten shape.



STAR

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona Shine

(98% Mercerised Cotton, 2% Metallic Polyester: 50g/115m)

Yarn A 208-G Yellow Gold x 1 ball

Not a fan of glitter? Then use

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 249 Saffron x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

5cm high x 5cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Yarn A, ch2.

Round 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 4dc. [5 dc]

Round 2 (RS) 2dc in each st around. [10 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, 2dc in next st) 5 times. [15 dc]

Round 4 (2dc, 2dc in next st) 5 times. [20 dc]

Round 5 Ss in first st, *(1dc, 1htr) in next st, (1tr, 1dtr, 1tr) in next st, (1htr, 1dc) in next st, ss in next st; repeat from * 4 times, work final ss of final repeat in first st of round to close. [35 sts excl. ss]

Fasten off.

To Finish

Block to flatten shape.



GINGERBREAD HOUSE

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 157 Root Beer x 1 ball

Yarn B 507 Chocolate x 1 ball

Yarn C 130 Old Lace x 1 ball

Yarn D 115 Hot Red x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

8cm high x 5cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

House

Using Yarn A, ch14.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each st to end, turn. [13 dc]

Rows 2 (WS)-10 Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, turn.

Row 11 Ch1, dc2tog, 11dc. [12 dc]

Row 12 Ch1, dc2tog, 10dc. [11 dc]

Row 13 Ch1, dc2tog, 9dc. [10 dc]

Row 14 Ch1, dc2tog, 8dc. [9 dc]

Row 15 Ch1, dc2tog, 7dc. [8 dc]

Row 16 Ch1, dc2tog, 6dc. [7 dc]

Row 17 Ch1, dc2tog, 5dc. [6 dc]

Row 18 Ch1, dc2tog, 4dc. [5 dc]

Row 19 Ch1, dc2tog, 3dc. [4 dc]

Row 20 Ch1, dc2tog, 2dc. [3 dc]

Row 21 Ch1, dc3tog, fasten off.

Window

Using Yarn B, ch7.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each st to end, turn. [6 dc]

Row 2 (WS)-5 Ch1, 6dc, turn, fasten off.

Using Yarn B, sew Window onto House.


Embroidered Details

Using photo as a guide, embroider details on House using Yarn C and running sts.

Wrap Yarn D around Yarn C to create a candy cane effect.

To Finish

Weave in ends and block to flatten shape.



GINGERBREAD MAN

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 383 Ginger Gold x 1 ball

Yarn B 130 Old Lace x 1 ball

Yarn C 115 Hot Red x 1 ball

Yarn D 512 Lime x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

8cm high x 6cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Head

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 5dc into ring. [5 dc]

Round 2 (RS) 2dc in each st around. [10 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, 2dc in next st) 5 times. [15 dc]

Round 4 (2dc, 2dc in next st) 5 times, ss in

next st. [20 dc]

Fasten off, making sure your magic ring is fully closed.

Stomach

Repeat Head but do not fasten off at the end of Round 4. Continue to work back and forth in short rows. Turning ch does not count as a st.

Arms and Legs

Row 1 (RS) 4dc, turn. [4 dc]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 4dc, turn.

Row 3 Ch1, 4dc.

Row 4 Ch1, 1dc, dc2tog, 1dc. [3 dc]

Row 5 Ch1, dc2tog, 1dc, fasten off. [2 dc]

*Rejoin yarn in next dc of Round 4 of

Stomach, repeat Rows 1-5; repeat from * twice more to create 2 Arms and 2 Legs in total. Do not fasten off but continue to Edging.

Edging

Work 4dc evenly in row-ends of Arm, 1tr in next dc of Stomach, work around Head: (3dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times, 2dc, 1tr in final unworked dc before second Arm, work around Gingerbread Man: 1dc in each row-end, 2dc in each corner, working 2dc in one st

or dc2tog where needed to create a rounded shape and ending with ss at the top of the first Arm.

