## Lady Clogsby the Mouse

### MATERIALS

Grey mouse including music box

[Scheepjes Catona](#) (100% Mercerised Cotton;

50g/125m, 25g/62.5m, 10g/25m)

**Yarn A** 074 Mercury, 50g x 1 ball

**Yarn B** 408 Old Rose, 10g x 1 ball

**Yarn C** 249 Saffron, 10g x 1 ball

**Yarn D** 390 Poppy Rose, 25g x 1 ball

Leftover black or dark brown yarn for eyes

2.5mm crochet hook

Polyester stuffing

Stitch markers

Music box

White mouse excl. music box

[Scheepjes Little Darling](#)

(100% Polyester; 50g/90m)

**Yarn A** 401 Ice Bear x 2 balls (see Pattern Notes)

**Yarn B** 415 Piglet x 1 ball

**Yarn C** 402 Bumble Bee x 1 ball

**Yarn D** 417 Strawberry x 1 ball

Leftover black or dark brown yarn for eyes

3.5mm crochet hook

Polyester stuffing

Stitch markers

### GAUGE/TENSION

Tension is not critical for this project, but make sure stuffing is not showing

### MEASUREMENTS

*Catona version:* about 19cm (7½in) tall sitting down, 26cm (10¼in) incl. Legs

*Little Darling version:* about 22cm (8¾in) tall sitting down, 30cm (11¾in) incl. Legs

### ABBREVIATIONS (UK TERMINOLOGY)

[ ] number of stitches on a given row/round

**blo** back loop(s) only: insert hook under back loop(s) only

**ch(s)** chain(s) or chain stitch(es)

**dc** double crochet

**dc2tog** double crochet 2 together to decrease by 1 st: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) twice, yoh, draw through all loops

**flo** front loop(s) only: insert hook under front loop(s) only

**inc** work 2dc into the next st to increase by 1 st

**rep(s)** repeat(s)

**RS** right side

**ss** slip stitch(es)

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**WS** wrong side

**yoh** yarn over hook

(.....) x times/to end work instructions between brackets the total number of times stated

### OPMERKINGEN

Lady Clogsby wears an adorable Waistcoat and a pair of Clogs. The Head is positioned in such a way that she glances to one side.

Pattern sections are worked in a combination of rounds and rows; Head and Body sections

are worked without fastening off yarn after each sub-section. Rounds are worked using amigurumi method: work sts continuously in a spiral without closing each round with ss. Mark first st of each round with a stitch marker, moving it up as you go. When working in rows, turn work after each row unless otherwise indicated. Change colour in last yoh of previous st. Ch1 at the beginning of a row/round does not count as a st throughout.

### Catona version:

The Catona version features a music box inside its Body.

### Little Darling version:

The Little Darling version does not have a music box. For Yarn A: depending on your gauge, you might just have enough if you purchase one ball or you might be running a tad short, so just to be sure we have stated that you need two balls.

### INSTRUCTIES

#### MOUSE

##### Head

Using Yarn A, make magic ring.

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), 6dc into ring. [6 dc]

**Round 2 (RS)** (Inc, 1dc) 3 times. [9 dc]

Pull tightly on short end of yarn to close ring.

**Round 3** (Inc, 2dc) 3 times. [12 dc]

**Round 4** (Inc, 1dc) 6 times. [18 dc]

**Round 5** 1dc in each st around.



**Round 6** (Inc, 2dc) 6 times. [24 dc]  
**Round 7** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 8** (Inc, 3dc) 6 times. [30 dc]  
**Round 9** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 10** (Inc, 4dc) 6 times. [36 dc]  
**Round 11** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 12** (Inc, 5dc) 6 times. [42 dc]  
**Round 13** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 14** (Inc, 6dc) 6 times. [48 dc]  
**Round 15** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 16** (Inc, 7dc) 6 times. [54 dc]  
**Rounds 17-18** 1dc in each st around.  
 Do not fasten off.

