Punch Needle Bunting

By Scheepjes Design



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MATERIALS

Scheepjes Stone Washed XXL (58% Cotton, 42% Acrylic; 100g/90m)

Use colours below for Bunting on photos or use colours of your choice:

Yarn A 841 Moon Stone x 1 ball

Yarn B 878 Orpiment x 1 ball

Yarn C 853 Amazonite x 1 ball

Yarn D 854 Crystal Quartz x 1 ball

Yarn E 883 Realgar Red x 1 ball

Scheepjes Candy Floss (100% Organic

Mercerised Cotton; 20g/165m)

105 Bridal White x 1 ball

Oxford punch needle, regular size 10

Oxford monk's cloth, approx. 16 x 16cm for each flag

Oxford punch frame

Felt, 2mm thick, in matching colour for back of flags

Twill tape, 20mm wide

Cord, 3mm thick

Basic sewing and craft supplies

PATTERN NOTES

Amount of materials needed depends on the number of letters and motifs you want to make. For a neat finish, it is important to keep the letters simple in shape. Avoid thin

lines, sharp corners and busy fonts, as these are more difficult to finish neatly. See photos for examples of suitable (letter) shapes, for example the letter N.

INSTRUCTIONS

Printing

See PDF file: Punch Needle Letters.

Print the letters and motifs at 100% size.

Note: Use mirrored letters, as you work from the wrong side of the fabric.

Punching

Stretch the monk's cloth tightly in the punch frame. Trace the letters and motifs onto the monk's cloth. Punch the letters and motifs following the pattern.

TO FINISH

Remove work from the frame. Cut out each letter or motif, leaving an even border of approx. 1.5cm (3/4in) all around. Fold the fabric edge to the wrong side around the letter or motif. Secure with pins or clips.

Place the letter or motif on the felt and cut out a shape that completely covers the back. Cut a piece of twill tape approx. 8cm (3 1/4in) long and form a loop. Place the loop at the top on the wrong side of the letter or motif. Sew the felt to the back of the letter using Scheepjes Candy Floss and the blanket stitch, catching the folded fabric edge and the twill

tape loop at the same time.

Repeat for all letters and motifs.

Thread the letters and motifs onto a cord through the loops and space evenly to form a Bunting. Cut the cord to the desired length.



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