Close opening between Head and Stomach using a yarn tail.

Embroidered details

Using Yarn B, embroider details all around Gingerbread Man using running sts.


Using Yarn B, embroider two eyes and a mouth on Head.

Using Yarn C, embroider a small bow tie.

Using Yarn D, embroider three buttons

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



RUDOLPH

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona (100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 383 Ginger Gold x 1 ball

Yarn B 115 Hot Red x 1 ball

Yarn C 157 Root Beer x 1 ball

Yarn D 130 Old Lace x 1 ball

Yarn E 179 Topaz x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

Stitch markers

MEASUREMENTS

13cm high x 7cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Head

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 6dc into ring. [6 dc]

Round 2 (RS) 2dc into each st around. [12 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, 2dc in next st) around. [18 dc]

Round 4 1dc, 2dc in next st, *2dc, 2dc in next st; repeat from * to final st, 1dc. [24 dc]

Round 5 (3dc, 2dc in next st) twice, 2htr, 1tr, 2tr in next st, 1tr, 2htr, (2dc in next st, 2dc) 3 times. [30 sts]

Round 6 2dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc, 2dc in next st, 1dc, 3htr, 2tr in next st, 2tr, 2tr in next st, 3htr, 1dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc, 2dc in next st, 4dc. [36 sts]

Round 7 5dc, 2dc in next st, 4htr, 2htr in next st, 1tr, 2tr in next st, 2tr, 2tr in next st, 1tr, 2tr in next st, 2tr, 2tr in next st, 2tr, 2tr in next st, 4htr, 1dc, 2dc in next st, 6dc. [44 sts]

Round 8 3ss, 2ss in next st, 6ss, 2ss in next st, 3ss, 2dc, 1htr, 2tr in next st (add stitch marker in second tr), 1tr, 2tr in next st, 2tr, 2tr in next st, 1tr, 2tr in next st (add stitch marker in first tr), 1tr, 2htr, 2dc, 2ss, 2ss in next st, 6ss, 2ss in next st, 4ss, fasten off. [52 sts]

Right Ear

Row 1 (RS) Join Yarn A with ss to first marked st of Round 7, 1dc in same st, 2dc, turn. [3 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 3dc, ch1, turn. [4 sts]

Row 3 Ch1, 1dc in second ch from hook, 2dc, 1ss. [4 sts]

Row 4 Ch1, skip 1 ss, 3dc, ch1. [4 sts]

Row 5 Ch1, 1dc in second ch from hook, 2dc, 1ss, fasten off.

Left Ear

Row 1 (RS) Join Yarn A with ss to second marked st of Round 7, 1dc in same st, 2dc, turn. [3 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch2, 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, turn. [4 sts]

Row 3 Ch1, 1ss, 3dc. [4 sts]

Row 4 Ch2, 1dc in second ch from hook, 2dc, 1ss. [4 sts]

Row 5 Ch1, skip 1 ss, 3dc, fasten off. [3 sts]

Nose

Using Yarn B, make a magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 6dc into ring. [6 dc]

Round 2 (RS) 2dc in each st around. [12 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, 2dc in next st) around. [18 dc]

Round 4 1dc, 2dc in next st, *2dc, 2dc in next st; repeat from * to final st, 1dc. [24 dc]

Attach Nose to Head.

Antlers (make 2)

Using Yarn C, ch9, 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, ch6, 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, ch6, 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, ch4, 1dc in second ch from hook, 2dc, 1ss in adjacent dc, ch5, 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, 1dc in adjacent ch, 1dc in adjacent dc, ch5, 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, 1dc in adjacent ch, 4dc in foundation ch that hasn't been worked in yet.

Attach Antler to Head next to Ear, leaving 2 sts between both Antlers.