#### Shape Back of Head

**Row 1 (RS)** 42dc, leave last 12 sts unworked, turn.  
 Continue on these 42 sts.  
**Row 2 (WS)** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, turn.  
**Row 3** Ch1, (dc2tog, 5dc) 6 times. [36 dc]  
**Rows 4-5** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end.  
**Row 6** Ch1, (dc2tog, 4dc) 6 times. [30 dc]  
**Rows 7-8** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end.  
**Row 9** Ch1, (dc2tog, 3dc) 6 times. [24 dc]  
**Row 10** Ch1, (dc2tog, 2dc) 6 times. [18 dc]  
**Row 11** Ch1, (dc2tog, 1dc) 6 times. [12 dc]  
**Row 12** Ch1, (dc2tog) 6 times. [6 dc]  
**Row 13** Ch1, (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) 6 times (7 loops on hook), yoh, draw through all 7 loops, do not turn and do not fasten off but continue to Body.

#### Body

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, work 12 dc evenly along

edge of Back of Head to unworked sts of Round 18 of Head, 1dc in next 12 unworked dc, work 12 dc evenly along remaining edge of Back of Head. [36 dc]  
**Rounds 2 (RS)-3** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 4** (Inc, 5dc) 6 times. [42 dc]  
**Rounds 5-6** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 7** (Inc, 6dc) 6 times. [48 dc]  
**Rounds 8-9** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 10** (Inc, 7dc) 6 times. [54 dc]  
**Rounds 11-12** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 13** (Inc, 8dc) 6 times. [60 dc]  
**Rounds 14-15** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 16** (Inc, 9dc) 6 times. [66 dc]  
**Rounds 17-26** 1dc in each st around.

#### Shape Base

**Round 27** (Dc2tog, 9dc) 6 times. [60 dc]  
**Round 28** (Dc2tog, 8dc) 6 times. [54 dc]  
**Round 29** (Dc2tog, 7dc) 6 times. [48 dc]  
**Round 30** (Dc2tog, 6dc) 6 times. [42 dc]  
 Stuff Head and Body.  
*For Catona version: form a cavity in centre of stuffing near Base of Body. Insert music box into cavity.*  
**Round 31** (Dc2tog, 5dc) 6 times. [36 dc]  
**Round 32** (Dc2tog, 4dc) 6 times. [30 dc]  
**Round 33** (Dc2tog, 3dc) 6 times. [24 dc]  
*For Catona version: Insert more stuffing to cover bottom of music box, making sure no hard edges poke through fabric and keeping music box pull hanging from centre of Base of Body.*  
**Round 34** (Dc2tog, 2dc) 6 times. [18 dc]  
**Round 35** (Dc2tog, 1dc) 6 times. [12 dc]

If needed, add more stuffing to get desired shape.

**Round 36** (Dc2tog) 6 times. [6 dc]  
 Fasten off.

#### EAR (MAKE 2)

##### Inner Ear

Using Yarn B, make magic ring.

**Row 1 (RS)** Ch1, 5dc into ring, turn. [5 dc]  
**Row 2 (WS)** Ch1, (inc) 5 times, turn. [10 dc]  
 Pull tightly on short end of yarn to close ring.  
**Row 3** Ch1, (inc, 1dc) 5 times. [15 dc]  
**Row 4** Ch1, (inc, 2dc) 5 times. [20 dc]  
**Row 5** Ch1, (inc, 3dc) 5 times. [25 dc]  
**Row 6** Ch1, (inc, 4dc) 5 times, change to Yarn A. [30 dc]

##### Outer Ear

**Row 7** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end.  
**Row 8** Ch1, 1dc flo in each st to end.  
**Row 9** Ch1, (dc2tog, 4dc) 5 times. [25 dc]  
**Row 10** Ch1, (dc2tog, 3dc) 5 times. [20 dc]  
**Row 11** Ch1, (dc2tog, 2dc) 5 times. [15 dc]  
**Row 12** Ch1, (dc2tog, 1dc) 5 times. [10 dc]  
**Row 13** Ch1, (dc2tog) 5 times. [5 dc]  
**Row 14** Ch1, (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) 5 times (6 loops on hook), yoh, draw through all 6 loops.  
 Fasten off, leaving long tails of Yarn A and Yarn B. Use tail of Yarn B to sew together row ends of Inner Ear. With tail of Yarn A, sew together row ends of Outer Ear. Sew together first two sts at corner of each Ear to shape them.

