MATERIALS

[Scheepjes Snowfall](#) (80% Acrylic, 20% Nylon;
200g/400m)

04 Rosehip x 1 yarn cake

[Scheepjes Stone Washed XL](#) (70% Cotton,
30% Acrylic; 50g/75m)

841 Moon Stone x 1 ball

4.5mm crochet hook

2 x ø 25mm buttons

1 x ø 50cm round cushion insert

Stitch markers

Basic sewing kit

MEASUREMENTS

About ø 42cm (16½in) per side till Round 19,
before assembly

GAUGE/TENSION

Tension is not critical. Work until you have
used about half of the cake, see Pattern
Notes

PATTERN NOTES

The Snowdrift Cushion is a variation on
the [Dandelion Clock Cushion](#), designed by
Jellina Verhoeff. This double-sided cushion is
crocheted using one yarn cake. The first side
is worked from the outside of the cake and
the second side from the centre. This creates

a beautiful colour gradient towards the edge.
Once you have made both cushion pieces,
work a motif onto each piece using surface
ss. The two cushion pieces are then sewed
together.

Please note: before you begin, calculate
how much yarn you can use for each cushion
piece. To do this, weigh the yarn cake without
the label. For example: the cake weighs 200
grams. Allow 10% of this weight for joining the
two pieces together. In this example, that is
20 grams, leaving 180 grams for the cushion
pieces. Divide this amount between the two
sides: 180 grams ÷ 2 = 90 grams per side.
Crochet the first side until you can complete
one full round without exceeding 90 grams.
Make a note of how many rounds you have
crocheted. Then crochet the same number
of rounds for the second side, so that both
cushion pieces are the same size.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

ss surface crochet with hook on RS of work,
and yarn on WS of work, insert hook from
front to back in specified opening, yoh, pull up
a loop from back to front, *insert hook into
next opening between two rounds, yoh, pull
up from back and draw through on hook; rep
from * for each opening as directed, fasten
off at end, do not weave in ends

INSTRUCTIONS

First Side

Starting from the outside of the cake, make a
magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) Ch3 (does not count as st
throughout), 12tr into ring, ss to first tr to join.
[12 tr]

Round 2 Ch3, 2tr in each st to end, ss to first
tr. [24 tr]

Round 3 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 1tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [36 tr]

Round 4 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 2tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [48 tr]

Round 5 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 3tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [60 tr]

Round 6 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 4tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [72 tr]

Round 7 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 5tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [84 tr]

Round 8 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 6tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [96 tr]

Round 9 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 7tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [108 tr]

Round 10 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 8tr) to end, ss to
first tr. [120 tr]

Round 11 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 9tr) to end, ss to first tr. [132 tr]

Round 12 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 10tr) to end, ss to first tr. [144 tr]

Round 13 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 11tr) to end, ss to first tr. [156 tr]

Round 14 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 12tr) to end, ss to first tr. [168 tr]

Round 15 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 13tr) to end, ss to first tr. [180 tr]

Round 16 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 14tr) to end, ss to first tr. [192 tr]

Round 17 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 15tr) to end, ss to first tr. [204 tr]

Round 18 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 16tr) to end, ss to first tr. [216 tr]

Round 19 Ch3, (2tr in next st, 17tr) to end, ss to first tr. [228 tr]

With the tension of our sample, we were able to crochet up to and including Round 19 without exceeding 90 grams. Should you have enough yarn remaining for additional rounds, work them as follows:

Next round(s) Ch3, 1tr in each st to end, ss to first tr.

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Second Side

Crochet the other side of the cushion up to the same round, but begin from the centre of the yarn cake (or from the outside if you began the first cushion piece from the centre). Do not fasten off.

Ss Surface Crochet Motif

Work surface ss on RS of both cushion pieces. See **Crochet Chart: Surface Slip Stitch Overview Crochet** and the Special Abbreviation. Do not pull the yarn too tightly. Insert the hook between Rounds 1 and 2 and work the first line, indicated by the red dots on the crochet chart. Work each st into the space between 2 rounds, all the way to the outer edge. Up to and including Round 19, work all ss surface sts between the 2 sts that form the increase.