Embroidered Details

Using Yarn D, embroider a gleam on the Nose using straight sts. Using Yarn E, embroider the inside of the Ears. Using Yarn C, embroider the eyes. Using Yarn D, embroider freckles.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



TEACUP

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 388 Rust x 1 ball

Yarn B 383 Ginger Gold x 1 ball

Yarn C 523 Sweet Mandarin x 1 ball

Yarn D 391 Deep Ocean x 1 ball

2.50mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

5cm high x 11cm wide, excl. Teabag

INSTRUCTIES

Cup

Using Yarn A, ch16.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 13dc, 2dc in final ch, turn. [16 dc]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 15dc, 2dc in final dc, turn. [17 dc]

Row 3 Ch1, 16dc, 2dc in final dc. [18 dc]

Row 4 Ch1, 17dc, 2dc in final dc. [19 dc]

Row 5 Ch1, 18dc, 2dc in final dc. [20 dc]

Row 6 Ch1, 19dc, 2dc in final dc. [21 dc]

Row 7 Ch1, 20dc, 2dc in final dc. [22 dc]

Row 8 Ch1, 21dc, 2dc in final dc. [23 dc]

Row 9 Ch1, 22dc, 2dc in final dc. [24 dc]

Row 10 Ch1, 23dc, 2dc in final dc. [25 dc]

Row 11 Ch1, 24dc, 2dc in final dc. [26 dc]

Row 12 Ch1, 25dc, 2dc in final dc, fasten off. [27 dc]

Base of Cup

Row 1 (RS) Using Yarn B and with RS of Cup facing, join yarn with ss to first ch of foundation ch, 2dc in same st, 13dc, 2dc in final ch of foundation ch, turn. [17 dc]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 16dc, 2dc in final dc, fasten off. [18 dc]

Handle

With RS of Cup facing, join Yarn A with ss in row-end in bottom right corner of Cup, ch21, 1dc in row-end of Row 10 of Cup, turn.

Row 1 (WS) Ch1, 5dc, ch3, 1ss in first ch, 16dc, ss in row-end of Cup, fasten off.

SS Surface Crochet

Using Yarn C, work five vertical stripes using ss surface crochet sts.

Teabag

Using Yarn D, ch10.

Rows 1-8 Ch1, 9dc, turn. [9 dc]

Fasten off.


String

Using Yarn C, ch25.

Attach end of String to Teabag and other end of String to upper left corner of Cup.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



CANDLE

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 409 Soft Rose x 1 ball

Yarn B 517 Ruby x 1 ball

Yarn C 157 Root Beer x 1 ball

Yarn D 249 Saffron x 1 ball

Yarn E 130 Old Lace x 1 ball

2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

11cm high x 4cm wide

PATTERN NOTES

Some parts of Candle are made using freeform crochet, meaning you can add or remove a st if you think that it will create a better shape.

INSTRUCTIONS

Candle

Using Yarn A, ch5.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 3dc, turn. [4 dc]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 4dc, turn.

Repeat Row 2 a further 12 times.

Row 15 Ch1, dc2tog, 2dc. [3 dc]

Rows 16-17 Ch1, 3dc.

Row 18 Ch1, dc2tog, 1dc. [2 dc]

Row 19 2dc.

Fasten off.

Candle Wick

Using Yarn C and with RS of Candle facing, join yarn with ss to second dc of final row of Candle, ch3, 1ss in second ch from hook, 2ss, end with 1ss in same st as joining-ss. Fasten off.

Flame

Using Yarn D and with RS of Candle facing, join yarn with ss to first ch of foundation chain of Candle Wick, 2dc, 2dc in ch-1 space, 3dc blo in ss on opposite side of foundation chain.

Next row (WS) Ch1, slip 1 dc, 2dc, ch2, 1ss in first ch, 1dc in same st, 2dc, ch1, skip 1 dc, 1ss in joining-ss. Fasten off.

Candle Holder

Using Yarn B and with RS of Candle facing, join yarn with ss to row-end of 4th row counted from the bottom.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in same st as ss, 2dc, 2dc in final row-end (creates corner), 3dc along bottom of Candle, 2dc in corner, 4dc in row-ends of Candle, turn.