#### LEG (MAKE 2)

##### Clog

Using Yarn C, ch6.

**Round 1 (RS)** 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in next 3 chs, 3dc in last ch, turn to continue on other side of foundation chain: 1dc in next 4 chs. [11 dc]  
**Round 2 (RS)** Inc, 3dc, inc, 3dc in next dc, inc, 3dc, inc. [17 dc]  
**Round 3** Inc, 5dc, (inc) 5 times, 5dc, inc, ss to first dc. [24 dc]  
 Do not fasten off, but continue to work in rows as follows.

**Row 1 (WS)** Ch1, 1dc flo in each st to end, ss to first dc to join, turn.  
**Row 2 (RS)** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, ss to first dc, turn.  
**Row 3** Ch1, 6dc, (dc2tog) twice, 4dc, (dc2tog) twice, 6dc, ss to first dc. [20 dc]  
**Rows 4-5** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, ss to first dc. Change to Yarn B at the end of Row 5. Fasten off Yarn C, leaving long tail hanging.

##### Leg

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, 5dc blo, skip next 10 dc, 5dc blo. [10 dc blo worked, 10 dc skipped]  
 Continue only in worked sts from previous round.  
**Rounds 2 (RS)-8** 1dc in each st around, change to Yarn A at the end of Round 8.  
 Fasten off Yarn B.  
**Round 9** (Inc, 1dc) 5 times. [15 dc]  
**Round 10** 1dc in each st around.  
**Round 11** (Inc, 2dc) 5 times. [20 dc]

**Rounds 12-15** 1dc in each st around.

Work 1dc in next 3 sts to end at side of Leg. Fasten off, leaving long tails of Yarn C (Clog) and Yarn A (Leg).

Using tail of Yarn C, sew 5 skipped sts together on top of Clog. Stuff Leg to within 4 rows from top, keeping sole of Clog flat. Flatten opening at top of Leg and sew sts together to form straight edge.

#### ARM (MAKE 2)

Using Yarn B, make magic ring.

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch1, 5dc into ring. [5 dc]

**Round 2 (RS)** Inc in each st around. [10 dc]  
Pull tightly on short end of yarn to close ring.

**Rounds 3-12** 1dc in each st around, change to Yarn A at the end of Round 12.

**Round 13** (Inc, 1dc) 5 times. [15 sts]

**Rounds 14-24** 1dc in each st around.

**Round 25** (Dc2tog, 1dc) 5 times. [10 dc]

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail hanging.

Stuff Arm to within 4 rows from top. Flatten top and sew sts together to form straight edge.

#### TAIL

Using Yarn B, ch46.

**Row 1 (WS)** 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in next 43 chs, 2dc in last ch, 1dc in opposite side of next 44 chs. [90 dc]

Fold Tail with WS together, aligning sts on each side. Working through both layers held together: ch1, 1ss in next 45 sts to join. Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.

#### WAISTCOAT

Waistcoat is made from neck down, so foundation chain is at side of neckline. Make sure to mark RS with a stitch marker. Keep an eye on RS/WS to make it easier to recognise where to rejoin yarn for the various sections. Using Yarn D, ch41.

**Row 1 (RS)** 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in next 39 chs, turn. [40 dc]

**Row 2 (WS)** Ch1, inc, 1dc in each dc to last st, inc, turn. [42 dc]

#### Left Front

**Row 3 (RS)** Ch1, inc, 3dc, turn. [5 dc]

Continue on these 5 sts, turn after each row.

**Row 4 (WS)** Ch1, 1dc in each dc to last st, inc. [6 dc]

**Row 5** Ch1, inc, 1dc in each st to end. [7 dc]

**Row 6** Rep Row 4. [8 dc]

**Rows 7-8** Ch1, inc, 1dc in each dc to last st, inc. [12 dc]

Fasten off.