Assembly

Place both pieces with WS together and make sure the ss surface sts line up as neatly as possible. Sew the pieces together using whip sts, leaving about 30cm unsewn. Insert the cushion and close the opening.

Place the buttons in the centre of both sides of the cushion. Pull the yarn tightly while sewing them on, so that the buttons are pulled inwards slightly.

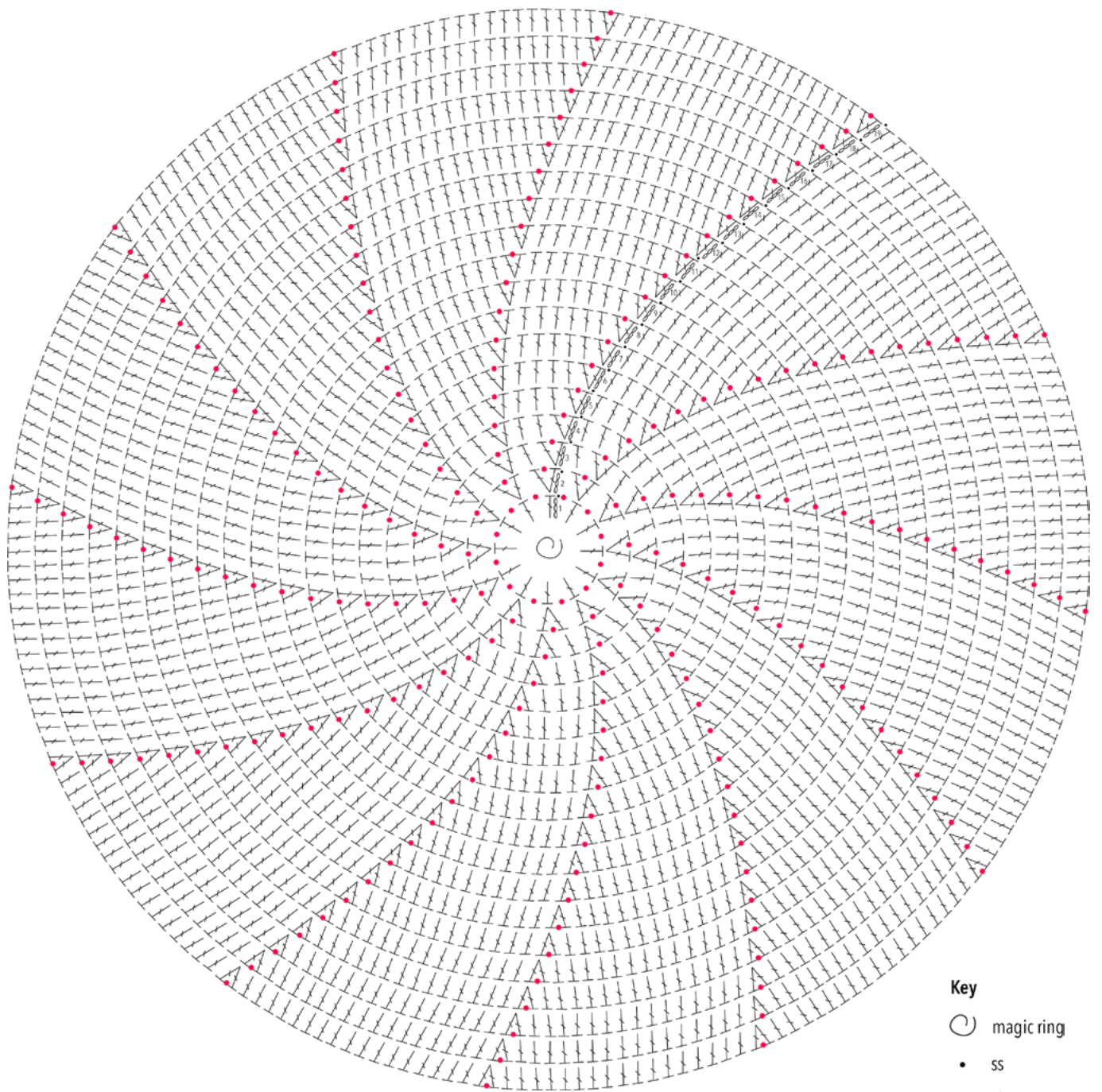