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, skip 1 dc, 3dc, 2dc in next dc, 4dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc, dc2tog, turn.

Row 3 Ch1, skip 1 dc, 1dc, 2dc in next st, 6dc, 2dc in next st, 2dc, dc2tog fasten off.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



CHRISTMAS JUMPER

Materials

Scheepjes Catona (100% Mercerised Cotton; 10g/25m)

Yarn A 409 Soft Rose x 1 ball

Yarn B 517 Ruby x 1 ball

Yarn C 130 Old Lace x 1 ball

2.50mm crochet hook

Measurements

7.5cm high x 12cm wide

Instructions

Using Yarn A, ch20.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 18dc. [19 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, skip first dc, 11dc in each st to end. [18 sts]

Repeat Row 2.

Change to Yarn B.

Repeat Row 2 a further 3 times.

Rows 7-8 Ch1, 11dc in each st to end. [14 sts]

Repeat Row 2 a further 3 times.

Rows 12-16 Ch1, 11dc in each st to end. [11 sts]

Row 17a Ch1, 3dc, 1ss, turn.

Row 18a Ch1, skip 1 ss, 3dc.

Row 19a Ch1, 2dc, 1ss, fasten off.

Rejoin yarn in fourth st counted from end of Row 16.

Row 17b 3dc.

Row 18b Ch1, 2dc, 1ss.

Row 19b Ch1, skip 1 ss, 2dc, fasten off.

Sleeve (make 2)

Using Yarn A, ch6.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 4dc. [5 sts]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, 5dc.

Change to Yarn B.

Rep Row 2 a further 8 times.

Row 11 Ch4 (counts as 1 dtr), 1tr, 1htr, 1dc, 1ss. [5 sts]

Row 12 Ch1, skip 1 ss, 1ss, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr. [4 sts]

Fasten off, leaving long tail hanging for sewing.

Attach Sleeve to Jumper.

Neckline


Join Yarn A with ss to top right corner of neck, ch1, work 10htr evenly across neckline, fasten off.

Embroidered Details

Using Yarn C, embroider a snowflake on Jumper.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, dc2tog, 16dc, turn. [17 dc]

Row 3 Ch1, dc2tog, 15dc. [16 dc]

Row 4 Ch1, dc2tog, 14dc. [15 dc]

Row 5 Ch1, dc2tog, 13dc. [14 dc]

Row 6 Ch1, dc2tog, 12dc. [13 dc]

Row 7 Ch1, dc2tog, 11dc. [12 dc]

Row 8 Ch1, dc2tog, 10dc. [11 dc]

Row 9 Ch1, dc2tog, 9dc. [10 dc]

Row 10 Ch1, dc2tog, 8dc. [9 dc]

Row 11 Ch1, dc2tog, 7dc, ch5. [8 dc, ch 5]

Row 12 1dc in second ch from hook, 11dc, ch5. [12 dc, ch 5]

Row 13 1dc in second ch from hook, 15dc. [16 dc]

Row 14 Ch1, dc2tog, 14dc. [15 dc]
Row 15 Ch1, dc2tog, 13dc. [14 dc]
Row 16 Ch1, dc2tog, 12dc. [13 dc]
Row 17 Ch1, dc2tog, 11dc. [12 dc]
Row 18 Ch1, dc2tog, 10dc. [11 dc]
Row 19 Ch1, dc2tog, 9dc. [10 dc]
Row 20 Ch1, dc2tog, 8dc. [9 dc]
Row 21 Ch1, dc2tog, 7dc. [8 dc]
Row 22 Ch1, dc2tog, 6dc. [7 dc]
Row 23 Ch1, dc2tog, 5dc, ch4. [6 dc, ch 4]
Row 24 1dc in second ch from hook, 8dc, ch4. [9 dc, ch 4]
Row 25 1dc in second ch from hook, 11dc. [12 dc]
Row 26 Ch1, dc2tog, 10dc. [11 dc]
Row 27 Ch1, dc2tog, 9dc. [10 dc]
Row 28 Ch1, dc2tog, 8dc. [9 dc]
Row 29 Ch1, dc2tog, 7dc. [8 dc]
Row 30 Ch1, dc2tog, 6dc. [7 dc]
Row 31 Ch1, dc2tog, 5dc. [6 dc]
Row 32 Ch1, dc2tog, 4dc. [5 dc]
Row 33 Ch1, dc2tog, 3dc. [4 dc]
Row 34 Ch1, dc2tog, 2dc. [3 dc]
Row 35 Ch1, dc3tog, fasten off.