#### Back Panel

With **RS** facing, skip next 10 unworked sts of Row 2 of Waistcoat and join Yarn D with ss to next dc.

**Row 1 (RS)** 1dc in same st as ss, 13dc, turn. [14 dc]

Continue on these 14 sts, turn after each row.



**Row 2 (WS)** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end.

**Rows 3-4** Rep Row 2.

**Rows 5-6** Ch1, inc, 1dc in each dc to last st, inc. [18 dc]

Fasten off.

#### Right Front

With **WS** facing, join Yarn D with ss to first dc of Row 2 of Waistcoat.

Begin in same st as ss, rep Rows 3-8 of Left Front, turn and do not fasten off at the end.

#### Create and Join Armholes

**Row 1 (WS)** Ch1, 2dc in next st of Right Front, 10dc, inc, ch10, 2dc in next st of Back (*first armhole opening made*), 16dc, inc, ch10, 2dc in next st of Left Front (*second armhole opening made*), 10dc, inc, turn. [68 dc]

**Row 2 (RS)** Ch1, inc, 13dc, 1dc in next 10 chs, 20dc, 1dc in next 10 chs, 1dc in each dc to last st, inc, turn. [70 dc]

**Rows 3-7** Ch1, 1dc in each st to end, turn. Do not fasten off at the end of Row 7.

#### Finish Left Front

**Row 8** Ch1, dc2tog, 15dc, dc2tog.

Continue on these 17 sts.

**Row 9** Ch1, skip first st, dc2tog, 1dc in each dc to last 2 sts, dc2tog. [14 dc]

**Row 10** Ch1, dc2tog, 1dc in each dc to last 3 sts, dc2tog, leave last st unworked. [11 dc]

**Rows 11-12** Rep Rows 9-10. [5 dc]

**Row 13** Ch1, skip first st, (dc2tog) twice. [2 dc]

**Row 14** Ch1, dc2tog. [1 dc]

Fasten off.

#### Finish Right Front

With **WS** of Waistcoat facing, join Yarn D with ss to first dc.

Begin in same st as ss, rep Rows 8-14 of Left Front.

Fasten off.

#### Edging

With **RS** of Waistcoat facing, join Yarn D with ss to opposite side of first of beginning 40-chs.

**Round 1 (RS)** 1dc in same st as ss, 1dc in next 39 chs, work 21dc evenly along Left Front

edge, 3dc in dc of Row 14 of Left Front, work 12dc evenly in row ends of Left Front, 32dc, work 12dc evenly in row ends of Right Front, 3dc in dc of Row 14 of Right Front, work 21dc evenly along Right Front edge. [144 dc]

**Round 2 (RS)** Inc, 38dc, inc, 10dc, inc, 3dc, inc, 7dc, 3dc in next dc, 58dc, 3dc in next dc, 7dc, inc, 3dc, inc, 10dc, ss to first dc. [154 dc]  
Fasten off.

#### Armhole Edging

With **WS** of Waistcoat facing, join Yarn D with ss to first of 10 skipped sts of Row 2 of Waistcoat.

**Next round** 1dc in same st as ss, 9dc, work 7dc evenly down edge of row ends, 1dc in opposite side of next 10 chs, work 7dc evenly up edge of row ends, ss to first dc, fasten off.

Rep Armhole Edging again for other armhole.

#### Button (make 2)

With Yarn C, ch4, ss to first ch to make ring.

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail and sew Button to Right Front of Waistcoat using image as guide.

#### TO FINISH

Sew each Ear to Head using image as guide, sewing all around the seam joining Outer Ear row ends to attach securely.

Sew Legs near front of Body on each side of the central group of dec sts, positioning outside edge of Leg at Row 28 and inside edge of Leg at Row 30 of Body. Sew Arms to each side of Body.

Sew Tail to back of Body.

Using satin stitch, embroider nose with Yarn B and eyes with black or dark brown yarn.

Weave in all ends.