Tree Trunk

With RS of Tree facing, join Yarn B with ss to 8th ch of foundation chain, 1dc in same st, 3dc, turn.

Row 1 (WS)-3 Ch1, 4dc, turn. [4 dc]


Fasten off.

Embroidered Details

Using Yarn C double stranded, embroider 4 candles on Christmas Tree.
 Using Yarn D, embroider a flame on each candle using a Lazy Daisy st.
 Using Yarn E, embroider 5 straight sts around each flame.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



MATERIALS

Scheepjes Catona

(100% Mercerised Cotton; 10gr/25m)
Yarn A 402 Silver Green x 1 ball
Yarn B 391 Deep Ocean x 1 ball
 2.5mm crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS

8cm high x 7.5cm wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Stocking

Using Yarn A, ch11.

Row 1 (RS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 9dc, turn. [10 dc]

Row 2 (WS)-4 Ch1, 10dc, turn.

Row 5 Ch1, 2dc in first dc, 8dc, 2dc in final dc. [12 dc]

Row 6 Ch2, start in second ch from hook: 13dc. [13 dc]

Row 7 Ch3, start in second ch from hook: 13dc, 2ss. [13 dc, 2 ss]

Row 8 Ch1, skip 1 ss, 1ss, 13dc. [13 dc, 1 ss]

Row 9 Ch3, start in second ch from hook: 13dc, 1ss, leave final 2 sts unworked. [13 dc, 1 ss]

Row 10 Ch1, skip 1 ss, 13dc. [13 dc]

Row 11 Ch1, 10dc, 1ss, leave final 2 sts unworked. [10 dc, 1 ss]

Rows 12-18 Ch1, 10dc. [10 dc]

Change to Yarn B.

Row 19 Ch3 (does not count as a st here and in next row), 10tr. [10 tr]

Row 20 Ch3, 10tr, fasten off.

Heel

With RS of Stocking facing, join Yarn B with ss in row-end of Row 1 of Stocking.

Row 1 (RS) Work 9dc evenly along row-ends of Stocking, turn. [9 dc]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, skip 1 st, 8dc, turn. [8 dc]

Row 3 Ch1, dc2tog, 1dc, dc2tog, 1dc, dc2tog. [5 dc]

Row 4 Ch1, dc2tog, 1htr, dc2tog. [2 dc, 1 htr]

Row 5 Dc3tog (incl. htr), fasten off. [1 dc]

Toe

With RS of Stocking facing, join Yarn B with ss in row-end of Row 7 of Stocking.

Row 1 (RS) Work 7dc evenly along row-ends of Stocking, turn. [7 dc]

Row 2 (WS) Ch1, dc2tog, 3dc, dc2tog, turn. [5 dc]

Row 3 Ch1, dc2tog, 1htr, dc2tog. [2 dc, 1 htr]

Row 4 Ch1, 3dc.

Row 5 Ch1, dc3tog, fasten off. [1 dc]

Embroidered Details

Using photos as a guide and with Yarn A, embroider 9 straight lines onto cuff of Stocking.

Using Yarn B, embroider small 'V' shapes onto Stocking.

To Finish

Weave in all ends and block to flatten shape.



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
